## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the safe and effective use of your Handheld Steam Cleaner, model WHL-609. This pressurized multi-surface steam cleaner is designed for various household cleaning tasks, utilizing high-temperature steam for chemical-free cleaning.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety warnings and instructions before using this appliance. Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always ensure the safety cap is securely closed during operation.
- **Do not open the safety cap while the steam cleaner is under high pressure or hot.**Wait for the unit to cool down completely before attempting to open the cap.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not direct steam at people, animals, or electrical appliances.
- Use only distilled or demineralized water to prevent mineral buildup and extend the life of the appliance.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use and before performing any maintenance.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.



# Vapor Safety Cap

Prevent scald during wrong operator

When the steam cleaner is in high pressure, please don't open the button cap so as to protect you and your child from hurting in hot steam. When the water temperature cools down, the pressure valve can be opened counterclockwise



**Image: Vapor Safety Cap.** This image shows the safety cap on the steam cleaner. The cap prevents scalding during operation. It should only be opened counterclockwise when the steam cleaner is cool and not under pressure.

## PRODUCT COMPONENTS AND ACCESSORIES

---

Your WHL-609 Handheld Steam Cleaner comes with a variety of accessories designed for different cleaning tasks. Familiarize yourself with each component before use.



**Image: Steam Cleaner Accessories.** This image displays the handheld steam cleaner along with its 9 included accessories: Nozzle Head, Window Wiper, Extension Hose, Angled Nozzle Head, Long Cord, Brush Head, and Steam Iron attachment. Each accessory is designed for specific cleaning applications.

- **Nozzle Head:** Ideal for ceramic tile crevices and car interiors.
- **Window Wiper:** For cleaning window glass and bathroom mirrors.
- **Extension Hose:** Provides extended reach for cleaning kitchen ventilators, ventilating fans, and bathrooms.
- **Angled Nozzle Head:** Useful for air conditioners, window gaps, and toilet walls.
- **Brush Head:** Designed for cleaning gas stoves, induction cookers, and sinks.
- **Steam Iron Attachment:** For steaming clothes, sofas, and blankets.
- **Measuring Cup and Funnel:** For accurate and easy water filling.
- **Long Power Cord (9.8 ft/3m):** Provides ample reach without frequent unplugging.

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to prepare your steam cleaner for use:



1. **Open the Safety Cap:** Ensure the unit is cool and unplugged. Turn the safety cap counterclockwise to open.
2. **Fill with Water:** Use the provided measuring cup and funnel to add approximately 250ml of water into the water tank. Do not overfill.
3. **Close the Safety Cap:** Securely close the safety cap by turning it clockwise until tight.
4. **Attach Accessories:** Select the appropriate accessory for your cleaning task and firmly attach it to the nozzle.
5. **Plug In:** Connect the power cord to a grounded electrical outlet.
6. **Heat Up:** The power button will illuminate (e.g., red) indicating the unit is heating. Wait 3-4 minutes for the steam cleaner to reach operating temperature.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the steam cleaner is heated and ready, you can begin cleaning.

- **Steam Release:** Press the steam trigger to release steam. Release the trigger to stop the steam flow.

- **High Temperature Steam:** The unit releases steam at approximately 230°F (110°C) for effective cleaning and sanitization.

- **Cleaning Surfaces:**

- For general surfaces like tile, grout, and windows, hold the nozzle close to the surface and move it slowly to allow the steam to penetrate and loosen dirt.
- For upholstery and fabrics (e.g., couches, blankets), use the steam iron attachment. Test on an inconspicuous area first.

- For stubborn grease and grime on stoves or sinks, use the brush head attachment.

## 9.8 Feet Charging Cord

Don't worry about distance!

- The long power cord (9.8 feet) allows for extended reach, useful for cleaning car wheel hubs or outdoor barbecue grills.
- **Chemical-Free Cleaning:** The steam cleaner uses only water, providing a cleaning solution safe for use around family and pets.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your steam cleaner.

- **After Each Use:**

1. Unplug the unit and allow it to cool completely.
2. Carefully open the safety cap and empty any remaining water from the tank.
3. Wipe down the exterior of the unit with a damp cloth.
4. Clean any used accessories with water and mild soap, then allow them to air dry.

- **Descaling:** Depending on water hardness, mineral deposits may build up over time.



- If you notice reduced steam output or unusual noises, descaling may be necessary.
- Consult the manufacturer's website or contact support for specific descaling instructions. Generally, a solution of white vinegar and water can be used, followed by thorough rinsing.
- **Storage:** Store the steam cleaner and its accessories in a cool, dry place, out of direct sunlight and away from children.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this section for solutions to common issues you might encounter.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or low steam output.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No water in the tank.</li><li>• Unit not heated sufficiently.</li><li>• Mineral buildup (scale).</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Add water to the tank.</li><li>• Wait 3-4 minutes for the unit to heat up.</li><li>• Perform descaling procedure.</li></ul>
Water dripping from nozzle.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Unit not fully heated.</li><li>• Condensation inside the hose/nozzle.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Allow more time for the unit to heat up.</li><li>• Point the nozzle away from the cleaning surface and press the trigger until only steam is released.</li></ul>
Safety cap cannot be opened.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Unit is still under pressure or hot.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Unplug the unit and allow it to cool down completely before attempting to open the cap.</li></ul>
