# PETLIBRO Automatic Cat Feeder User Manual

Model: PLAF008

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the PETLIBRO Automatic Cat Feeder. This device is designed to provide scheduled and portion-controlled meals for your pets, ensuring a consistent and healthy feeding routine. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to help you get the most out of your feeder.

The PETLIBRO Automatic Cat Feeder features a 2-liter food tank, an LCD screen for easy programming, and dual power options (DC 5V power adapter or 3 x D alkaline batteries). It is suitable for cats and small to medium dogs, and designed for dry pet food with kibble sizes between 2-15mm (0.078-0.6 inches) in diameter.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions carefully before operating the feeder.
- Use only the original 5V power supply provided with the feeder.
- Do not immerse the feeder base in water or any other liquid. The base can only be wiped with a dry cloth.
- Keep the feeder away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Ensure the feeder is placed on a stable, level surface.
- This appliance is for indoor use only.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets when not in use or during cleaning.
- Change batteries every 6 months if not in use for a long time to prevent leakage.
- Only fill with dry pet food.

## SETUP

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### 1. Assembly

1. Place the feeder base on a stable, level surface.
2. Insert the bowl tray into the designated slot on the front of the feeder base.
3. Place the stainless steel bowl onto the bowl tray.
4. Open the top lid by pressing the center to access the food tank.
5. Fill the food tank with dry pet food. Ensure kibble size is between 2-15mm (0.078-0.6 inches).
6. Close the top lid securely by pressing it down until it locks.

### 2. Power Supply

The PETLIBRO Automatic Pet Feeder offers two power options:

- **DC 5V Power Adapter:** Connect the power cable to the feeder's external socket (Type C) and plug the adapter into a wall outlet. This is the primary power source.
- **D Alkaline Batteries (Backup):** For flexible placement and as a backup during power outages, insert three D alkaline batteries (not included) into the battery compartment at the bottom of the feeder. These batteries can provide up to 180 days of battery life.

*Note: It is recommended to use both the power adapter and batteries for reliable operation, especially to ensure feeding during power interruptions.*

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## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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### 1. Understanding the Control Panel

The feeder features an LCD screen and control buttons. The button protection panel can be opened by pressing its center to reveal the operational buttons. This design prevents accidental presses, ensuring feeding schedules are maintained.

### 2. Setting the Feeding Schedule

The PETLIBRO automatic cat feeder supports up to 6 meals per day, with 1-16 portions of food per meal. Follow these steps to program your feeding schedule:

1. Press the "SET" button to enter programming mode.

2. Use the "UP" and "DOWN" buttons to adjust the current time (hour and minute). Press "SET" to confirm.
3. Proceed to set Meal 1: Adjust the feeding time (hour and minute) and the number of portions (1-16). Press "SET" to confirm each setting.
4. Repeat for Meal 2 through Meal 6 as desired. If you do not wish to set a meal, simply skip it or set portions to 0.
5. After setting all desired meals, exit programming mode. The feeder will now dispense food according to your schedule.

*Note: One portion is approximately 10.4ml (1/24 cup, 2/3 tbsp, or 2 tsp). Actual food portions may vary slightly based on the size and type of kibble.*

### 3. Manual Feeding

To dispense food manually, locate the manual feed button (refer to the Quick Start Guide for exact button location). Pressing this button will dispense one portion of food immediately.

### 4. Lid Security

The press-to-lock top lid features a spring design for easy opening and closing. When closed, it keeps the food tank tightly locked, preventing pets from accessing the food. The internal rotor at the food outlet also remains securely closed when not dispensing, further preventing unauthorized access.

## MAINTENANCE

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### 1. Cleaning the Feeder

Regular cleaning ensures optimal hygiene for your pet. The following parts are easily detachable for cleaning:

- **Top Lid:** Detach and wash with water and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- **Food Tank:** Detach and wash with water and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- **Internal Rotor:** Detach and wash with water and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- **Stainless Steel Bowl:** Wash with water and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- **Feeder Base:** *The feeder base cannot be washed with water.* If cleaning is necessary, wipe it only with a dry cloth.

Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling the feeder and refilling with food.

### 2. Battery Replacement

If you are using D alkaline batteries as a backup or primary power source, replace them when the low battery indicator appears on the LCD screen, or approximately every 180 days for optimal performance. Ensure the feeder is unplugged from the power adapter before replacing batteries.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your PETLIBRO Automatic Cat Feeder, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Feeder not dispensing food.	Food tank is empty. Kibble size is too large or too small. Food outlet is blocked. Power issue.	Refill the food tank. Ensure kibble is within 2-15mm diameter. Check and clear any blockages in the food outlet. Verify power adapter connection or replace batteries.
Feeder not powering on.	Power adapter not connected. Batteries are dead or incorrectly installed.	Ensure power adapter is securely plugged in. Replace batteries with new D alkaline batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
Feeding schedule not working.	Incorrect time setting. Meals not programmed correctly. Accidental button press reset.	Re-check and adjust the current time. Re-program the feeding schedule, ensuring portions are set for each meal. Ensure the button protection panel is closed to prevent accidental presses.
