PractiScore 2 Application User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION TO PRACTISCORE 2

PractiScore 2 is a mobile application designed for scoring practical shooting competitions. It serves as a comprehensive tool for match directors and scorers to manage and record scores for various shooting disciplines, including USPSA, Steel Challenge, and others. This manual provides instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of the PractiScore 2 application.

The application works in conjunction with the PractiScore website, which facilitates match creation, competitor registration, and result reporting. While the app can function independently for scoring, its full capabilities are realized when integrated with the online platform.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

2.1 System Requirements

- **Operating System:** Android, iOS, or Fire OS.
- **Device Type:** Mobile phones or tablets (not compatible with Windows PCs).
- **Internet Connection:** Required for initial download, match synchronization, and result uploads.

2.2 Application Installation

1. **Download:** Obtain the PractiScore 2 application from your device's respective app store (e.g., Google Play Store, Apple App Store, Amazon Appstore).
2. **Install:** Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the installation process.
3. **Launch:** Open the PractiScore 2 application after installation.

3. OPERATING THE PRACTIScore 2 APPLICATION

3.1 Match Synchronization

To begin scoring, you must first synchronize the match data from the PractiScore website to your device. This process downloads competitor lists, stage details, and other match configurations.

- Ensure your device has an active internet connection.
- Navigate to the "Matches" section within the app.
- Select the option to "Download Match" or "Synchronize."
- Choose the relevant match from the list.

Note: Be cautious when synchronizing. Downloading match registrations from the website can overwrite existing data on your device. Always confirm your action, especially when updating an ongoing match.

3.2 Scoring a Stage

1. From the synchronized match, select the stage to be scored.
2. Choose the competitor from the roster.
3. Input scores, penalties, and other relevant data as per the discipline's rules (e.g., time, hits, misses, procedural penalties).
4. Review the entered data for accuracy.
5. Confirm and save the score.

3.3 Uploading Results

After scoring is complete for a stage or the entire match, results can be uploaded back to the PractiScore website for public viewing and final processing.

- Ensure your device has an active internet connection.
- Navigate to the "Upload Results" section.
- Select the match and confirm the upload.

3.4 K-Zone Scoring

PractiScore 2 introduces K-Zone scoring for certain disciplines. Ensure that your match setup on the PractiScore website includes K-Zone target configurations if you intend to use this feature. If you download match registrations, verify that K-Zone settings are not inadvertently removed or overwritten.

4. MAINTENANCE AND BEST PRACTICES

- **Regular Updates:** Keep the PractiScore 2 application updated to the latest version to benefit from new features, bug fixes, and performance improvements.
- **Battery Management:** Scoring can be battery-intensive. Ensure devices are fully charged before a match and consider portable power banks for extended use.
- **Data Backup:** Regularly synchronize match data to the PractiScore website to prevent data loss.
- **Storage:** Ensure sufficient storage space on your device for match data.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Match data not synchronizing.	No internet connection, incorrect match ID, server issues.	Verify internet connectivity. Double-check match ID. Try again later.
Existing match data overwritten after download.	Incorrect synchronization option selected, or a known behavior in specific scenarios.	Always back up data before major synchronization. Be cautious with "download into existing match" options. Report persistent issues to support.
Application crashes or freezes.	Low device memory, outdated app version, software conflict.	Close other applications. Update PractiScore 2 to the latest version. Restart your device.
K-Zone scoring not available.	Match not configured for K-Zone on the website, or settings were lost during sync.	Verify K-Zone configuration on the PractiScore website. Re-synchronize carefully if necessary.
