# Generic Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed with Built-in Ladder, White - Instruction Manual

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use of this bunk bed. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the recommended weight limits for each bunk. Refer to specifications for details.
- **Top Bunk Safety:** The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age. Ensure children understand proper use of the ladder.
- **Fall Hazard:** Always use the guardrails on the top bunk. Do not allow jumping on the bed.
- **Mattress Size:** Use only mattresses of the specified size to prevent gaps that could trap a child.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all connections and hardware to ensure they are tight and secure.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

- Bunk Bed Frame Components (Headboards, Footboards, Side Rails)
- Ladder
- Bed Slats (for both upper and lower bunks)
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, washers, Allen wrench)

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Assembly typically requires two adults. Clear a spacious area for assembly. Do not fully tighten bolts until all components are loosely assembled.

### Step 1: Unpack and Identify Parts

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Refer to the parts list in your hardware pack to identify each piece.

## Step 2: Assemble the Main Frame

Begin by connecting the headboards and footboards to the side rails for both the upper and lower bunks. Use the provided bolts and an Allen wrench. Ensure all connections are aligned correctly before partially tightening.

### **Step 3: Install Bed Slats**

Place the metal slats onto the designated supports for both the upper and lower bunks. Secure them using the provided hardware. Ensure slats are evenly spaced and firmly attached to provide adequate mattress support.

#### **Step 4: Attach the Ladder and Finalize**

Attach the built-in ladder to the side of the bunk bed frame using the specified hardware. Once all components are in place, go back and fully tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Proper use ensures safety and longevity of your bunk bed.

- **Ladder Use:** Always use the built-in ladder for accessing the top bunk. Face the ladder when climbing up or down.
- **Top Bunk Occupancy:** Only one person should occupy the top bunk at a time.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit jumping, rough play, or hanging from any part of the bunk bed.
- **Lighting:** Ensure adequate lighting near the ladder for safe nighttime use.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance helps preserve the condition and safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Every 3-6 months, inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain structural integrity.
- **Squeak Prevention:** This bed is designed to be squeak resistant. If any squeaking occurs, re-tighten all hardware. Applying a small amount of silicone lubricant to metal-on-metal contact points can also help.

- **Environmental Factors:** Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources to prevent material degradation.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable	Loose hardware connections.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
Squeaking noises	Loose connections or metal-on-metal friction.	Re-tighten all assembly hardware. Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to contact points if necessary.
Ladder feels loose	Ladder attachment hardware is not secure.	Ensure the ladder is correctly installed and all connecting bolts are fully tightened.
