1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Euhomy Portable Countertop Ice Maker IM-19G is designed to produce bullet-shaped ice cubes efficiently. This compact appliance is suitable for various settings including homes, kitchens, offices, and RVs, providing a convenient solution for your ice needs.

Key Features:

- **Efficient Ice Production:** Produces 9 bullet-shaped ice cubes in approximately 6 minutes, with a daily capacity of up to 26 lbs.
- **User-Friendly Operation:** Simple one-button control with clear indicators for 'ICE FULL' and 'ADD WATER'.
- **Portable Design:** Compact size (9.25 x 11.61 x 11.41 inches) and lightweight (13.7 lbs) with a convenient carry handle for easy transport.
- **Self-Cleaning Function:** Automated cleaning system activated by a simple button press, simplifying maintenance.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, please read all instructions before using the appliance. Retain this manual for future reference.

- Always connect to a grounded power outlet.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or any part of the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Supervise children when the appliance is in use.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after it malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Use only potable water in the ice maker.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Maintain a minimum of 5 inches (12.7 cm) clearance on all sides.
- Do not place the appliance near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or when not in use for extended periods.
- Do not attempt to repair or replace any part of your ice maker unless specifically recommended

in this manual.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- Euhomy Portable Countertop Ice Maker
- Ice Scoop
- Ice Basket

4. INITIAL SETUP

Follow these steps to prepare your ice maker for first use:

1. **Unpack the Appliance:** Carefully remove the ice maker and all accessories from its packaging.
2. **Position the Ice Maker:** Place the unit on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is at least 5 inches (12.7 cm) of space around the unit for proper ventilation.
3. **Clean the Interior:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker, including the water reservoir and ice basket, with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and wipe dry.
4. **Allow to Rest:** After transport, allow the ice maker to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle.
5. **Add Water:** Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill.
6. **Connect Power:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Making Ice

1. Ensure the ice maker is plugged in and the water reservoir is filled.
2. Press the **ON/OFF** button on the control panel to start the ice-making cycle. The indicator light will illuminate.
3. The ice maker will begin producing ice. The first batch of ice may take slightly longer to form.
4. Ice cubes will drop into the ice basket. When the basket is full, the 'ICE FULL' indicator will light up, and the ice maker will pause operation.
5. Remove ice from the basket as needed. The ice maker will resume operation once ice is removed and the 'ICE FULL' sensor is clear.
6. If the 'ADD WATER' indicator lights up, the water reservoir is low. Add more potable water and press the **ON/OFF** button to restart the cycle.

5.2 Control Panel Indicators

- **ICE FULL:** Illuminates when the ice basket is full. The ice maker will temporarily stop producing ice.
- **ADD WATER:** Illuminates when the water reservoir needs refilling. The ice maker will pause operation until water is added.
- **ON/OFF Button:** Press to start or stop the ice-making process. Press and hold for approximately 5 seconds to activate the self-cleaning function.

6. SELF-CLEANING FUNCTION

The ice maker features an automatic self-cleaning system to maintain hygiene and reduce mineral buildup.

1. Ensure the ice maker is empty of ice and the water reservoir is filled with clean water.
2. Press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for approximately 5 seconds. The self-cleaning cycle will begin.

3. The cleaning process typically takes about 15 minutes, circulating water through the system.
4. Once the cycle is complete, drain the water from the reservoir by removing the drain plug located at the bottom of the unit.
5. Rinse the interior with fresh water and drain again to remove any residue.
6. Wipe the interior dry with a soft cloth.

7. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and proper care will extend the life of your ice maker.

- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Interior Cleaning:** Perform the self-cleaning function regularly, especially if the ice maker is used frequently or if you notice mineral buildup.
- **Drainage:** Periodically drain any remaining water from the reservoir, especially if the unit will not be used for an extended period.

- **Storage:** When storing the ice maker, ensure it is clean and dry. Store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Air Filter:** Check and clean the air filter (if applicable, refer to diagram) regularly to ensure proper ventilation and efficient operation.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; 'ADD WATER' indicator on.	Fill water reservoir to MAX line and restart.
Ice maker not producing ice.	Ice basket is full; 'ICE FULL' indicator on.	Remove ice from the basket.
Ice cubes are small or cloudy.	Water temperature too high; ambient temperature too high.	Use colder water; ensure unit is in a cool, well-ventilated area.
Unit is noisy during operation.	Normal operation sounds (compressor, water pump).	This is normal. Ensure unit is on a stable, level surface.
Water leaks from the unit.	Drain plug not properly sealed.	Ensure the drain plug is securely in place.






Image 9.1: The compact design of the Euhomy ice maker, with its dimensions clearly indicated for reference.
