1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Tenveo 4K PTZ Conference Room Camera System. This system is designed to deliver high-quality audio and video for professional conferencing environments, featuring a 4K PTZ camera with 12x optical zoom, a Bluetooth speakerphone, and two expansion microphones.

Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your conferencing experience.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Tenveo VA512Group-EX system integrates a high-definition camera, speakerphone, and hub for a comprehensive conferencing solution.

3.1 Key Components

- **4K PTZ Camera:** Features a 1/2.8-inch CMOS sensor, 12x optical zoom, 78° viewing angle, 350° pan, and 180° tilt. Supports 10 preset positions.
- **Bluetooth Speakerphone:** Equipped with a DSP audio processor, high-fidelity speaker, intelligent noise reduction, and automatic echo cancellation.
- Expansion Microphones: Two omnidirectional microphones extend the voice pickup range for larger rooms.
- Hub: Central connection point for the camera, speakerphone, and expansion microphones.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Tenveo conference system.

4.1 Connecting Components

- 1. Connect the 4K PTZ Camera to the Hub using one of the provided 5m DP cables. Ensure the correct port is used (refer to the port diagram).
- 2. Connect the Bluetooth Speakerphone to the Hub using the other 5m DP cable.
- 3. Connect the two Expansion Microphones to the Speakerphone.
- 4. Connect the Hub to a power source using the DC 12V/2A Power Adapter.
- 5. Connect the Hub to your computer (Windows 7/8.1/10 or Mac OS X 10.7 or higher) using the 3m USB cable.

4.2 Initial Power On

Once all connections are secure, power on the Hub. The system is plug-and-play, and your computer should automatically detect the devices. You may need to select the Tenveo system as your audio and video input/output device within your conferencing software (e.g., Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Webex).

Important Notice:

- The PTZ 4K Camera and microphone must be connected to the Hub for proper operation.
- The camera interface in this VLGroup system differs from the separate VL12U camera interface. Refer to product images for details.

5. OPERATION

The system can be controlled via the included remote control or directly from the speakerphone.

5.1 Camera Control (PTZ & Zoom)

- Pan/Tilt: Use the directional arrows on the remote or speakerphone to adjust the camera's horizontal (pan up to 350°) and vertical (tilt up to 180°) position.
- **Zoom:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the remote or speakerphone to control the 12x optical zoom.
- **Presets:** The camera supports 10 preset positions. To save a preset, move the camera to the desired position and zoom level, then press and hold a number button (1-10) on the remote for 5 seconds. To recall a preset, simply press the corresponding number button. The 'C' button on the speakerphone or 'Home' button on the remote returns the camera to its default home position.

5.2 Audio Control

- Volume: Adjust the speaker volume using the '+' and '-' buttons on the speakerphone or remote.
- **Mute:** Press the microphone mute button on the speakerphone to mute all microphones. Press again to unmute. The speakerphone also has a mute button for the speaker.
- Call Management: Use the call answer/end buttons on the speakerphone for managing calls when connected via Bluetooth.

5.3 Bluetooth Functionality

The speakerphone supports Bluetooth connectivity for use with smartphones or other compatible devices.

- 1. Press the Bluetooth button on the speakerphone to activate pairing mode.
- 2. On your device, search for and select the Tenveo speakerphone to pair.
- 3. Once paired, you can use the speakerphone for audio calls from your connected device.

5.4 Software Compatibility

The system is compatible with major conferencing platforms including Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Webex, Skype for Business, Voovmeeting, and CISCO WebEx. It supports Windows 7/8.1/10 and Mac OS X 10.7 or higher.



7. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera lens and device surfaces. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the system in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Cable Management: Ensure cables are not kinked or strained to prevent damage.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your system, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

• No Video Output:

- Ensure the camera is properly connected to the Hub and the Hub is powered on.
- Verify the USB cable connection between the Hub and your computer.
- Check your conferencing software settings to ensure the Tenveo camera is selected as the video input device.

• No Audio Input/Output:

- · Confirm the speakerphone and expansion microphones are correctly connected to the Hub.
- Check volume levels on the speakerphone, computer, and conferencing software.
- Ensure microphones are not muted.
- If experiencing crackling audio, check the DP cables for damage or ensure they are fully seated.

• PTZ Control Not Responding:

- $\circ~$ Ensure the remote control has fresh batteries and is pointed at the camera.
- Verify the speakerphone is powered on and connected to the Hub.
- Allow a few seconds between commands, especially after rapid camera movements.

• Compatibility Issues (e.g., Windows 11):

- Ensure your operating system and conferencing software are up to date.
- Contact Tenveo support for potential firmware updates or specific driver information.
