1. INTRODUCTION

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Please follow these step-by-step instructions carefully. It is recommended to assemble the unit with at least two people for ease and safety. Ensure you have enough space for assembly.

3.1 Unpacking and Part Identification

Carefully unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface. Verify that all parts listed in your packaging contents are present before proceeding.

3.2 Step-by-Step Assembly

1. **Attach Leveling Feet:** Screw the leveling feet into the bottom of the main vertical poles. These feet help stabilize the rack on uneven surfaces.

Adjustable Storage Shelves

2. **Install Shelf Clips:** Snap the plastic shelf clips onto the vertical poles at the desired height for your first shelf. Ensure the "TOP" arrow on each clip points upwards and that all clips for a single shelf are at the same height. There should be a small gap when the clips are properly installed.
3. **Place Bottom Shelves:** Carefully slide the bottom wire shelves over the vertical poles, resting them on the installed clips. Ensure the shelves are securely seated and level. The finer grid design of the shelves prevents small items from falling through.

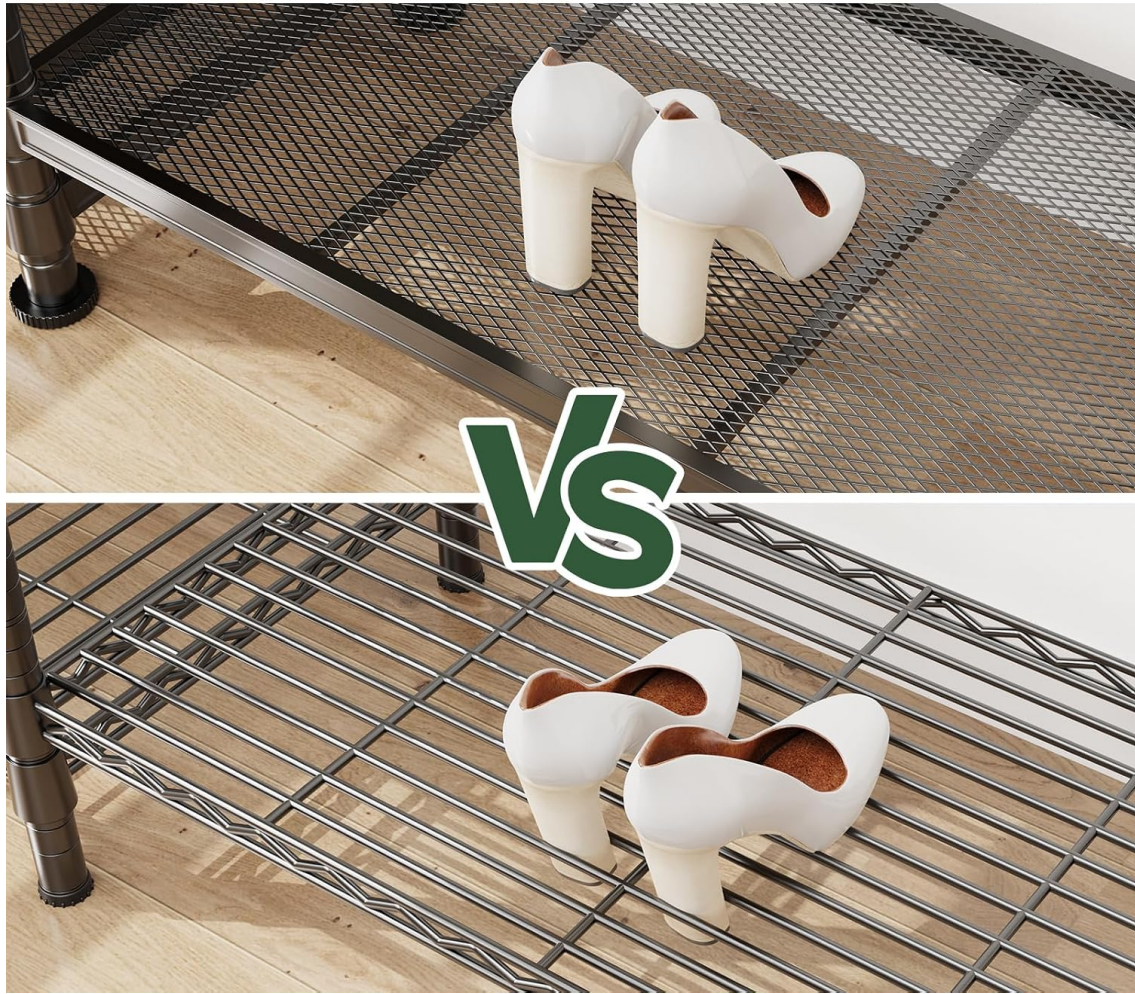


Figure 3.2: Illustration of the finer grid design of the shelves, which provides better support and prevents smaller items from falling through compared to wider grid designs.

4. **Extend Vertical Poles:** If your model includes multi-part vertical poles, connect the upper sections to the lower sections by screwing them together. Ensure they are tightly secured.
5. **Install Additional Shelves:** Repeat steps 2 and 3 for any additional shelves, adjusting the height as needed. The adjustable design allows for customization of storage space.
6. **Attach Hanging Rods:** Secure the hanging rods between the vertical poles at the designated heights. Ensure the connecting rod wave direction is outward for proper fit and stability.
7. **Install Side Hooks:** Attach the four side hooks to the outer vertical poles for additional hanging storage.
8. **Apply Oxford Fabric Cover:** Once the metal frame is fully assembled, drape the Oxford fabric cover over the structure. Zip up the front for dust protection and a neat appearance. The cover features durable zippers, fixed drawstrings, and anti-fall accessory holes for secure attachment.

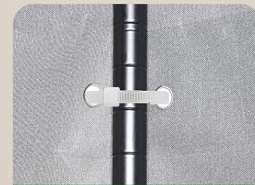

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your LEHOM Garment Rack is straightforward. Here are some tips for optimal use:

- **Adjusting Shelves:** To adjust shelf height, remove the items from the shelf, lift the shelf, reposition the plastic clips on the vertical poles to the desired height, and then lower the shelf onto the new clips. Ensure all clips are at the same level for stability.
- **Utilizing Hanging Rods:** Hang clothes on hangers directly onto the sturdy hanging rods. Distribute weight evenly to prevent bowing.
- **Using the Fabric Cover:** The Oxford fabric cover can be zipped closed to protect your garments from dust and provide a tidy appearance. The front panels can be rolled up and secured with the attached ties for easy access.
- **Side Pockets:** Utilize the side pockets on the fabric cover for storing smaller items like accessories, scarves, or magazines.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your LEHOM Garment Rack:

- **Cleaning the Metal Frame:** Wipe the carbon steel frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as they may damage the black chrome finish.
- **Cleaning the Fabric Cover:** The Oxford fabric cover can be spot cleaned with a mild detergent and water. Allow it to air dry completely before zipping it closed. Do not machine wash or tumble dry.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all connections and ensure screws and clips are secure. Tighten if necessary.
- **Weight Distribution:** Always distribute weight evenly across shelves and hanging rods to maintain stability and prevent damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your garment rack, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Rack is wobbly/unstable.	Uneven floor; loose connections; improperly installed shelf clips.	Adjust the leveling feet until the rack is stable. Check all pole connections and ensure shelf clips are securely snapped into place at the same height.
Shelf not sitting level.	Shelf clips are not at the same height on all poles.	Remove the shelf, re-align the plastic clips to the same groove on each pole, and then re-seat the shelf.
Hanging rod falls off.	Rod not properly seated; excessive weight.	Ensure the hanging rod's ends are fully inserted into their respective slots. Reduce the amount of clothing if overloaded.
Zipper on cover is stuck.	Fabric caught in zipper; zipper misalignment.	Gently pull the fabric away from the zipper path. If misaligned, try to slowly move the slider back and forth to realign. Do not force it.
