INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the VirtuFit Rectangular Frame Pool user manual. This guide provides essential information for the safe and efficient setup, operation, and maintenance of your new pool. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety when using the pool. Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury or death.

- Adult supervision is required at all times for children using the pool.
- Do not dive or jump into the pool. The water depth is not sufficient for diving.
- Keep electrical devices away from the pool area.
- Ensure the pool is set up on a level, stable surface to prevent collapse.
- Regularly check the pool for any signs of damage or leaks.
- Do not allow pets into the pool, as their claws can damage the liner.
- Always use the filter pump as instructed to maintain water quality.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, ensure all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact VirtuFit customer support.

SETUP

Follow these steps for quick and easy assembly of your VirtuFit pool.

- 1. Site Selection:** Choose a flat, level area in your garden, free from sharp objects, debris, or excessive slopes. Ensure there is adequate space around the pool for safe access and maintenance.

2. **Unpack and Lay Out Liner:** Carefully unpack the pool liner and lay it out flat in your chosen location. Allow it to warm up in the sun for a short period to make it more pliable.

3. **Assemble the Frame:**

- Identify the different lengths of frame poles and connectors.
- Connect the horizontal poles to the corner joints to form the rectangular top frame.
- Insert the vertical support poles into the designated sleeves on the pool liner and connect them to the top frame.
- Ensure all connections are secure and the frame is stable.

4. **Install Filter Pump:**

- Attach the filter pump to the designated inlet and outlet connections on the pool liner using the provided hoses and clamps.
- Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.
- Insert the filter cartridge into the pump housing as per the pump's specific instructions.

5. **Fill the Pool:** Begin filling the pool with water. As the water level rises, smooth out any wrinkles in the liner from the center outwards. Stop filling when the water reaches the recommended fill line, typically just below the top frame.

OPERATING

Using your VirtuFit pool is straightforward once set up. Follow these guidelines for optimal enjoyment.

Filter Pump Operation

The included filter pump is crucial for maintaining clean and clear water.

- Connect the pump to a grounded electrical outlet.
- Operate the filter pump for a minimum of 4-6 hours daily, or longer during heavy use, to ensure proper filtration.
- Always turn off and unplug the pump before performing any maintenance or when people are in the pool.

Water Chemistry

Maintaining proper water chemistry is essential for hygiene and pool longevity.

- Regularly test the water pH and chlorine levels using a pool test kit.
- Adjust chemicals as needed to keep pH between 7.2 and 7.6, and chlorine levels within recommended ranges.
- Consult a pool supply professional for specific chemical recommendations and safe handling procedures.

General Use

- Rinse off before entering the pool to reduce contaminants.
- Avoid sharp objects or rough play that could damage the liner.

- Do not overcrowd the pool.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your pool and ensure clean water.

Cleaning the Pool

- **Skimming:** Use a pool skimmer net to remove leaves, insects, and other debris from the water surface daily.
- **Vacuuming:** Periodically vacuum the pool floor to remove settled dirt and debris.
- **Wiping:** Wipe down the pool liner walls with a soft brush or cloth to prevent algae buildup.

Filter Cartridge Care

- Rinse the filter cartridge with a garden hose every few days, or more frequently if the pump flow rate decreases.
- Replace the filter cartridge every 2-4 weeks, depending on usage and water quality.

Winterization (Seasonal Storage)

- Completely drain the pool using the drain plug.
- Clean and dry the pool liner thoroughly to prevent mold and mildew.
- Disassemble the frame and store all components in a dry, protected area, away from extreme temperatures and pests.
- Store the filter pump indoors in a dry, frost-free location.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this section for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water is cloudy/dirty	Insufficient filtration, dirty filter, improper chemical balance	Run pump longer, clean/replace filter cartridge, test and adjust water chemistry.
Pump not running	Not plugged in, power outage, tripped breaker, pump malfunction	Check power connection, reset breaker, contact customer support if pump is faulty.
Water leaking from connections	Loose clamps, damaged O-rings, improper hose connection	Tighten clamps, inspect and replace O-rings if damaged, ensure hoses are properly seated.
Pool liner has a small puncture	Sharp object, wear and tear	Use a vinyl repair kit (not included) to patch the hole.
