PRODUCT OVERVIEW

CONTROLS AND INDICATORS

Familiarize yourself with the speaker's controls and indicators for optimal use.




Image: The side panel of the boAt Stone 352 Pro speaker, highlighting the power button, volume up/down buttons, and mode selection button.

- Power Button: Press and hold to power on/off. Short press to play/pause music.
- Volume Up (+): Short press to increase volume. Long press for next track.
- Volume Down (-): Short press to decrease volume. Long press for previous track.
- Mode (M) Button: Short press to switch between Bluetooth, AUX, and TF Card modes.
- RGB LED Strip: Indicates power status, charging, and provides dynamic lighting effects.

GETTING STARTED

Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge your speaker. The boAt Stone 352 Pro features a Type-C charging port.

- 1. Connect the Type-C end of the charging cable to the speaker's charging port.
- 2. Connect the USB-A end of the cable to a compatible USB power adapter (5V/1A recommended).
- 3. The RGB LED strip will indicate charging status. It typically takes approximately 2 hours for a full charge.
- 4. Once fully charged, disconnect the charging cable.

Powering On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the Power button until you hear an audible prompt and the RGB LEDs illuminate.
- To power off, press and hold the Power button again until you hear an audible prompt and the RGB LEDs turn off.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Bluetooth Connectivity

- 1. Ensure the speaker is powered on and in Bluetooth mode (indicated by a specific LED pattern or audible prompt).
- 2. On your smartphone or audio device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 3. Select "boAt Stone 352 Pro" from the list of devices.
- 4. Once paired, you will hear a confirmation tone, and the speaker's LED will indicate a successful connection.
- 5. The speaker will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when powered on, if the device is within range.

AUX Mode

For wired connections, use the AUX port.

- 1. Connect one end of a 3.5mm AUX cable (not included) to the speaker's AUX port.
- 2. Connect the other end to your audio device's 3.5mm audio output.

- 3. Press the 'M' (Mode) button on the speaker to switch to AUX mode.
- 4. Audio will now play through the speaker from your connected device.

TF Card Playback

Play music directly from a TF (microSD) card.

- 1. Insert a TF card with MP3 audio files into the speaker's TF card slot.
- 2. Press the 'M' (Mode) button to switch to TF Card mode.
- 3. The speaker will automatically begin playing music from the card.

TWS (True Wireless Stereo) Function

Connect two boAt Stone 352 Pro speakers wirelessly for a true stereo sound experience.

- 1. Ensure both speakers are powered on and not connected to any other Bluetooth device.
- 2. On one speaker (this will be the primary speaker), long press the 'M' (Mode) button until you hear a TWS pairing prompt.
- 3. The two speakers will automatically search and pair with each other. A confirmation tone will indicate successful TWS pairing.
- 4. Now, connect your audio device to the primary speaker via Bluetooth as described above.
- 5. Both speakers will play audio in stereo.

Hands-Free Calling

The built-in microphone allows for convenient hands-free calls when connected via Bluetooth.

- When an incoming call is received, press the Power button once to answer.
- To end a call, press the Power button once again.
- To reject an incoming call, long press the Power button.

RGB LED FUNCTIONALITY

The boAt Stone 352 Pro features dynamic RGB LEDs that add a visual element to your audio experience.

- The RGB LEDs automatically cycle through various colors, synchronizing with the music or providing ambient lighting.
- Specific button presses may allow for changing LED modes or turning them off (refer to product-specific quick start guide for advanced controls if available).

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Water Resistance (IPX5): The speaker is IPX5 rated, meaning it is protected against low-pressure water jets from any direction. It is not designed for submersion in water. Ensure the charging port cover is securely closed to maintain water resistance.

- Storage: Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Battery Care: To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the speaker frequently. Charge it regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution			
Speaker does not power on.	Ensure the speaker is charged. Connect it to a power source and try again.			
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	 Ensure the speaker is in Bluetooth pairing mode. Make sure your device's Bluetooth is enabled and within 10 meters of the speaker. Forget the device from your phone's Bluetooth list and try pairing again. Restart both the speaker and your device. 			
No sound or low volume.	 Increase the volume on both the speaker and your connected device. Ensure the speaker is correctly connected (Bluetooth, AUX, or TF Card). Check if the audio source is playing. 			

Problem	Possible Solution		
TWS pairing failed.	 Ensure both speakers are fully charged and not connected to any other device. Repeat the TWS pairing steps carefully. Make sure both speakers are the same model (Stone 352 Pro). 		
Call quality is poor.	 Ensure you are within close proximity to the speaker. Check for any obstructions between the speaker and your phone. Ensure the microphone is not covered.
