1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of the Generic replacement paddle for Breadman Bread Maker Machines. This paddle is specifically designed for use with **Breadman Bread Maker Machine Models TR333 and TR444 only**

To ensure proper function and compatibility, it is crucial to verify your bread maker's model number before installation. Using this paddle with incompatible models may result in improper operation or damage.

2. PRODUCT COMPATIBILITY AND VERIFICATION

Before proceeding with installation, please confirm the exact model number of your Breadman bread maker. This paddle is exclusively compatible with models TR333 and TR444.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. **Ensure Safety:** Before handling any parts of your bread maker, ensure the appliance is unplugged from the power outlet and completely cooled down.
2. **Remove Old Paddle (if applicable):** If replacing an existing paddle, carefully remove the old paddle from the bread pan's drive shaft. It may require a gentle twist or pull.
3. **Inspect New Paddle:** Examine the new Generic paddle for any manufacturing defects or damage.
4. **Install New Paddle:** Align the opening at the base of the new paddle with the drive shaft inside the bread pan. Push the paddle firmly onto the shaft until it is securely seated. It should fit snugly and be able to rotate freely.

Once installed, the paddle is ready for use with your Breadman TR333 or TR444 bread maker.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Generic replacement paddle functions identically to the original paddle in your Breadman TR333 or TR444 bread maker. Follow the operating instructions provided in your original Breadman bread maker manual for specific recipes and program settings.

- Place the installed paddle in the bread pan before adding ingredients.
- Add ingredients according to your recipe, ensuring liquids are added first, followed by dry ingredients, and yeast last.
- Insert the bread pan into the bread maker and select your desired program.
- The paddle will automatically knead the dough during the designated cycles.
- After baking, allow the bread and pan to cool before carefully removing the bread. The paddle may be embedded in the loaf; remove it carefully using a non-abrasive utensil.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your paddle and ensure hygienic operation.

- **After Each Use:** Remove the paddle from the bread pan. Wash it immediately with warm, soapy water. Use a soft sponge or cloth to remove any dough residue.

- **Stubborn Residue:** If dough is stuck to the paddle, soak it in warm water for 10-15 minutes to loosen the residue before washing. Avoid using abrasive scrubbers or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the paddle's non-stick coating (if applicable) or material.
- **Drying:** Thoroughly dry the paddle before storing it or re-installing it in the bread pan.
- **Storage:** Store the paddle in a clean, dry place.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues related to the bread maker paddle.

- **Paddle Not Turning:**
 - Ensure the paddle is correctly seated on the drive shaft.
 - Check if the bread pan is properly installed in the bread maker.
 - Verify that the bread maker itself is plugged in and functioning. Refer to your bread maker's original manual for appliance-specific troubleshooting.
- **Dough Sticking to Paddle:**
 - This is common. Ensure the paddle is thoroughly cleaned after each use.
 - Soaking the paddle in warm water immediately after use can help prevent dough from hardening on it.
- **Paddle Comes Off During Kneading:**
 - Ensure the paddle is pushed firmly onto the drive shaft.
 - Check for any damage to the paddle's shaft opening or the bread pan's drive shaft.

If issues persist, consult your original Breadman bread maker manual or contact the bread maker manufacturer's support.
