AVI-8 Men's Hawker Typhoon Baldwin Automatic Watch AV-4119 Instruction Manual

Model: AV-4119-02

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your AVI-8 Men's Hawker Typhoon Baldwin Automatic Watch, model AV-4119-02. This timepiece features a Japanese Miyota 21-jewel self-winding automatic movement, a 42mm stainless steel case, a genuine leather strap, and an anti-reflection coated sapphire lens. It is water-resistant up to 5 ATM (50 meters).

2. UNBOXING AND INITIAL SETUP

2.1 Unboxing

Carefully remove your watch from its packaging. Inspect the watch for any signs of damage. The watch comes secured in a protective box.

2.2 Setting the Time

1. Gently pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) out to its outermost position.
2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into its original position.

2.3 Winding the Automatic Movement

Your AVI-8 watch is powered by an automatic movement, which means it winds itself through the motion of your wrist. If the watch has stopped or its power reserve is low, you can manually wind it:

- Ensure the crown is in its innermost position (not pulled out).
- Turn the crown clockwise approximately 20-30 times. This will provide enough power for the watch to start running.
- Wearing the watch regularly will keep it wound. The movement has a power reserve of approximately 42 hours when fully wound.

2.4 Adjusting the Leather Strap

The watch features a genuine leather strap with a buckle clasp. To adjust the fit, simply select the appropriate hole on the strap and secure the buckle pin through it. Ensure the fit is snug but comfortable, allowing for proper air circulation.

3. OPERATING THE WATCH

3.1 Understanding the Dial

The AVI-8 Hawker Typhoon Baldwin Automatic Watch features a unique dial design:

- **Main Hands:** The central hour and minute hands indicate the current time.
- **Subdial Seconds:** A smaller subdial at the 6 o'clock position displays the running seconds.
- **Luminous Elements:** Key hour markers and hands are treated with luminous material for visibility in low-light conditions.





3.2 Automatic Movement Overview

The Japanese Miyota automatic movement does not require a battery. It is powered by the natural motion of your arm. When worn daily, the watch will remain wound. If the watch is not worn for an extended period (beyond its 42-hour power reserve), it will stop. Simply wind it manually as described in Section 2.3 or wear it to restart the movement.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

4.1 Water Resistance (5 ATM / 50 Meters)

Your watch is water-resistant up to 5 ATM (50 meters). This means it is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming, showering, and general daily use. It is **not** suitable for diving, snorkeling, or high-impact water sports. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water.

- Avoid operating the crown or pushers when the watch is wet or submerged.
- After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch with fresh water and dry it thoroughly with a soft cloth.

4.2 Cleaning Your Watch

To maintain the appearance of your watch:

- Wipe the case and sapphire lens with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaning materials.

4.3 Leather Strap Care

The genuine leather strap requires specific care to prolong its life:

- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and moisture.
- If the strap gets wet, allow it to air dry naturally, away from direct heat.
- Clean with a soft, damp cloth and a mild leather cleaner if necessary.

4.4 Storage

When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original box or a watch case, to protect it from dust and scratches.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** If the watch has stopped, it likely needs to be wound. Manually wind the watch by turning the crown clockwise 20-30 times while it is in the innermost position. If it still does not run after winding and wearing, contact customer support.
- **Time Inaccuracy:** Automatic movements can experience slight variations in timekeeping. If your watch is consistently gaining or losing a significant amount of time (e.g., more than +/- 30 seconds per day), it may require adjustment by a professional watchmaker.
- **Moisture Under Crystal:** If you notice condensation or moisture under the sapphire lens, this indicates a breach in the water resistance. Immediately take the watch to a qualified watch repair center to prevent further damage to the movement.
