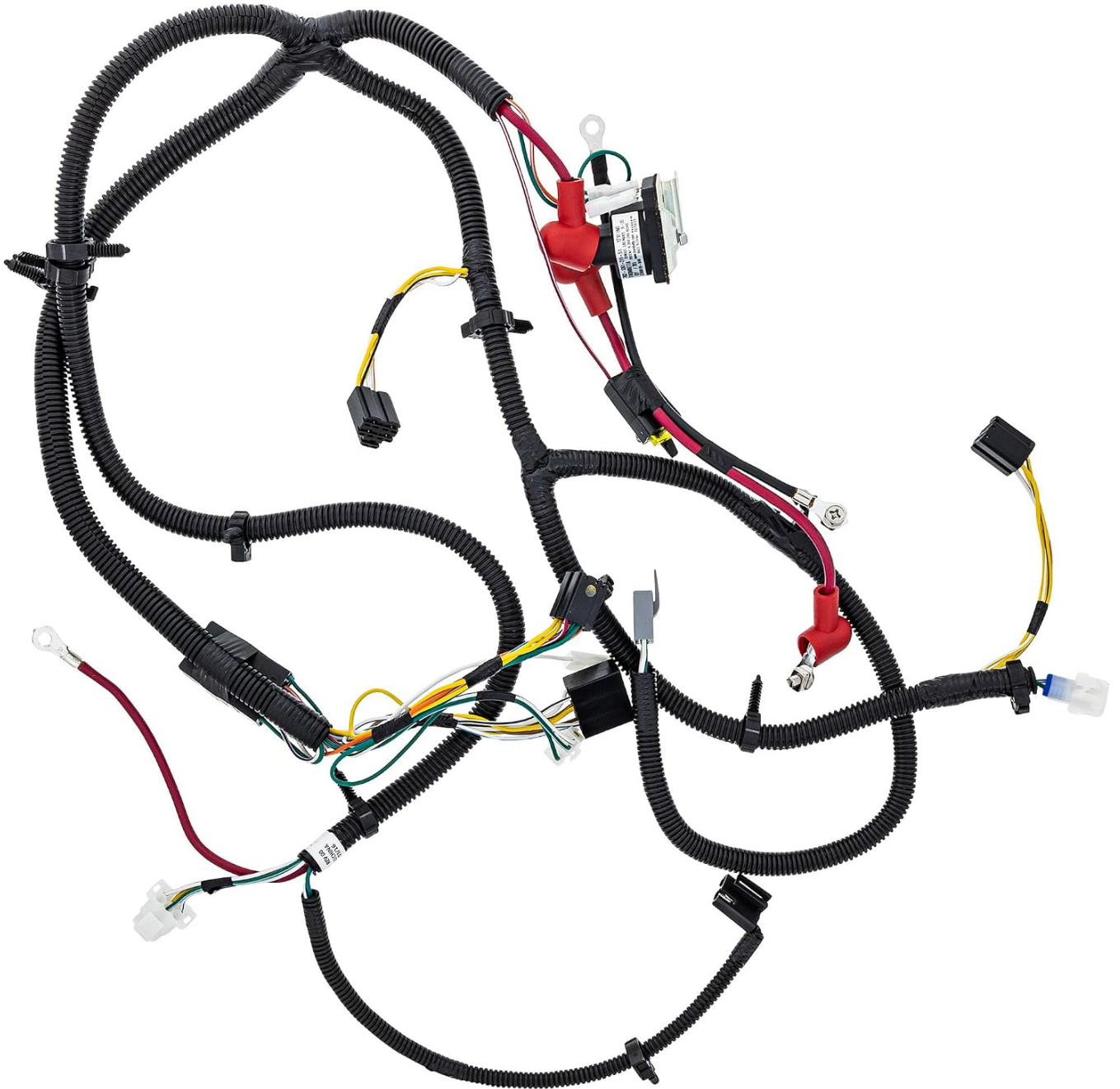


Image 2: The CUB CADET 725P18177 Main Wiring Harness laid out, illustrating its full length and various connection points for installation reference.
