## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and effective use of your HTC Men's Hair Clippers & Beard Trimmer Grooming Kit. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

- Ensure the device is fully charged before cordless operation to prevent power interruptions.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW & WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your HTC Grooming Kit is an all-in-one solution for hair and beard trimming, designed for versatility and ease of use.

- Main Clipper Unit (Model AT-129C)
- 4 Adjustable Guide Combs (3mm, 6mm, 9mm, 12mm)
- USB Charging Cable
- Cleaning Brush
- Lubricating Oil

## SETUP

### 1. Charging the Device

The HTC AT-129C can be used both corded and cordless. For cordless use, ensure the device is fully charged. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the charging port at the bottom of the clipper and plug the other end into a standard USB power source (e.g., computer, wall adapter).

A full charge typically provides 60 minutes of operating time. The charging indicator light will illuminate during charging.

## 2. Attaching Guide Combs

Select the desired guide comb (3mm, 6mm, 9mm, or 12mm) based on your preferred hair length. Align the comb with the clipper blade and push it firmly until it clicks into place. To remove, gently pull the comb away from the blade.

### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 1. Powering On/Off

Slide the power switch located on the front of the clipper to the 'ON' position to start the device. Slide it to 'OFF' to power down.

#### 2. Hair Trimming

For haircuts, attach the appropriate guide comb. Start with a longer comb if unsure, and gradually switch to shorter combs for desired length. Move the clipper against the direction of hair growth for an even cut.

### 3. Beard and Body Trimming

The clipper can be used for beard, mustache, sideburns, goatees, stubble, and other body hair. Use without a guide comb for a close 'zero cut' trim, or with a guide comb for desired length. Always ensure the skin is clean and dry before trimming.

### **MAINTENANCE**

#### **1. Cleaning**

The HTC AT-129C features an IPX7 waterproof design, allowing for easy cleaning. After each use, remove the guide comb and rinse the clipper head directly under running water to remove hair clippings. Ensure the device is powered off before cleaning.

Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any stubborn hair particles. Allow the clipper to air dry completely before storing or recharging.

## 2. Lubrication

Periodically apply a small drop of the provided lubricating oil to the blades to maintain optimal performance and extend blade life. Turn the clipper on for a few seconds after oiling to distribute the oil evenly.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Clipper not turning on:** Ensure the device is fully charged. If using corded, check the power connection.

- **Reduced cutting performance:** Clean the blades thoroughly and apply lubricating oil. Ensure the guide comb is correctly attached.
- **Unusual noise:** Clean the blades and check for any obstructions. If the issue persists, contact customer support.




