## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Always adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- **Helmet Use:** Always wear a certified bicycle helmet when riding.
- **Traffic Laws:** Obey all local traffic laws, regulations, and road signs.
- **Pre-Ride Check:** Before each ride, check tire pressure, brake functionality, battery charge, and ensure all quick releases and fasteners are secure.
- **Weather Conditions:** Exercise caution when riding in wet conditions. Braking distance increases significantly on wet surfaces.
- **Night Riding:** Use front and rear lights when riding at night or in low-light conditions. Wear reflective clothing.
- **Battery Safety:** Do not attempt to open or modify the battery pack. Use only the provided charger. Keep the battery away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity specified for the bicycle.

- **Brakes:** Front and rear disc brakes for reliable stopping power.
- **Gears:** 7-speed gear system for versatile riding.



## 5. SETUP

Follow these steps for initial setup:

### 1. Unfolding the Bicycle:

- Place the bicycle on a flat surface.
- Release the frame folding latch and carefully unfold the main frame until it locks into place.
- Adjust the handlebar stem and seat post to your desired height and secure them with their respective quick releases.
- Unfold the pedals if they are in the folded position.

### 2. Battery Installation:

- Ensure the battery is fully charged before first use.
- Insert the battery into its compartment on the frame and secure it. Use the key to lock the battery in place if applicable.

3. **Tire Inflation:** Inflate tires to the recommended pressure (check sidewall of tires for PSI range).
4. **Brake Adjustment:** Test brakes and adjust if necessary to ensure proper function.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your Youin Texas electric bicycle is intuitive:

1. **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button on the display to turn the bicycle on or off.
2. **Pedal Assist Modes:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the display to cycle through the five levels of pedal assistance. Higher levels provide more motor assistance.
3. **Riding:** Begin pedaling, and the motor will engage to provide assistance based on the selected mode. You can also ride without assistance like a regular bicycle.
4. **Shifting Gears:** Use the gear shifter on the handlebar to change between the 7 speeds, adapting to different terrains and inclines.
5. **Braking:** Apply both front and rear disc brakes smoothly and simultaneously for effective stopping.

6. **Charging the Battery:** Connect the charger to the battery charging port (either on the bike or directly to the removed battery) and then to a power outlet. The indicator light on the charger will show charging status. Charging typically takes 4-6 hours.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safety of your electric bicycle:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the bicycle regularly with a damp cloth. Avoid high-pressure washing directly on electrical components.
- **Tires:** Check tire pressure weekly and inflate as needed. Inspect tires for wear and tear.
- **Brakes:** Regularly check brake pads for wear and ensure brake levers are responsive. Adjust brake cables if necessary.
- **Chain:** Keep the chain clean and lubricated to ensure smooth gear changes and prevent rust.
- **Battery Care:** Store the battery in a cool, dry place. If storing for extended periods, charge the battery to

50-70% every 2-3 months.

- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all bolts, nuts, and quick releases to ensure they are tight and secure.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bicycle does not power on	Battery not charged or not properly installed.	Ensure battery is fully charged and securely seated in its compartment. Check connections.
Motor not assisting	Low battery, pedal assist level too low, or sensor issue.	Charge battery. Increase pedal assist level. Check for any obstructions around the pedal sensor.
Brakes feel weak	Worn brake pads, loose cables, or air in hydraulic system (if applicable).	Inspect and replace brake pads if worn. Adjust brake cable tension. If hydraulic, seek professional service.
Unusual noises	Loose components, dry chain, or misaligned gears.	Check all fasteners. Lubricate chain. Adjust gear derailleur if shifting is rough.
