1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Fire-Boltt Snapp Smart Watch. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the functionality of your device. The Fire-Boltt Snapp is an advanced smartwatch featuring a 4G Nano-SIM slot, a selfie camera, a vibrant AMOLED display, and access to the Google Play Store.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the key components and features of your Fire-Boltt Snapp Smart Watch.

3.1 Key Features

- **Display:** 54.1mm (2.13-inch) AMOLED display with 410x502 pixel resolution.
- **Connectivity:** 4G Nano-SIM slot for cellular connectivity, Bluetooth, and Wi-Fi (2.4 GHz).
- **Camera:** Integrated selfie camera for photos and video calls.
- **Operating System:** Android OS with full access to the Google Play Store.
- **Memory:** 2GB RAM and 16GB ROM (storage capacity may vary by model).
- **Battery:** 1000mAh high-voltage polymer battery.
- **Health Monitoring:** SpO2 monitoring, heart rate tracking, sleep monitoring, step and calorie counting.

3.2 Device Layout

Identify the physical components of your smartwatch:

- **Display:** Front-facing touch screen.
- **Push Buttons:** Located on the side for navigation and power control.
- **Selfie Camera:** Integrated into the watch bezel.
- **4G Nano-SIM Slot:** Located on the side for cellular connectivity.
- **Charging Ports:** Magnetic charging pins on the rear.

4. GETTING STARTED

4.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge your smartwatch. Connect the provided charging cable to the magnetic charging pins on the back of the watch and to a standard USB power adapter (not included). A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours.

4.2 SIM Card Installation

The Fire-Boltt Snapp supports a 4G Nano-SIM card for independent cellular connectivity.

1. Locate the SIM card slot on the side of the smartwatch.
2. Gently open the SIM tray using the provided SIM ejector tool (if applicable) or your fingernail.
3. Insert a Nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down and the notched corner aligned correctly.
4. Carefully push the SIM tray back into the slot until it clicks into place.

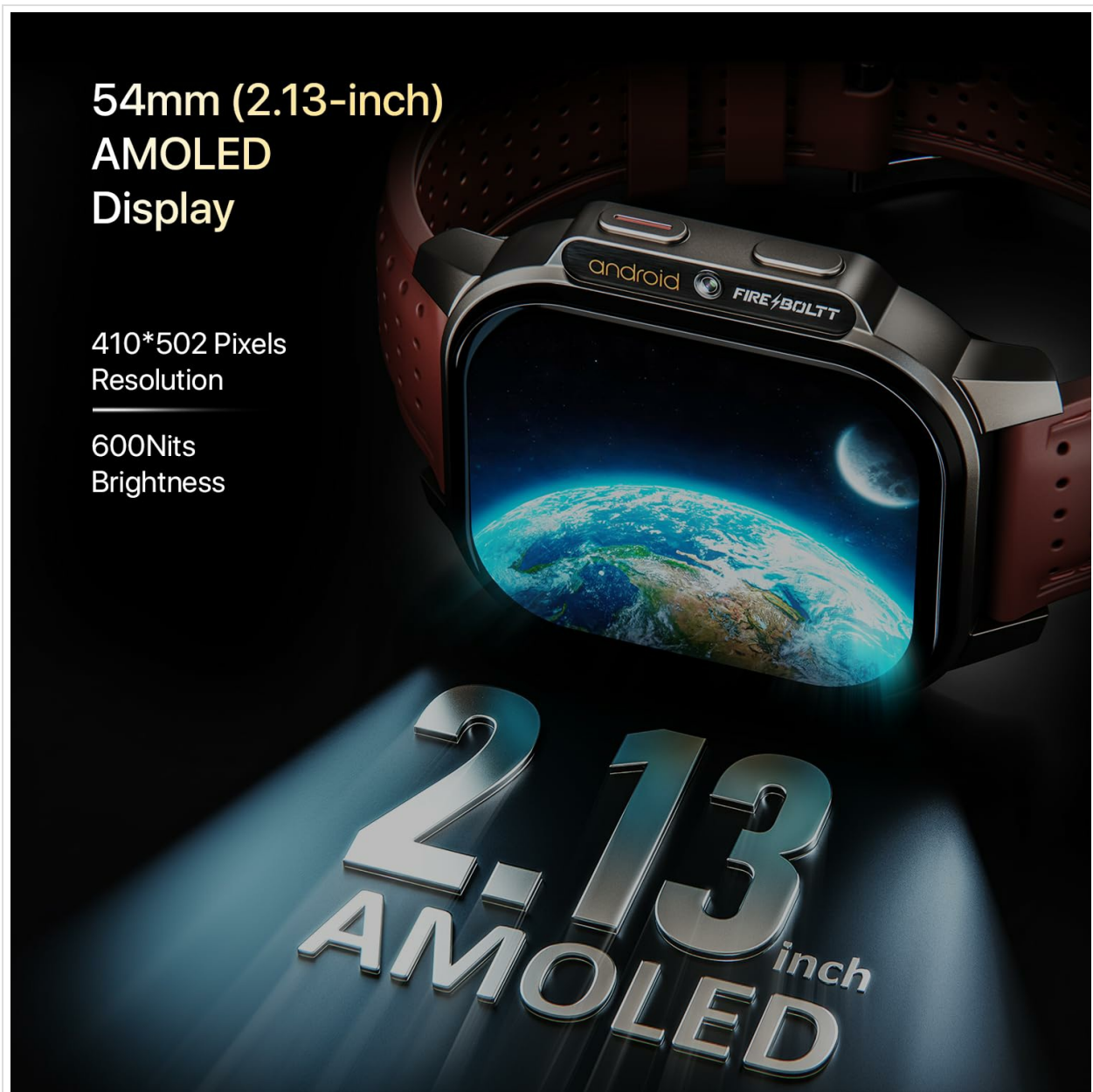


Image: The smartwatch highlighting its 4G Nano-SIM calling capability, showing the SIM card slot.

4.3 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the power button (usually the top or main button) until the Fire-Boltt logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the power button, then select 'Power Off' from the options on the screen.

4.4 Initial Setup and App Pairing

Upon first power-on, follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including language selection, time zone, and Wi-Fi connection. As an Android-based smartwatch, you can access the Google Play Store directly on the device to download and install applications without requiring a separate smartphone pairing for core functions.

5. OPERATING YOUR SMART WATCH

5.1 Navigation

The Fire-Boltt Snapp features a responsive touchscreen and physical buttons for navigation:

- **Swipe:** Swipe left, right, up, or down on the screen to access different menus, notifications, and quick settings.
- **Tap:** Tap an icon or option to select it.
- **Press Buttons:** Use the physical buttons for functions like returning to the home screen, accessing app lists, or power control.

5.2 Making and Receiving Calls

With a 4G Nano-SIM installed, you can make and receive calls directly from your smartwatch.

- **To Make a Call:** Open the 'Phone' app, dial the number, and tap the call icon.
- **To Receive a Call:** When a call comes in, tap the green answer icon on the screen.

5.3 Using the Selfie Camera

The integrated selfie camera allows you to capture photos and videos directly from your wrist.

1. Open the 'Camera' app from your app list.
2. Frame your shot using the watch display as a viewfinder.
3. Tap the shutter button on the screen to take a photo or start/stop video recording.

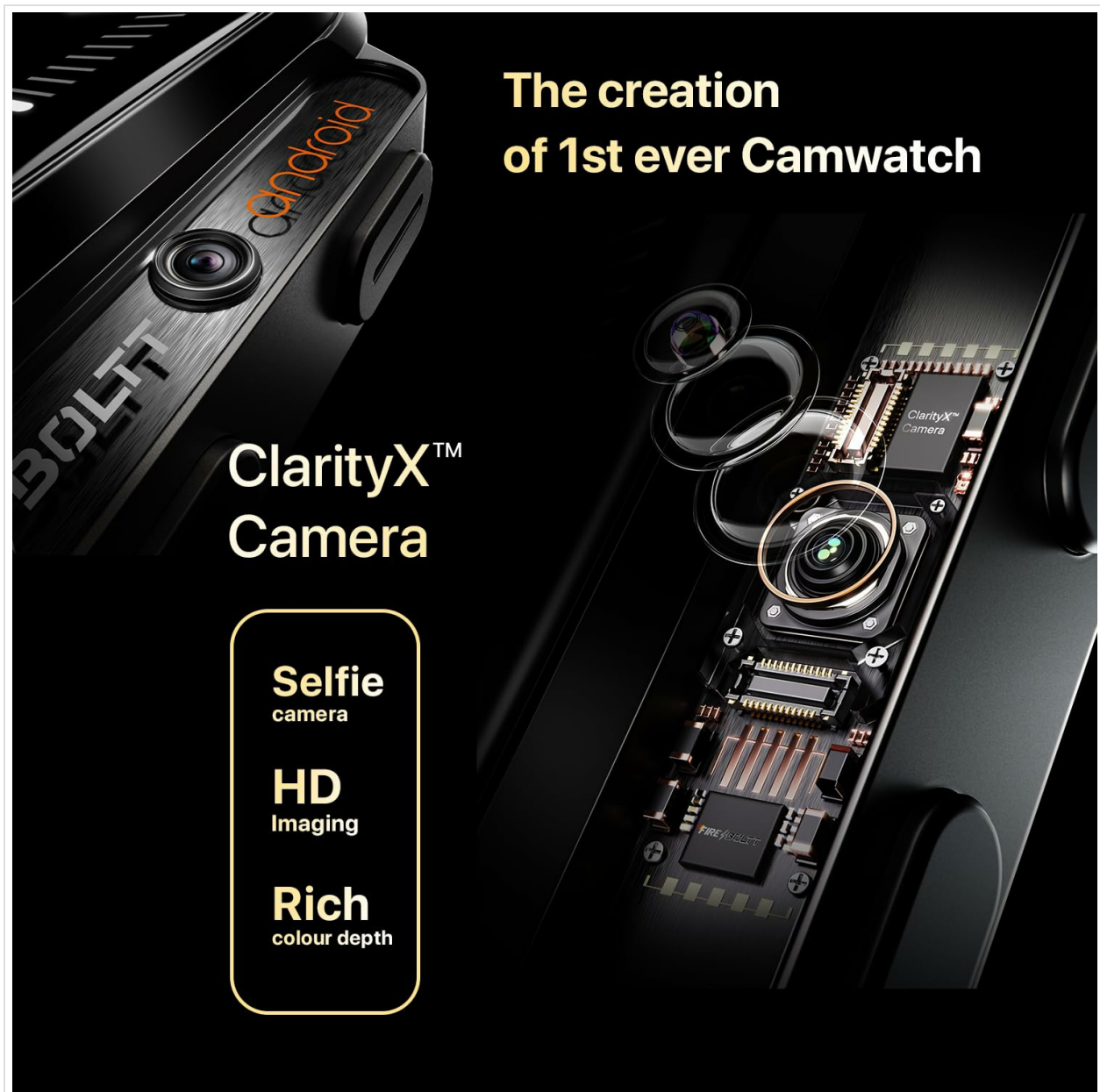


Image: A detailed view of the smartwatch's integrated selfie camera, designed for capturing moments from your wrist.

- **Activity Tracking:** Records steps taken, distance covered, and calories burned.

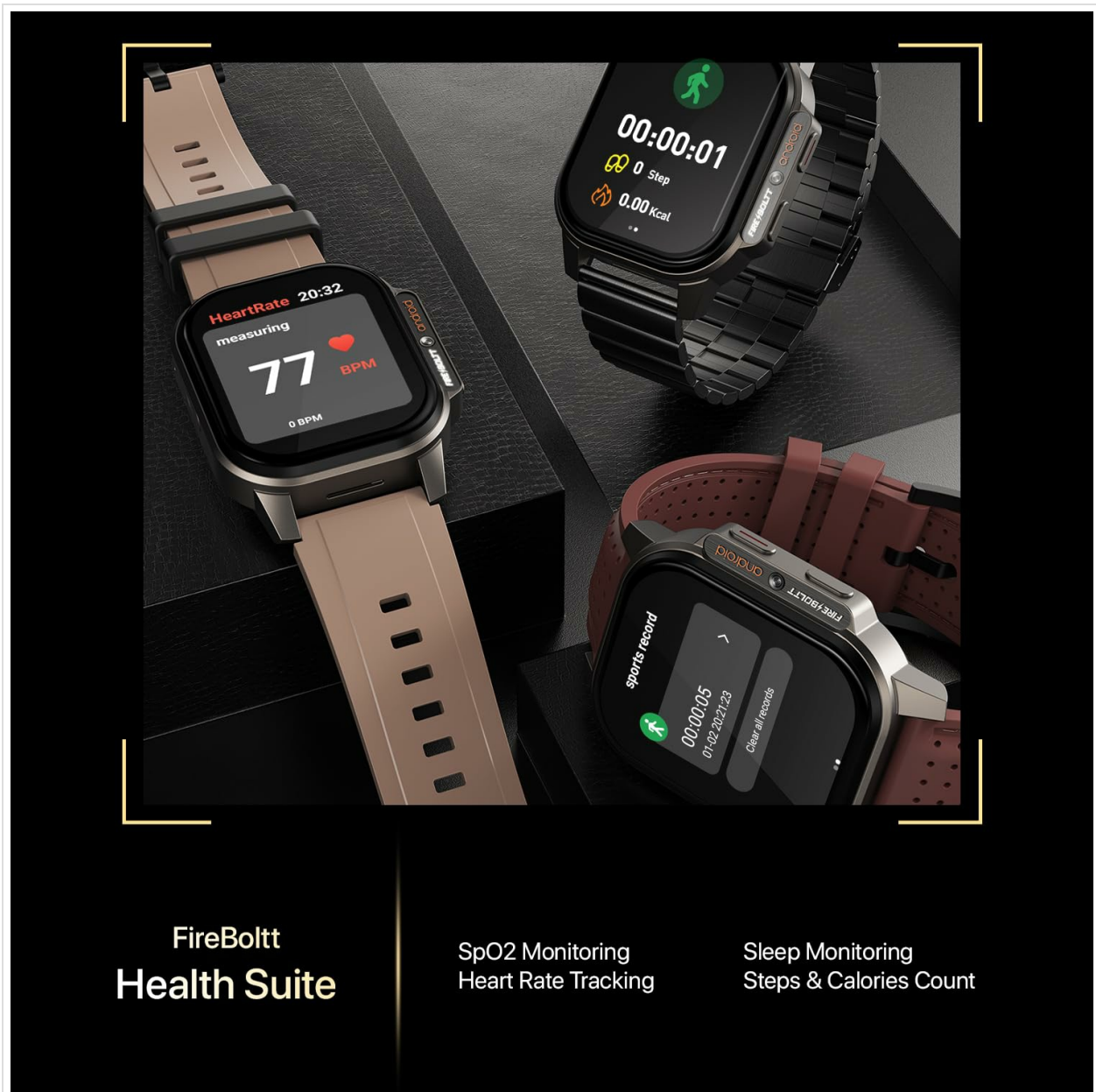


Image: Several smartwatches showcasing the 'FireBolt Health Suite' with displays for SpO2 monitoring, heart rate tracking, and steps/calories count.

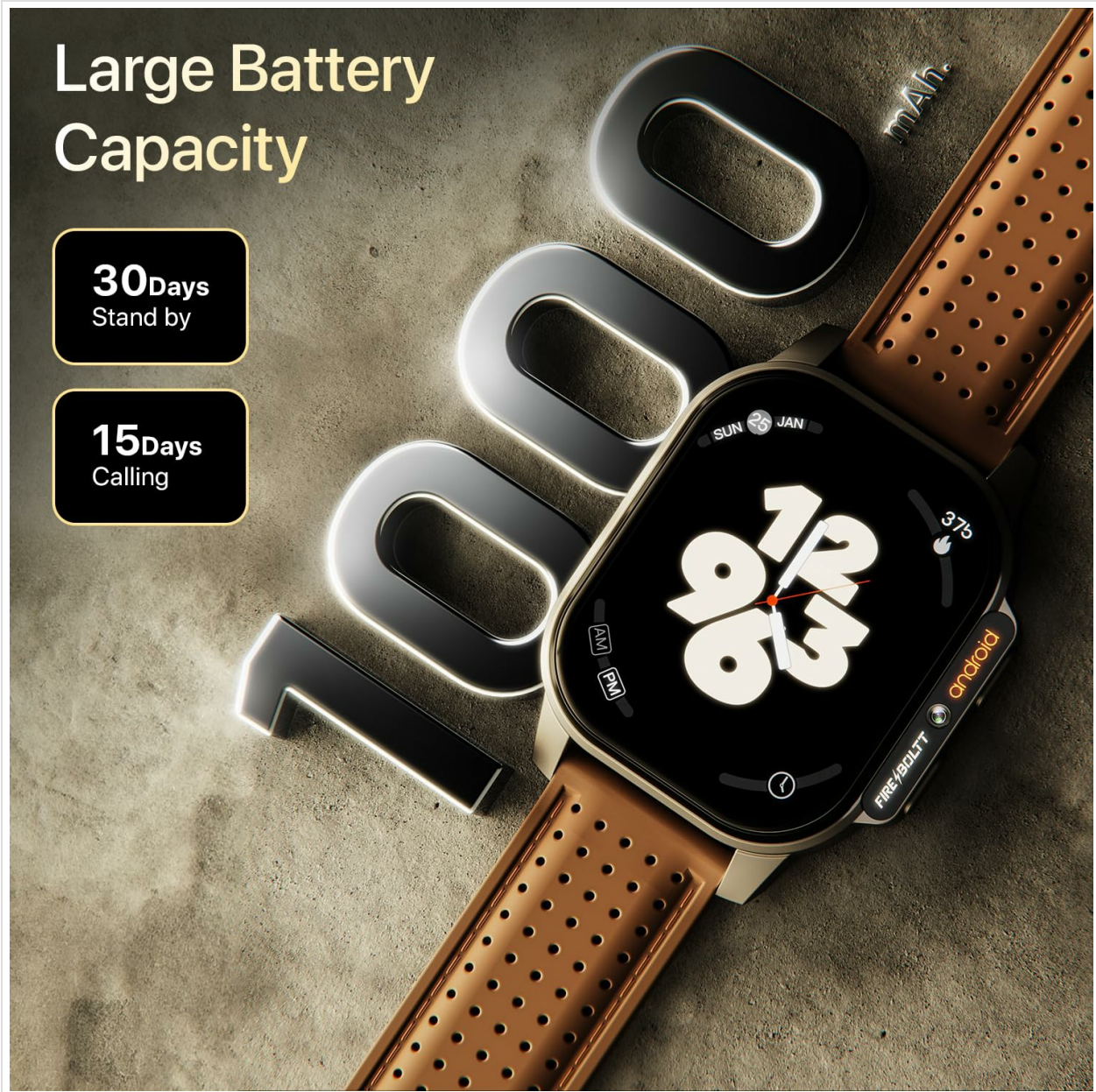

7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Fire-Boltt Snapp Smart Watch, follow these care guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the watch screen and body with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Water Resistance:** The watch has an IP67 rating, meaning it is resistant to dust and can withstand immersion in water up to 1 meter for 30 minutes. It is suitable for daily use and light splashes but should not be used for swimming or diving. Ensure the SIM tray is properly closed to maintain water resistance.
- **Temperature:** Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures (hot or cold) or direct sunlight for extended periods.
- **Charging:** Use only the provided charging cable. Do not attempt to force the charger if it does not connect easily.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Fire-Boltt Snapp Smart Watch, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Watch does not power on	Ensure the watch is fully charged. Press and hold the power button for at least 10 seconds.
Poor battery life	Reduce screen brightness, disable unnecessary background apps, turn off Wi-Fi/Bluetooth when not in use, or enable battery saver mode.
Cannot make/receive calls	Check if the 4G Nano-SIM card is correctly inserted and activated. Ensure you have network coverage. Restart the watch.
Apps not downloading/working	Verify Wi-Fi or cellular data connection. Ensure sufficient storage space. Clear Play Store cache or restart the watch.
Health sensors inaccurate	Ensure the watch is worn snugly on your wrist. Clean the sensor area on the back of the watch. Avoid excessive movement during measurements.
