SETUP

1. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided power adapter to the WMX1 MK2 and plug it into a suitable power outlet.
2. **DMX Connections:** Connect your DMX-compatible lighting fixtures to the DMX output sockets on the WMX1 MK2 using DMX cables. Ensure proper DMX addressing for each fixture.
3. **USB Connection (Optional):** For software updates or advanced configuration, connect the WMX1 MK2 to a computer via the USB port.
4. **Fixture Profiles:** Load the appropriate fixture profiles for your lighting devices into the Wolfmix software to ensure correct control and functionality.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The WMX1 MK2 offers intuitive control over your DMX lighting. Familiarize yourself with the buttons and encoders for optimal performance.

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button to turn the unit on or off.
2. **Fixture Selection:** Use the dedicated buttons or touch screen interface to select individual fixtures or groups of fixtures.
3. **Parameter Adjustment:** Utilize the 4 rotary encoders to adjust various lighting parameters such as dimmer, color, position, gobo, and effects. The backlit buttons provide visual feedback on active functions.
4. **Scene and Chase Programming:** The Wolfmix system allows for the creation and storage of custom scenes and chases. Refer to the on-screen interface for detailed programming steps.
5. **Live Control:** Adjust lighting in real-time using the encoders and buttons for dynamic effects during performances.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the surface of the controller with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

- **Storage:** Store the WMX1 MK2 in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.
- **Firmware Updates:** Periodically check the ADJ or Wolfmix website for firmware updates to ensure optimal performance and access to new features. Follow the instructions provided with the update carefully.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the controller and a working power outlet. Check the power indicator light on the unit.
- **Lights Not Responding:** Verify all DMX cables are correctly connected and not damaged. Check that your lighting fixtures are properly addressed and set to the correct DMX mode. Confirm that the WMX1 MK2 is sending DMX signals.
- **Incorrect Lighting Behavior:** Ensure that the correct fixture profiles are loaded and assigned to your lights in the Wolfmix software. Check for any conflicting scenes or effects.
- **Software Connectivity Issues:** If connecting to a computer, ensure the USB cable is secure and the necessary drivers are installed. Restart both the controller and the computer if issues persist.
