AECOJOY 123-inch Chicken Coop Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the AECOJOY 123-inch Chicken Coop. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new chicken coop. Please read these instructions thoroughly before assembly and retain them for future reference.

This extra-large chicken coop is designed to provide a secure and comfortable habitat for your poultry. It features a double-layer design with a main house for roosting and a wire-fenced run for outdoor activity. Key features include four nesting boxes, a removable tray for easy cleaning, and roosting bars.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

The coop is constructed from natural fir wood with a waterproof varnish and features galvanized wire mesh for the run areas.

3. Choose a suitable location for the coop. Consider factors like sunlight, shade, drainage, and protection from wind.

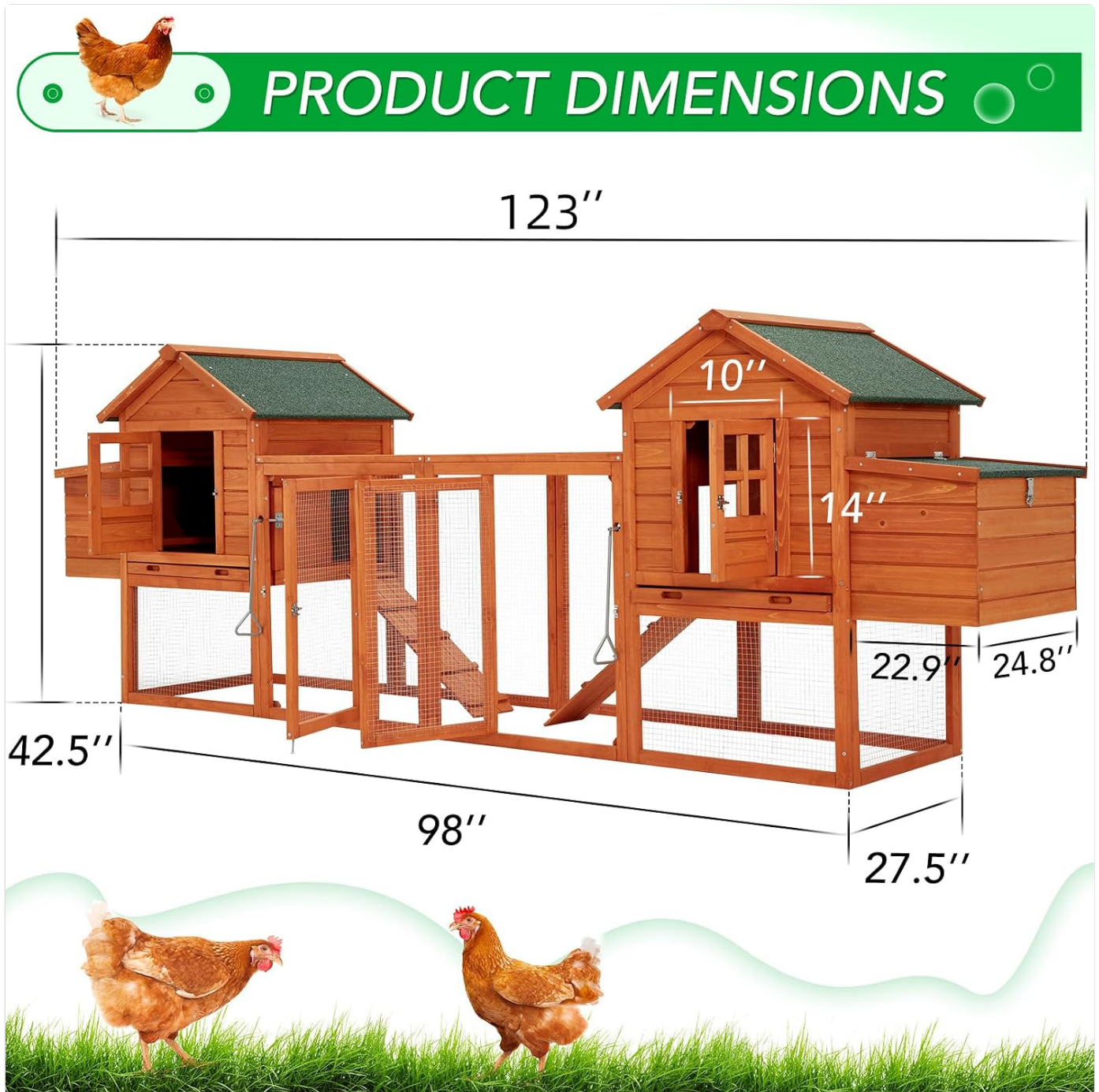


Figure 4.1: Overall dimensions of the chicken coop. The coop measures 123 inches in length, 27.5 inches in width, and 42.5 inches in height. This diagram is crucial for planning the placement of the coop in your yard.

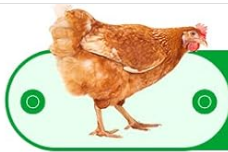
Figure 4.2: The assembled chicken coop featuring multiple entrances and lockable doors. This image demonstrates the various access points for cleaning and tending to chickens, along with the security features.

5. OPERATION

5.1 Access and Security

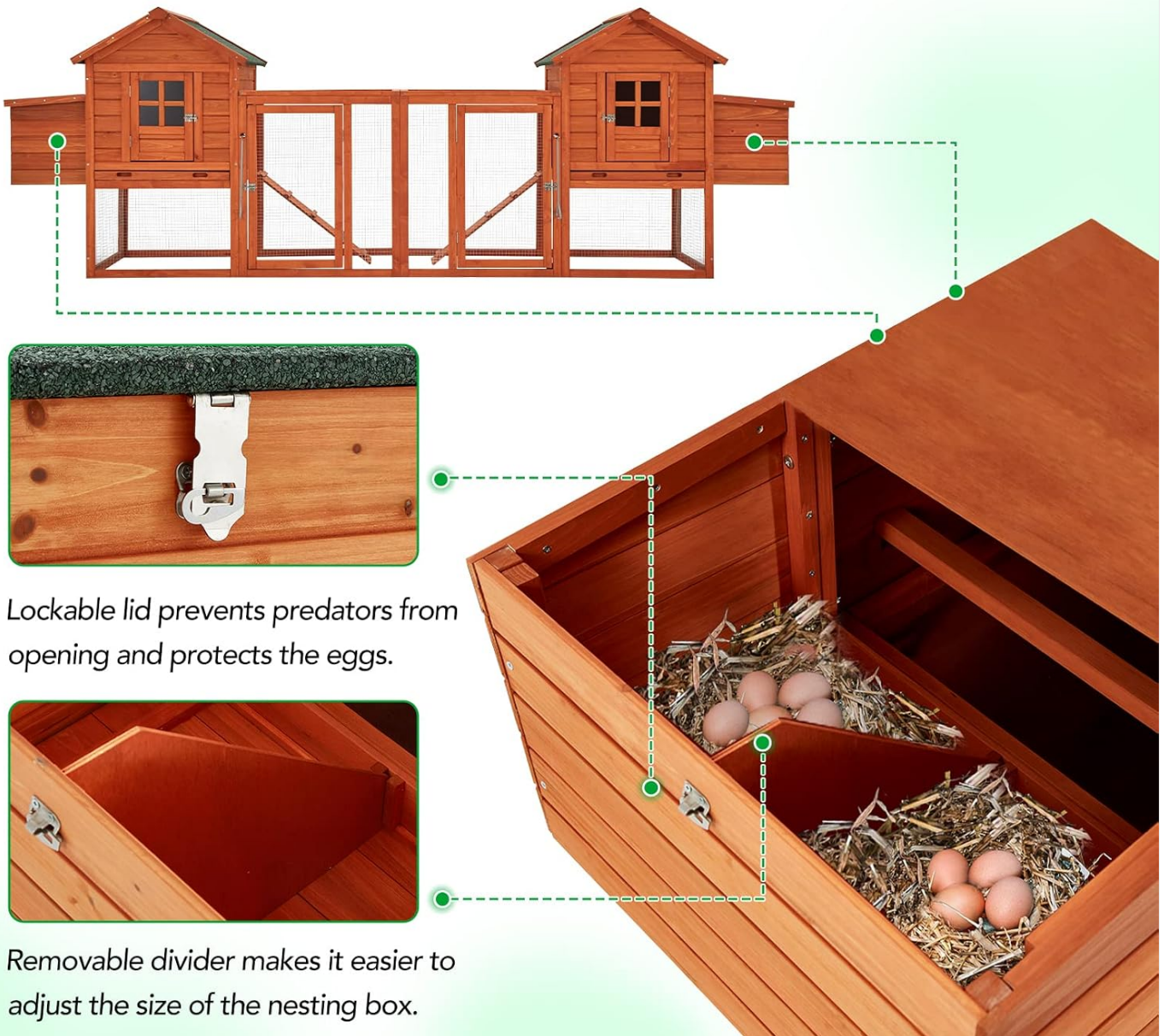
Figure 5.1: Operation of the steel slide handle to control the door between the run and the resting room. This handle allows for easy opening and closing, ensuring the safety of your pets at night.

5.2 Nesting Boxes

The coop includes four nesting boxes for egg laying. These boxes are designed to be easily accessible for egg collection.

Lockable lid prevents predators from opening and protects the eggs.

Removable divider makes it easier to adjust the size of the nesting box.

5.3 Roosting Bars and Ramp

Internal roosting bars provide a place for chickens to perch. A built-in ramp allows chickens to move between the upper main house and the lower run area.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your chicken coop and ensure a healthy environment for your poultry.

- **Cleaning the Removable Tray:** The coop features removable trays for easy cleaning of droppings. Pull out the trays, empty them, clean with a mild disinfectant, and allow to dry completely before reinserting. This should be done regularly to maintain hygiene.
- **Wood Inspection:** Periodically inspect the wooden structure for any signs of wear, rot, or damage. Apply a non-toxic, pet-safe wood sealant annually to protect the wood from moisture and prolong its lifespan.

- **Roof Maintenance:** Check the asphalt roof covering for any tears or damage, especially after strong winds or storms. Repair as needed to maintain its waterproof integrity.
- **Wire Mesh:** Inspect the galvanized wire mesh for any bends, breaks, or rust. Repair or replace damaged sections to prevent escapes or predator entry.
- **Hardware Check:** Ensure all locks, hinges, and fasteners are secure and functioning correctly. Tighten any loose screws.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your chicken coop.

- **Difficulty with Assembly:** If you encounter difficulties during assembly, double-check the diagrams in your physical manual. Ensure all parts are correctly oriented and that you are using the correct fasteners for each step. Sometimes, parts may require slight adjustment to fit properly.
- **Doors Not Closing/Locking Properly:** Check for any obstructions in the door tracks or hinges. Ensure the coop is on a level surface, as uneven ground can cause misalignment. Lubricate hinges if necessary.
- **Wood Splitting:** If minor wood splitting occurs during assembly, it may be due to overtightening screws. Avoid excessive force. For existing splits, a wood filler or sealant can be used for repair.
- **Pest/Predator Entry:** Regularly inspect the entire coop for any small gaps or holes, especially at ground level or where different sections meet. Reinforce weak points with additional wire mesh or wood. Ensure all locks are engaged nightly.
