INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the SBPKMARSCT Built-In Gas Hob. This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient use of your new appliance. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and operation, and keep it for future reference. This gas hob features a durable tempered glass panel, two powerful burners (Left 4.2kW, Right 5.2kW), and is designed for natural gas application, offering energy-saving performance and strong flame output.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Your safety and the safety of others are paramount. Please observe all safety warnings and instructions to minimize the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

- **Gas Supply:** Ensure the gas supply is compatible with the appliance (Natural Gas). All gas connections must be performed by a qualified professional.
- **Ventilation:** Always ensure adequate ventilation in the area where the gas hob is installed and operated.
- **Leak Checks:** After installation and any maintenance, check for gas leaks using a soapy water solution. Never use an open flame to check for leaks.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the appliance during operation and when it is hot.
- **Flammable Materials:** Do not store or use flammable materials near the gas hob.
- **Hot Surfaces:** Burners and surrounding areas become hot during use. Allow surfaces to cool before cleaning or touching.
- **Proper Use:** Use the appliance only for its intended purpose of cooking food.

INSTALLATION GUIDE (SETUP)

This gas hob is designed for built-in, drop-in installation. Due to the nature of gas appliances, professional installation by a certified technician is highly recommended to ensure safety and compliance with local regulations.

Installation Steps:

- 1. Prepare the Countertop:** Create a cut-out in your countertop according to the specified hole size: **620~680 mm (length) × 330~380 mm (width)**. Ensure the countertop material can withstand heat.
- 2. Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the installation area.
- 3. Gas Connection:** Connect the gas supply line to the hob's inlet. Use appropriate fittings and ensure all connections are tight and leak-free. Perform a leak test with soapy water.
- 4. Position the Hob:** Carefully lower the gas hob into the prepared cut-out. Ensure it sits flush and is stable.
- 5. Secure the Hob:** Use the provided clips or brackets (if any) to secure the hob to the countertop from underneath.
- 6. Final Checks:** Before first use, double-check all connections and ensure there are no obstructions around the burners.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to safely operate your gas hob:

1. **Prepare Cookware:** Place appropriate cookware centrally on the burner grate.
2. **Ignition:** Push down and turn the corresponding control knob counter-clockwise to the ignition position (usually marked with a flame symbol). You will hear a clicking sound as the automatic ignition sparks.
3. **Flame Adjustment:** Once the burner ignites, continue to hold the knob down for a few seconds to allow the thermocouple to heat up and activate the flame failure device (if present). Then, release the knob. You can then adjust the flame size by turning the knob between the high and low flame settings.
4. **Turning Off:** To turn off a burner, turn the control knob clockwise until it clicks into the OFF position. Ensure the flame is extinguished.

Important: If a burner does not ignite within a few seconds, turn the knob to the OFF position, wait for a minute for any gas to disperse, and then try again. Do not continuously hold the ignition for extended periods.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your gas hob.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, allow the hob to cool completely. Wipe the tempered glass surface with a soft cloth and a mild detergent solution. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for glass cooktops.
- **Burner Components:** Periodically remove the burner caps and grates. Wash them with warm soapy water, rinse thoroughly, and dry completely before reassembling. Ensure the burner ports are not clogged.
- **Stainless Steel Parts:** Clean stainless steel components with a damp cloth and a non-abrasive

cleaner. Dry immediately to prevent water spots.

- **Avoid Abrasives:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals, as they can scratch or damage the surface.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent them from baking onto the surface, which can make them harder to remove later.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|-------------------------|--|---|
| Burner does not ignite | No gas supply Clogged burner port Igniter not sparking | Check gas valve is open Clean burner caps and ports Ensure igniter is dry and clean |
| Flame is weak or uneven | Low gas pressure Clogged burner port Burner cap not seated correctly | Contact gas supplier Clean burner ports Re-seat burner cap properly |
| Gas smell detected | Gas leak Unlit burner | Immediately turn off gas supply, ventilate area, do not operate electrical switches, contact gas company/professional Ensure all burners are off |
