SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The floor brush assembly is designed for easy attachment and detachment from your TROUVER POWER 12 vacuum cleaner.

- Preparation:** Ensure your TROUVER POWER 12 vacuum cleaner is turned off and unplugged (if applicable) before attaching or detaching any accessories.
- Attachment:** Align the connection point of the WALDOR Floor Brush Assembly with the corresponding port on your vacuum cleaner's main body or extension wand. Push firmly until you hear a click, indicating a secure connection.
- Detachment:** To remove the brush assembly, locate the release button or latch on the connection point (refer to your vacuum cleaner's manual if unsure). Press the button and gently pull the brush assembly away from the vacuum cleaner.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- General Use:** Once securely attached, operate your TROUVER POWER 12 vacuum cleaner as usual. The brush assembly will rotate to agitate and collect dirt from the floor surface.
- Floor Types:** The brush is designed to be effective on both hard floors and soft surfaces. For delicate hard floors, ensure the brush is clean to prevent scratching.
- Optimal Performance:** Move the vacuum cleaner slowly and steadily over the area to be cleaned to allow the brush to effectively pick up debris.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Brush roller not spinning.	Hair or debris tangled around the brush roller.	Turn off the vacuum. Remove the brush roller and clean it thoroughly as described in the Maintenance section.
Reduced suction when using the brush.	Blockage in the brush head or connection port.	Check the brush head and the vacuum's connection port for any obstructions and remove them. Ensure the brush is securely attached.
Unusual noise from the brush head.	Debris caught in the brush mechanism or worn parts.	Inspect the brush roller and its housing for any foreign objects. If the noise persists after cleaning, contact customer support.
