INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Amplicomms BigTel 48 Plus telephone.

1. Connecting the Handset

1. Locate the coiled handset cord.
2. Plug one end of the coiled cord into the jack on the side of the telephone base, typically marked with a handset icon.
3. Plug the other end of the coiled cord into the jack on the bottom of the handset. Ensure both connections are

secure.

2. Connecting to the Telephone Line

1. Locate the straight telephone line cord.
2. Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the jack on the back of the telephone base, usually marked with a wall jack icon or "LINE".
3. Plug the other end of the telephone line cord into your telephone wall jack.

3. Power Connection

1. Connect the small end of the power adapter cable into the DC IN jack on the back of the telephone base.
2. Plug the larger end of the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
3. The phone display should illuminate, indicating it is receiving power.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details the basic functions and features of your telephone.

Making a Call

1. Lift the handset from the cradle.
2. Listen for a dial tone.

3. Dial the desired telephone number using the large numeric keypad.
4. Wait for the call to connect.
5. To end the call, place the handset back into the cradle.

Receiving a Call

1. When the phone rings, lift the handset from the cradle to answer the call.
2. To end the call, place the handset back into the cradle.

Adjusting Volume and Audio Boost

The Amplicomms BigTel 48 Plus features an "Audio Boost" function for extra loud handset volume, ideal for users with hearing difficulties. The phone also has a loud ringer.

- **Handset Volume:** During a call, use the volume control buttons (often marked with arrows or +/-) on the side or front of the phone to adjust the handset listening volume.
- **Audio Boost:** Press the dedicated "Audio Boost" button (often marked with a speaker icon and a plus sign, or "AUDIO BOOST" on the display) to activate maximum amplification. The display will show "AUDIO BOOST" when active.
- **Ringer Volume:** Adjust the ringer volume using the switch or button usually located on the side or back of the phone. The ringer can reach up to 90 dB.

Speed Dial (M1/M2 Buttons)

The M1 and M2 buttons allow you to store and quickly dial frequently used numbers.

Programming Speed Dial Numbers:

1. Lift the handset.
2. Press the **STORE** button (if available, or refer to specific manual for programming sequence).
3. Dial the phone number you wish to save.
4. Press the **M1** or **M2** button to assign the number to that memory key.
5. Place the handset back into the cradle.

Using Speed Dial:

1. Lift the handset.
2. Press the **M1** or **M2** button. The stored number will be dialed automatically.

Redial Function

To redial the last number called:

1. Lift the handset.
2. Press the **REDIAL** button (often marked with an 'R' or a curved arrow). The last dialed number will be automatically redialed.

Mute Function

During a call, press the **MUTE** button (if available) to temporarily disable your microphone, allowing you to speak privately without the other party hearing you. Press it again to unmute.

Hearing Aid Compatibility

The Amplicomms BigTel 48 Plus is designed to be compatible with hearing aids. If you use a hearing aid with a T-coil (telecoil) setting, switch your hearing aid to the "T" or "MT" position for an optimized listening experience, reducing background noise and feedback.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity of your telephone.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the telephone's surface. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they may damage the finish.
- **Liquid Exposure:** Keep the telephone away from water and other liquids. If the phone comes into contact with liquid, immediately unplug it from the wall jack and power outlet.
- **Storage:** Store the telephone in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Cords:** Periodically check all cords for damage or fraying. Replace any damaged cords immediately.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your telephone, please refer to the following table for common problems and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No dial tone	Telephone line cord is loose or disconnected.	Ensure the telephone line cord is securely plugged into both the phone and the wall jack.
Cannot hear caller / Caller cannot hear me	Handset volume is too low; Mute function is active; Handset cord is loose.	Increase handset volume. Deactivate Mute. Ensure handset cord is securely connected.
Phone does not ring	Ringer volume is set to off or too low.	Adjust the ringer volume switch/button to an audible level.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is dim or unreadable	Insufficient power; Environmental lighting conditions.	Ensure power adapter is securely connected. Adjust phone's position to avoid glare from light sources.
Buttons are unresponsive	Temporary software glitch; Power issue.	Unplug the power adapter and telephone line cord for 1 minute, then reconnect.
