1. Introduction

The Breville Paradice 9 Food Processor and Dicer is designed for precision and performance in a compact form. This appliance simplifies food preparation with its versatile functions and integrated storage solutions. This manual provides essential information for safe operation, assembly, use, cleaning, and maintenance of your food processor.

The Breville Paradice 9 offers high performance in a small footprint, making food preparation easier and more efficient. It features a heavy-duty induction motor and durable, BPA-free components.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always read all instructions before operating the appliance. Misuse can result in injury. Keep hands and utensils out of the processing bowl while operating to reduce the risk of severe injury to persons or damage to the food processor. Never add food by hand when the appliance is operating. Use the food pusher provided.

Important: This product is designed for household use only. Do not use outdoors. Ensure the appliance is unplugged from the power outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.

The bowl and lid are made from tough, BPA-free materials to withstand everyday use. Breville makes its BPA Free claim for this product based on independent laboratory testing performed for all the food contact plastic materials of the product per EU Commission Regulation No 10/2011.




Image: Close-up of the BPA-free food processor bowl, highlighting its durable construction.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, wash all parts that come into contact with food in warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly. Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface.

- 1. Place the motor base on a dry, level countertop.
- 2. Position the processing bowl onto the motor base, aligning the handle with the front of the base. Rotate clockwise until it locks into place.
- 3. Insert the desired attachment (e.g., S-Blade, dough blade, dicing kit, shredding disc, or slicing disc) onto the central spindle in the bowl.

- 4. Place the lid onto the processing bowl, aligning the lid's handle with the bowl's handle. Rotate clockwise until it locks securely.
- 5. Insert the food pusher into the feed chute.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Breville Paradice 9 features intuitive controls for various food preparation tasks.

General Operation:

- Ensure the food processor is correctly assembled and locked.
- Plug the appliance into a power outlet. The power button will illuminate.
- Add ingredients to the processing bowl or feed chute as required by the attachment.
- Press the 'ON/OFF' button to start continuous operation, or the 'PULSE' button for intermittent processing.
- Always use the food pusher when adding ingredients through the feed chute.

Using the Dicing Kit:

The Paradice Kit includes a large half grid and blade system for 0.5-inch dicing. This is ideal for achieving precise and even cubes in a single push, especially with the wide feed chute.

Using the Wide Feed Chute:

The 4.7-inch 2-in-1 wide feed chute is designed to accommodate different shapes and sizes of ingredients, allowing for easy and fast preparation of items like nuts, onions, garlic, and various vegetables.





5. ATTACHMENTS AND FEATURES EXPLAINED

The Breville Paradice 9 comes with a range of color-coded accessories for easy identification and use:

- S-Blade: For chopping, mixing, and pureeing.
- **Dough Blade:** Specifically designed for kneading dough.
- Reversible Shredder (Coarse & Fine): For shredding various ingredients like cheese or vegetables.
- Adjustable Slicer (15 levels): Allows for precise slicing thickness from paper-thin to thick.
- 0.5 Paradice Kit: For consistent 0.5-inch dicing.

6. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Proper cleaning and maintenance ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your food processor.

- Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.
- The processing bowl, lid, and all accessories are dishwasher safe. Place them on the top rack of your dishwasher.
- For manual cleaning, wash parts in warm, soapy water using a soft cloth or sponge. Rinse thoroughly and dry immediately.
- The motor base should be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid.
- Blades are extremely sharp. Handle with care during cleaning and assembly.

7. STORAGE

The Breville Paradice 9 features an integrated storage caddy designed to keep all accessories organized and easily accessible within the bowl, minimizing counter and cabinet space requirements.

- After cleaning and drying, store the S-blade, reversible shredder, adjustable slicer, dough blade, and dicing kit components in the onboard storage caddy.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before storing to prevent moisture buildup.
- The compact design allows the entire unit to fit neatly under most kitchen cabinets.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Breville Paradice 9, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Appliance does not turn on:** Ensure the processing bowl and lid are correctly assembled and locked into place. Check that the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.
- Motor stops during operation: The appliance may have overheated. Unplug it and allow it to cool down for at least 30 minutes before attempting to use it again. Reduce the load size for future use.
- Ingredients are not processing evenly: Ensure ingredients are cut into appropriate sizes before
 adding them to the feed chute. Do not overfill the bowl. Use the pulse function for better control over
 consistency.
- Loud noise during operation: This may indicate an overloaded motor or improper assembly of attachments. Reduce the load or reassemble the parts correctly.




Image: Close-up of the heavy-duty high torque induction motor, emphasizing its robust construction.
