- Do not operate the dishwasher if it is not properly installed.
- Do not touch the heating element during or immediately after use.
- Use only detergents or rinse agents recommended for use in a dishwasher.
- · Keep children away from detergent and rinse aid.
- Do not allow children to play in or on the appliance.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Do not tamper with controls.
- Ensure the dishwasher is properly grounded.

# **SETUP AND INSTALLATION**

Proper installation is crucial for the optimal performance and safety of your Dacor dishwasher. It is recommended that installation be performed by a qualified installer.

## **Pre-Installation Checklist:**

- Verify water supply (hot water, 120°F/49°C recommended).
- Ensure proper electrical supply (120V, 60Hz, dedicated circuit).

- · Confirm drain line connection availability.
- Prepare cabinet opening dimensions: 24 inches wide, 34-35 inches high, 24 inches deep.

## **Installation Steps (Summary):**

- 1. Unpack the dishwasher and inspect for any shipping damage.
- 2. Connect the water inlet hose to the hot water supply.
- 3. Connect the drain hose to the sink drain or garbage disposal.
- 4. Make electrical connections according to local codes.
- 5. Slide the dishwasher into the cabinet opening.
- 6. Secure the dishwasher to the countertop or side cabinets.
- 7. Install the custom panel (if applicable) to the dishwasher door.
- 8. Level the appliance using the adjustable feet.
- 9. Test for leaks and proper operation.

## **Loading the Dishwasher:**

Proper loading ensures optimal cleaning and drying performance.

- · Scrape off large food particles.
- Place glasses and cups upside down on the upper rack.
- Place plates, bowls, and larger items on the lower rack.
- Load cutlery in the cutlery basket or third rack with handles down for forks/spoons and handles up for knives.
- Ensure spray arms are not blocked by dishes.

# **Adding Detergent and Rinse Aid:**

- Add recommended dishwasher detergent to the dispenser.
- Fill the rinse aid dispenser to the indicated level.

# **Selecting a Wash Cycle:**

Your Dacor dishwasher offers several wash cycles to suit different needs:

Cycle	Description	Typical Use
Auto	Automatically detects soil level and adjusts wash time and temperature.	Everyday use for mixed loads.
Heavy	For heavily soiled dishes, pots, and pans.	Baked-on food, large cookware.
Normal	Standard wash for normal soil levels.	Daily dishes.
Express	Quick wash for lightly soiled dishes.	Lightly soiled items, quick turnaround.
Delicate	Gentle wash for fragile items.	Crystal, fine china.

Refer to the control panel on your dishwasher for specific cycle names and options.

# **Starting a Cycle:**

- 1. Close the dishwasher door firmly.
- 2. Select your desired wash cycle.
- 3. Press the Start button.

# MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficiency of your dishwasher.

# **Cleaning the Filters:**

The dishwasher has a multi-stage filtration system that requires periodic cleaning.



- 1. Turn off the dishwasher and disconnect power.
- 2. Locate the filter assembly at the bottom of the dishwasher tub.
- 3. Twist and remove the coarse filter and fine filter.
- 4. Rinse filters under running water to remove food particles. Use a soft brush if necessary.
- 5. Reassemble the filters and place them back into the dishwasher, ensuring they are securely locked.

# **Cleaning the Interior:**

• Wipe down the interior walls and door gasket regularly with a damp cloth.

• Use a dishwasher cleaner product periodically to remove mineral buildup and odors.

# **Cleaning the Exterior:**

- For stainless steel surfaces, use a soft cloth and a stainless steel cleaner.
- · Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.

## Winterizing (for non-use in cold climates):

- Disconnect power to the dishwasher.
- · Turn off water supply.
- Drain water from the water inlet line and pump.
- Add 1 quart of RV antifreeze to the tub and run a short cycle to circulate.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Before calling for service, review the following common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishwasher does not start	Door not closed properly; Power issue; Cycle not selected.	Ensure door is latched; Check circuit breaker; Select a cycle and press Start.
Dishes not clean	Improper loading; Clogged spray arms; Insufficient detergent; Clogged filters.	Reload dishes correctly; Clean spray arm nozzles; Add more detergent; Clean filters.
Dishwasher not draining	Clogged drain hose; Clogged air gap; Food disposer plug.	Check and clear drain hose; Clean air gap; Remove plug from disposer if new installation.
Excessive noise	Dishes rattling; Foreign object in pump; Motor issue.	Rearrange dishes; Inspect pump area for debris; Contact service if motor noise persists.
Water leaks	Improper installation; Damaged door gasket; Loose hose connections.	Check connections; Inspect and replace gasket if damaged; Ensure proper leveling.
