# Hiicam Speed 60 Action Camera User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

The Hiicam Speed 60 is a versatile action camera designed to capture high-quality video and photos in various environments, including underwater. Featuring 4K 60FPS video recording, 48MP photo capabilities, dual screens, Electronic Image Stabilization (EIS), and HDR, it is built for adventurers. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your camera to ensure optimal performance.

## SETUP

### 1. Battery Installation and Charging

The camera comes with two 2150mAh Lithium Ion batteries. Ensure they are fully charged before first use.

- Open the battery compartment latch on the side of the camera.
- Insert a battery, ensuring the contacts align correctly.
- Close the latch securely.
- To charge, use the included USB-C cable with the battery charger. The charger can charge both batteries sequentially.

## 2. Memory Card Installation

A Micro SD card (not included) is required for recording. Use a high-speed card (U3 or higher) for optimal performance, especially for 4K video.

- Locate the Micro SD card slot, usually next to the battery compartment or under a protective flap.
- Insert the Micro SD card with the contacts facing the correct direction until it clicks into place.
- To remove, gently push the card in until it springs out.

## 3. Waterproof Case Usage

While the camera is natively waterproof to 33FT, the included waterproof housing extends its depth rating to 131FT (40M) and provides additional protection against impacts.

- Before placing the camera in the housing, ensure the housing's seal is clean and free of debris.
- Place the camera carefully into the housing.

- Close the latch securely, ensuring a tight seal.
- Always perform a dry test of the housing without the camera before deep water use.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power/Mode button (usually on the front or side) for a few seconds until the screen lights up.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power/Mode button again until the camera shuts down.

### 2. Mode Switching

Press the Power/Mode button repeatedly to cycle through different modes such as Video, Photo, Playback, and Settings.

### 3. Recording and Capturing

- **Start Recording (Video Mode):** Press the Shutter/OK button (usually on top) once. A red indicator light will flash, and a timer will appear on the screen.
- **Stop Recording:** Press the Shutter/OK button again. The indicator light will stop flashing.
- **Take Photo (Photo Mode):** Press the Shutter/OK button once.

### 4. Playback

- In Playback mode, use the Up/Down buttons or touch screen gestures to navigate through your recorded videos and photos.
- Press the Shutter/OK button to play a video or view a photo in full screen.

### 5. Wi-Fi Connectivity

The built-in 5G Wi-Fi allows for easy connection to your smartphone for remote control, viewing, downloading, and sharing content.

- Enable Wi-Fi on the camera via the settings menu.
- Download the official Hiicam app on your smartphone.
- Connect your phone to the camera's Wi-Fi network (SSID and password usually displayed on the camera screen).
- Use the app to control the camera, preview footage, and transfer files.

## 6. EIS Anti-Shake and HDR

These features enhance video quality, especially in dynamic environments.

- **EIS (Electronic Image Stabilization):** Activate EIS in the camera settings to reduce shakiness and achieve smoother video footage, even during intense activities.
- **HDR (High Dynamic Range):** Enable HDR for improved image quality in scenes with both very bright and very dark areas, ensuring better detail in highlights and shadows.

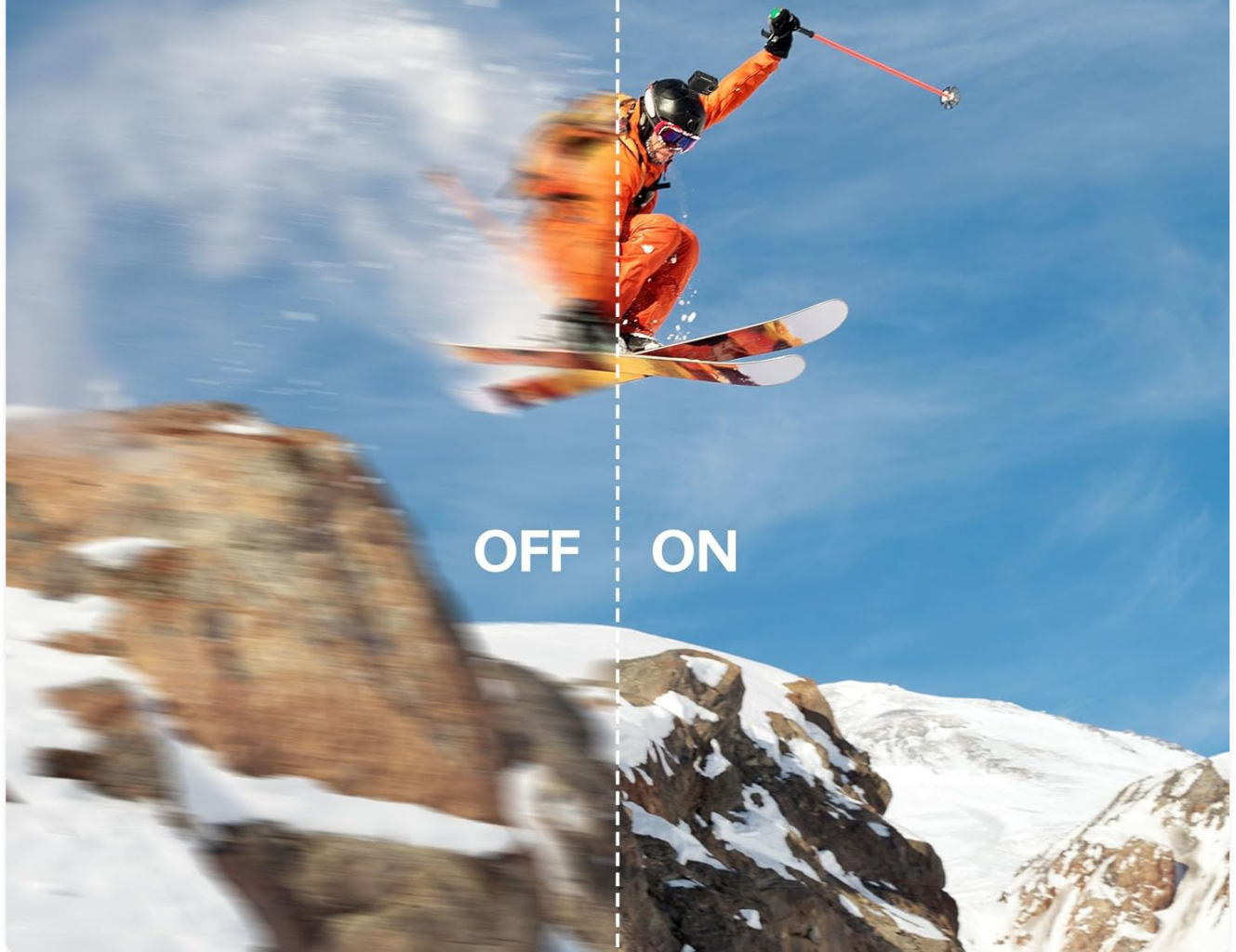

## 7. Zoom Function

The camera supports 8X digital zoom.

- While in video or photo mode, use the zoom controls (often on the touch screen or dedicated buttons) to adjust the zoom level.

## MAINTENANCE

### 1. Cleaning

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the camera body and screens.
- For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution. Avoid abrasive materials.
- Ensure the waterproof case's O-ring seal is clean and free of sand or debris after each use, especially in saltwater.



## 2. Storage

- Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Remove batteries if storing for extended periods to prevent leakage.

## 3. Battery Care

- Charge batteries fully before use.
- Avoid overcharging or completely draining batteries.
- If batteries are not used for a long time, charge them to about 50% every few months.




Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera won't turn on	Low or dead battery; Battery not inserted correctly	Charge battery; Reinsert battery correctly
Cannot record video/take photos	No Micro SD card; SD card full or corrupted; SD card speed too low	Insert Micro SD card; Delete files or format card; Use a U3 or higher speed card
Footage is shaky	EIS is off; Extreme vibration	Enable EIS in settings; Use a more stable mount
Wi-Fi connection issues	Incorrect password; Too far from camera; App issues	Verify password; Move closer to camera; Restart app/camera
Camera freezes	Software glitch; SD card issue	Remove and reinsert battery to reset; Try a different SD card
