3. **Maintain Fire:** As logs burn down, the self-feeding mechanism allows new logs to be stacked on top without obstructing the fresh air draft, promoting continuous and efficient combustion.
4. **Smoke Management:** The enhanced airflow and complete combustion facilitated by the grate design help minimize smoke emission into the room.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** After each use and once the grate has completely cooled, remove any ash or unburned wood residue. A stiff brush can be used to clean the bars.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the grate for any signs of wear, damage, or deformation. While made from durable steel, extreme conditions or impacts can affect its integrity.
- **Storage:** If storing the grate for an extended period, ensure it is clean and dry to prevent rust, although the powder-coated finish offers protection.

## TROUBLESHOOTING



Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty igniting fire	Insufficient kindling or poor airflow.	Ensure adequate kindling is used. Check for proper placement of logs to allow airflow.
Excessive smoke	Damp wood, insufficient draft, or improper log placement.	Use dry, seasoned wood. Ensure chimney damper is fully open. Re-arrange logs for better airflow.
Grate feels unstable	Components not fully interlocked or tightened.	Re-check assembly to ensure all pieces are securely fitted. Tighten connections with tools if necessary.
Logs not burning completely	Lack of oxygen or damp wood.	Ensure logs are dry. Adjust log placement to maximize air exposure. Clear ash buildup from beneath the grate.



