Qaba Toddler Tricycle Instruction Manual

Model: 370-024BK

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembly and use of the Qaba Toddler Tricycle. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury.

- **Adult Supervision Required:** Always supervise children when they are using the tricycle.
- **Protective Gear:** Ensure the child wears a helmet and other protective gear (e.g., knee and elbow pads) at all times while riding.
- **Age and Weight Limit:** This tricycle is suitable for children aged 24 months to 5 years, with a maximum weight capacity of 55 lbs (25 kg). Do not exceed these limits.
- **Safe Riding Environment:** Use the tricycle on flat, even surfaces away from traffic, steep inclines, stairs, swimming pools, and other hazards.
- **Pre-Ride Check:** Before each use, check that all bolts and fasteners are securely tightened, the wheels are properly attached, and the steering and pedals function correctly.
- **Foot Placement:** Ensure the child's feet are properly placed on the pedals to avoid injury.
- **No Stunts:** Do not allow children to perform stunts or ride recklessly.
- **Keep Clear:** Keep fingers, hair, and loose clothing away from moving parts.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all components and ensure all parts are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- Tricycle Frame
- Front Wheel Assembly (with pedals and mudguard)
- Rear Wheels (2)
- Handlebars (with bell)
- Adjustable Seat
- Assembly Hardware (bolts, washers, nuts)
- Assembly Tool (multi-purpose wrench)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Qaba Toddler Tricycle. It is recommended to have two adults for easier assembly.

Step 1: Attach Rear Wheels

Slide each rear wheel onto the rear axle extensions of the tricycle frame. Ensure they click securely into place. Some models may require removing protective foam from the axle before attachment.

Step 2: Install Handlebars

Insert the handlebar stem into the front fork of the tricycle frame. Ensure the handlebars are facing forward and are aligned with the front wheel. Tighten the securing bolt firmly using the provided tool.

Step 3: Attach Seat

Position the seat onto the frame. The seat is adjustable to two levels. Select the appropriate height for your child and secure it with the provided bolts. Ensure the bolts are very tight to prevent the seat from shifting during use.

Double-check all connections, bolts, and nuts to ensure they are securely fastened. Test the steering and pedal function before allowing a child to ride.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Qaba Toddler Tricycle is designed for simple and intuitive operation.

- **Riding:** Instruct the child to sit comfortably on the ergonomic seat, place their feet on the pedals, and grasp the handlebars. They can propel the tricycle by pedaling forward.
- **Steering:** The handlebars control the direction of the front wheel. Teach the child to steer by turning the handlebars left or right.
- **Using the Bell:** The integrated bell can be used to alert others. Show the child how to operate it by pressing the lever.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your tricycle.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the tricycle with a damp cloth and mild soap as needed. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Inspections:** Periodically check all bolts, nuts, and connections for tightness. Tighten any loose fasteners.
- **Wheel Care:** The EVA wheels are puncture-resistant and require minimal maintenance. Keep them free of debris.
- **Storage:** Store the tricycle in a dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent material degradation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tricycle feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose bolts or improperly attached wheels.	Check and tighten all assembly bolts, especially those for the wheels and seat. Ensure wheels are fully engaged on axles.
Difficulty pedaling.	Obstruction in pedal mechanism or child's feet not positioned correctly.	Inspect pedals for debris. Ensure child's feet are securely on the pedals and they are tall enough to reach comfortably.
Steering is stiff or difficult.	Handlebar stem not properly seated or tightened.	Loosen handlebar bolt, re-align stem, and re-tighten securely.
