1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the assembly, safe use, and maintenance of your Kangmusi 3139834 Solid Pine Wood Bunk Bed. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure safety and product longevity.

The Kangmusi 3139834 bunk bed is designed to be a functional and space-saving solution for any room. It features a robust construction made from solid pine wood, known for its natural beauty and distinctive rustic grain.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Please adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Always follow assembly instructions precisely. Incorrect assembly can lead to instability and injury.
- Ensure all bolts and connectors are securely tightened before use and check periodically.
- The top bunk is equipped with guardrails to prevent falls during sleep. Always ensure these guardrails are properly installed and maintained.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age on the upper bunk.
- Use only mattresses of the specified size (80 x 200 cm) and thickness to ensure proper guardrail height.
- Do not attach or hang items on any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, or ropes.
- Periodically inspect the bed for any signs of damage, loose parts, or wear. Discontinue use if damage is found and contact support.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- 1 x Lower Bed Frame
- 1 x Upper Bed Frame
- Slats for both bed frames
- Ladder components
- Guardrail components
- Assembly hardware (screws, bolts, nuts, etc.)
- Assembly tools (if included, otherwise standard household tools may be required)

Note: Mattresses are not included with this product.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires two adults. Please ensure you have adequate space and all tools ready before starting.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Assemble Lower Bed Frame:** Follow the diagrams provided in your separate assembly guide (if applicable) to connect the side rails, headboard, and footboard for the lower bed. Secure all connections with the provided hardware.
3. **Install Lower Bed Slats:** Place the bed slats onto the support rails of the lower bed frame. Ensure they are evenly spaced and secured according to the instructions.
4. **Assemble Upper Bed Frame:** Repeat the process for the upper bed frame, connecting side rails, headboard, and footboard.
5. **Install Upper Bed Slats:** Place the bed slats onto the support rails of the upper bed frame.
6. **Attach Guardrails:** Securely attach the guardrails to the upper bunk frame as indicated in the assembly guide.
7. **Attach Ladder:** Mount the ladder securely to the bunk bed frame. Ensure it is stable and all steps are firmly attached.
8. **Final Check:** Double-check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight and secure. The bed should not wobble or show any signs of instability.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (USAGE)

Once assembled, the bunk bed is ready for use. Please observe the following:

- **Mattress Placement:** Place an 80 x 200 cm mattress on each bunk. Ensure the mattress on the upper bunk does not exceed the height of the guardrails.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the ladder to access the upper bunk. Do not jump onto or off the upper bunk.
- **Weight Capacity:** Adhere to the maximum weight capacity for each bunk as specified in the "Specifications" section.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate air circulation around the mattresses to prevent moisture buildup.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life of your bunk bed and ensure continued safety.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wooden surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the pine wood finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any that have become loose.
- **Wood Care:** As the bed is made of untreated solid pine wood, it can be susceptible to changes in humidity and temperature. Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources. You may

choose to apply a wood sealant or varnish for added protection, following the product manufacturer's instructions.

- **Damage Inspection:** Regularly inspect the wood for cracks, splinters, or other damage. Address any issues promptly to prevent further deterioration or injury.




Image 6.1: A close-up view of the solid pine wood, highlighting its natural grain and knots.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Bed Wobbles:**

- Check if slats are properly seated and not rubbing against the frame.




Image 8.1: Detailed dimension diagram of the bunk bed, showing key measurements.
