5.1 Power On/Off and Power Level Adjustment

1. **To Turn On:** Press the ON/OFF button for the desired burner. The display will illuminate.
2. **To Adjust Power:** Rotate the corresponding knob to select one of the 10 power levels. Level 1 is the lowest, and Level 10 (or 'P' for preheat/boost) is the highest, providing up to 1800W of power.
3. **To Turn Off:** Press the ON/OFF button again for the specific burner.


