1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your BEAR FLAG EDITION Ignition Switch. This replacement ignition switch is specifically designed for Case David Brown Tractor models 996, 1210, 1212, 1410, 1412, 380, and 580-F, ensuring reliable starting and operation of your agricultural equipment. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure safety and optimal performance.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always disconnect the tractor's battery before attempting any electrical work to prevent electrical shock or short circuits.
- Ensure the tractor is turned off and the parking brake is engaged before beginning installation.

8. **Test Functionality:** Insert the key and test the ignition switch through its various positions (OFF, ACC, ON, START) to ensure proper operation.

For a precise fit and informed choice, please thoroughly check the product's dimensions and inspect the provided photos before installation.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The ignition switch controls the electrical power to your tractor's engine and accessories. Familiarize yourself with the key positions:

- **OFF:** All electrical power to the engine and most accessories is cut. The key can be removed in this position.
- **ACC (Accessory):** Provides power to certain accessories (e.g., radio, lights) without turning on the engine.
- **ON (Run):** Provides power to the engine's ignition system and other essential components. This is the position for normal operation once the engine is running.
- **START:** Engages the starter motor to crank the engine. This is a momentary position; release the key once the engine starts, and it will return to the 'ON' position.

To start the tractor, ensure the transmission is in neutral and the parking brake is engaged. Insert the key, turn it to the 'ON' position, and then briefly to the 'START' position until the engine fires. Release the key immediately after the engine starts.

6. MAINTENANCE

The BEAR FLAG EDITION Ignition Switch is designed for long-term reliability with minimal maintenance. However, periodic checks can help ensure its longevity:

- **Inspect Connections:** Periodically check the wiring connections at the back of the switch to ensure they are clean, tight, and free from corrosion. Loose or corroded connections can lead to intermittent electrical issues.
- **Keep Clean:** Keep the area around the ignition switch clean and free from dirt, dust, and moisture. Use a dry cloth to wipe down the switch and surrounding panel.
- **Key Care:** Avoid using excessive force when inserting or turning the key. Do not hang heavy keychains from the ignition key, as this can put stress on the switch mechanism over time.
- **Functionality Check:** If you notice any stiffness or unusual resistance when turning the key, or if the switch feels loose, inspect it for damage or wear.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ignition switch, consider the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine does not crank when key is turned to START.	Dead battery, loose battery terminals, faulty starter motor, wiring issue, or faulty ignition switch.	Check battery charge and connections. Inspect starter motor. Verify wiring to the ignition switch. If other components are fine, the switch may need replacement.
No power to accessories in ACC or ON position.	Blown fuse, wiring issue, or faulty ignition switch.	Check relevant fuses in the tractor's fuse box. Inspect wiring for damage. If fuses are good, the switch may be faulty.
Key is difficult to turn or gets stuck.	Worn key, debris in the lock cylinder, or internal switch mechanism wear.	Try the spare key. Use a small amount of graphite lubricant in the keyhole. If the problem persists, the switch may need replacement.
Engine cuts out intermittently.	Loose wiring connection at the switch, faulty ignition switch, or other electrical issues.	Check all wiring connections to the switch for tightness. If connections are secure, the switch may be failing internally.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, it is recommended to consult a professional mechanic or contact customer support.
