## INTRODUCTION

The MgaoLo Mini Karaoke Machine is a portable Bluetooth speaker with two wireless microphones, designed for entertainment for kids and adults. It features voice change functions, LED lights, and supports various audio inputs, making it suitable for family gatherings, parties, and personal use.

## Key Features:

- **Fun Voice Change and LED Lights:** Built-in LED light show transforms any room into a concert hall. Includes 6 kinds of funny voice change effects.
- **Immersive, Clear Sound:** Features HI-FI sound quality and advanced technology for powerful, balanced sound with minimal distortion.
- **Easy to Use:** Wireless microphones connect automatically. Stable Bluetooth technology ensures easy connection to phones or tablets. Supports TF-card reading.
- **Bluetooth 5.3:** Offers instant pairing, stable connection, and an impressive range of 35ft without obstacles.
- **Compact and Portable:** Designed for easy transport and use anywhere.

## SETUP GUIDE

### 1. Charging the Device

Before first use, ensure both the karaoke speaker and the wireless microphones are fully charged.

1. Connect the provided USB Type-C charging cable to the charging port on the karaoke speaker.
2. Connect the other end of the charging cable to a compatible USB power adapter (not included).
3. Repeat the charging process for each wireless microphone. A charging indicator light will typically show the charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged.

### 2. Powering On and Pairing

1. **Power On Speaker:** Press and hold the power button on the karaoke speaker until the LED lights illuminate and an audible prompt indicates it's powered on.
2. **Power On Microphones:** Press and hold the power button on each wireless microphone. The microphones will automatically attempt to pair with the speaker. A successful connection is usually indicated by a steady blue light on the microphone.
3. **Bluetooth Connection:** On your smartphone or tablet, enable Bluetooth and search for "Mgaolo T97" (or similar device name). Select it to pair. A confirmation sound will indicate a successful connection.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Speaker Controls:

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off. Short press to switch modes (Bluetooth, TF Card, AUX).
- **Volume Up/Down:** Use '+' and '-' buttons to adjust speaker volume.
- **Play/Pause:** Short press the play/pause button to control music playback.
- **LED Lights:** Short press the light button to cycle through different LED light modes or turn them off.

### Microphone Controls:

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off.
- **Volume Up/Down:** Use '+' and '-' buttons on the microphone to adjust microphone volume.
- **Voice Changer:** Short press the voice changer button to cycle through 6 different voice effects (Original, Baby, Monster, Female, Male, Robot).

### Using with TF Card:

Insert a TF (MicroSD) card with pre-loaded MP3 music into the designated slot on the speaker. The speaker will automatically switch to TF card mode and begin playback.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the speaker and microphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the device frequently. Charge it regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.
- **Water Exposure:** This device is not waterproof. Avoid exposure to water or high humidity.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Sound from Speaker:**
  - Ensure the speaker is powered on and charged.
  - Check the speaker's volume level.
  - Verify Bluetooth connection to your device.

- If using TF card, ensure it's inserted correctly and contains playable audio files.

- **Microphones Not Working:**

- Ensure microphones are powered on and charged.
- Verify microphones are paired with the speaker (indicated by a steady blue light). If not, power cycle both the speaker and microphones.
- Check microphone volume levels.

- **Bluetooth Connection Issues:**

- Ensure the speaker is in Bluetooth mode.
- Move your Bluetooth device closer to the speaker.
- Forget the device from your phone's Bluetooth settings and re-pair.
- Ensure no other devices are actively connected to the speaker.

- **Distorted Sound:**

- Reduce the volume on both the speaker and the connected device.
- Ensure microphones are not too close to the speaker to avoid feedback.
- Check for interference from other electronic devices.
