GHUST Voice Remote Control User Manual

Replacement for Panasonic Smart TVs

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the GHUST Voice Remote Control, designed as a direct replacement for various Panasonic Smart TV models. This remote offers precise control and voice search capabilities, enhancing your television viewing experience.

1.1 Compatible TV Models

The GHUST Voice Remote Control is compatible with the following Panasonic TV models:

2. SETUP AND INITIAL USE

2.1 Battery Installation

To begin using your GHUST Voice Remote Control, you will need two (2) AAA batteries (not included).

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.

4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Important: Ensure batteries are inserted with correct polarity. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.

2.2 First Use

No programming or complex setup is required for this replacement remote. Once the batteries are correctly installed, the remote is ready for immediate use with your compatible Panasonic Smart TV. Simply point the remote towards your television and begin operating it.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The GHUST Voice Remote Control features a standard layout with dedicated buttons for various functions. Refer to the image below for a visual guide to the remote's buttons.

3.1 Button Functions

Below is a description of the primary functions of the remote control buttons:

Button	Function
Power (Red Button)	Turns the TV on or off.
Number Pad (0-9)	Direct channel selection or inputting numbers.
LIST	Accesses the channel list or other indexed content.
INFO	Displays information about the current program or input.
VOL (+/-)	Adjusts the volume level up or down.
Mute (Speaker with X)	Mutes or unmutes the TV audio.
P (Channel Up/Down)	Changes the TV channel up or down.
Voice Assistant (Google Assistant icon)	Activates the voice control feature for commands and search.
NETFLIX	Direct access to the Netflix application.
HOME	Returns to the TV's home screen or main menu.
MENU	Opens the TV's main settings or options menu.
Navigation (Up, Down, Left, Right Arrows)	Navigates through menus and selections.
OK	Confirms a selection or enters a menu item.
BACK	Returns to the previous screen or menu.
EXIT	Exits the current menu or application.
GUIDE / REVEAL	Accesses the electronic program guide (EPG) or reveals hidden information.
ZOOM / INDEX	Zooms in/out or accesses an index function.
SOURCE / HOLD	Selects input source or holds a function.
Playback Controls (Rewind, Play, Fast Forward, Pause, Stop)	Controls media playback (e.g., USB, streaming apps).
SUBTITLE	Toggles subtitles on or off.
Color Buttons (R, G, Y, B)	Context-sensitive functions, often used in menus or interactive services.
TEXT	Accesses teletext services.
FAV	Accesses favorite channels or content.
AD	Activates Audio Description for visually impaired users.
I/II	Switches between audio tracks or dual sound modes.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning the Remote

To maintain the remote control's appearance and functionality, wipe it regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the remote's surface or internal components.

4.2 Battery Care

- Remove batteries if the remote control will not be used for an extended period to prevent leakage.
- Dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations.
- If the remote's performance degrades, replace both AAA batteries with new ones.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your GHUST Voice Remote Control, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Remote is not responding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity.◦ Replace old batteries with new AAA batteries.◦ Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's infrared sensor.◦ Point the remote directly at the TV.
Voice control is not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure your TV supports voice control and is properly configured.◦ Check the TV's network connection, as voice features often require internet access.◦ Speak clearly and directly into the remote's microphone.
Specific buttons are not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Clean the remote control, especially around the non-functional buttons, to remove any dirt or debris.◦ Test other buttons to determine if it's an isolated button issue or a general remote problem.
