1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the tectake® Titan Wooden Rowing Machine. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, assembly, and maintenance of your new fitness equipment. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and keep it for future reference.



2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Consult a physician before starting any exercise program.
- Ensure all parts are securely assembled before each use. Refer to the assembly instructions.
- Keep children and pets away from the machine during operation.
- Place the rowing machine on a flat, stable surface.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 150 kg.
- · Wear appropriate athletic footwear and clothing.
- Stop exercising immediately if you feel faint, dizzy, or experience pain.
- Regularly inspect the machine for wear and tear, especially the moving parts and water tank.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The tectake® Titan Rowing Machine requires assembly. Detailed assembly instructions are included in the packaging. Please follow them carefully.

3.1 Unpacking

- 1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- 2. Verify that all parts listed in the assembly instructions are present.
- 3. Keep packaging materials until assembly is complete in case of missing parts or return.

3.2 Water Tank Filling

The rowing machine uses a water resistance system.

- · Locate the water tank cap.
- Use the provided siphon pump to fill the tank with clean tap water.
- Fill the tank to the desired resistance level. The tank has a capacity of 6 liters and offers 4 different difficulty levels.
- Add a water purification tablet (if provided) to prevent algae growth.
- · Securely close the water tank cap.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Adjusting Foot Pedals

The foot pedals are adjustable to accommodate different foot sizes.

- Adjust the pedals to one of the6 available sizes.
- Secure your feet with the adjustable straps.




Image: The adjustable foot pedals of the tectake® Titan Rowing Machine, showing the multiple size settings and secure foot straps.

4.2 Using the LED Display

The integrated LED display provides real-time workout data.

- The display shows important training data such as **distance**, **time**, **speed**, **strokes**, **calories burned**, **and heart** rate (with compatible chest strap).
- Connect a compatible Bluetooth chest strap for heart rate monitoring.
- Use the buttons on the display to navigate through modes and reset values.

4.3 Proper Rowing Technique

To maximize effectiveness and prevent injury, maintain proper rowing form:

- 1. Catch: Lean forward from the hips, arms extended, shins vertical.
- 2. **Drive:** Push off with your legs, then swing your back, and finally pull with your arms.
- 3. Finish: Lean slightly back, legs extended, handle at your lower ribs.
- 4. Recovery: Extend arms, lean forward from hips, then bend knees to slide forward.




Image: A user demonstrating the correct posture and movement on the tectake® Titan Rowing Machine, illustrating the full body engagement during a rowing stroke.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Cleaning: Wipe down the machine with a damp cloth after each use. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Water Tank: Change the water in the tank every 6-12 months, or if it appears discolored. Use purification tablets as needed.
- Moving Parts: Periodically check all bolts, nuts, and moving parts for tightness and wear. Lubricate as necessary.
- Storage: The rowing machine is foldable for space-saving storage. Utilize the integrated wheels for easy transport.



6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No display on LED screen	Batteries are dead or incorrectly installed.	Replace batteries or ensure they are inserted correctly.
Resistance feels too low/high	Water level in tank is incorrect or resistance knob is not set.	Adjust water level using the siphon pump or turn the resistance knob.
Unusual noises during operation	Loose bolts or worn components.	Check all connections and moving parts for tightness. Lubricate if necessary.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Heart rate monitor not connecting	Chest strap not paired or out of range; low battery in strap.	Ensure chest strap is worn correctly and within range. Replace strap battery if needed. Refer to chest strap manual.


