4. SETUP

- Initial Charging:** Upon receiving your voice recorder, connect it to a USB power source using the provided USB-C charging cable. Ensure the device is fully charged before first use. The indicator light will typically change or turn off when charging is complete.
- Set the Time:** After fully charging, connect the recorder to a computer (Windows or Mac) using the data cable. The device will appear as a removable disk. Locate the time synchronization file (often named "time.txt" or similar, refer to the detailed manual if provided) and follow the instructions to synchronize the recorder's internal clock with your local time. This ensures accurate timestamps for your recordings.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Recording

- To begin recording, locate the ON/OFF switch on the side of the recorder.
- Slide the switch to the **ON** position. The indicator light will briefly illuminate and then turn off,

signaling that recording has started.

3. To stop recording and save the file, slide the switch back to the **OFF** position. The recorder will power off and automatically save the current recording.

5.2. Playback

The Vandlion V15 does not have a built-in speaker to maintain its compact size and prevent accidental audio output. Playback is done via earphones or by connecting to a computer.

1. Ensure the recorder is in the **OFF** position.
2. Connect the provided control cable and earphones to the recorder's headphone jack.
3. Slide the recorder to the **ON** position. The recorder will now be in playback mode, and you can listen to your recordings through the earphones. Use the controls on the wired controller to navigate through files and adjust volume.

5.3. Voice Activation Settings

The voice activation function (VOR) allows the recorder to start and stop recording automatically based on the presence or absence of sound, saving storage space and battery life by skipping silent segments.

1. Connect the recorder to a computer.
2. Locate the configuration file, typically named **[RECSET]** or similar, on the recorder's storage.
3. Open this file using a basic text editor (e.g., Notepad on Windows,TextEdit on Mac).
4. Find the setting for VOR (Voice Operated Recording) and modify its value to **1** or **2** to activate it (the default is OFF). A higher number might indicate a higher sensitivity, but refer to the specific instructions in the full manual for precise values.
5. Save the **[RECSET]** file and safely eject the recorder from your computer.
6. When you power on the recorder by sliding the switch to **ON**, it will now operate in voice activation mode.

Important: *It is generally not recommended to modify other parameters in the configuration file unless you are familiar with their functions, as incorrect settings may affect device performance.*

5.4. Managing Files

To manage your recording files (view, delete, or play back), connect the Vandlion V15 Voice Recorder to a compatible computer (Windows or Mac) or an Android phone using the appropriate data cable. The device will appear as a removable storage drive, allowing you to access and manage your files directly.

Note: iPhone devices are generally not supported for direct file management due to their operating system

restrictions.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Vandlion V15 Voice Recorder, please follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Keep Dry:** Avoid exposing the device to water, moisture, or high humidity, as this can damage internal components.
- **Clean Gently:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the exterior of the recorder. Do not use harsh chemicals, cleaning solvents, or strong detergents.
- **Avoid Extreme Temperatures:** Do not store or operate the device in extremely hot or cold environments, as this can affect battery life and electronic components.
- **Handle with Care:** Avoid dropping the recorder or subjecting it to strong impacts, which can cause physical damage.
- **Regular Charging:** If storing the device for an extended period, charge it periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) to maintain battery health.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Vandlion V15 Voice Recorder, please refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Device not turning on	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Battery is depleted. Charge the device fully.◦ Ensure the ON/OFF switch is firmly in the ON position.
Cannot record	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Device memory is full. Connect to a computer and delete unnecessary files.◦ Battery is too low. Charge the device.◦ Ensure the switch is moved from OFF to ON to initiate recording.
Poor audio quality / Noise in recordings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Microphone is obstructed. Ensure the microphone hole is clear.◦ Recording in a very noisy environment. Move closer to the sound source or to a quieter area.◦ Device rubbing against clothing or surfaces during recording. Keep the device still or in an open space.
Cannot connect to computer / Files not visible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the data cable is securely connected to both the recorder and the computer.◦ Try a different USB port on your computer.◦ Ensure the recorder is powered OFF before connecting to the computer for file access.◦ For Mac users, ensure the device is recognized in Finder. For Windows, check "My Computer" or "This PC".

8. WARRANTY AND SUPPORT

The Vandlion V15 Voice Recorder comes with a **2-year warranty** from the date of purchase, covering

manufacturing defects and malfunctions under normal use.
