INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Tribit StormBox Micro 2 and XSound Plus 2 Portable Bluetooth Speakers. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your devices to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing, please verify that all components are present:

- Tribit StormBox Micro 2 Portable Bluetooth Speaker
- Tribit XSound Plus 2 Portable Bluetooth Speaker
- USB-C Charging Cable (for each speaker)
- User Manual (this document)

Note: Specific cable types and quantities may vary slightly.

SETUP

Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge both speakers. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the charging port on each speaker and the other end to a compatible USB power adapter (not included).

- **Charging Indicator:** The LED indicator will show charging status. It typically turns off or changes color when fully charged.
- **Charging Time:** Approximately 3-4 hours for a full charge.

Pairing with a Bluetooth Device

1. **Power On:** Press and hold the power button on the speaker until you hear an audible prompt or see the LED indicator light up.
2. **Enter Pairing Mode:** The speaker will automatically enter pairing mode when powered on for the first time. If already paired, press and hold the Bluetooth button until the LED flashes rapidly.
3. **Enable Bluetooth:** On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth.
4. **Select Speaker:** In your device's Bluetooth settings, select "Tribit StormBox Micro 2" or "Tribit XSound Plus 2" from the list of available devices.
5. **Confirmation:** Once connected, the speaker will provide an audible confirmation, and the LED indicator will turn solid blue.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Controls

Button/Indicator	Function
Power Button	Press and hold to Power On/Off.
Volume +	Press to increase volume. Press and hold for next track.
Volume -	Press to decrease volume. Press and hold for previous track.
Play/Pause Button	Press to Play/Pause music. Press to answer/end calls. Press and hold to reject calls.
Bluetooth Button	Press and hold to enter pairing mode. Press to disconnect current Bluetooth device.
XBass Button (XSound Plus 2)	Press to toggle XBass mode On/Off for enhanced bass.
Link Button (StormBox Micro 2)	Press to link two StormBox Micro 2 speakers for stereo sound.

Sound Customization (XSound Plus 2)

The Tribit XSound Plus 2 offers various sound modes and customization options via the Tribit App.

- **3 Button Modes:** Cycle through preset EQ modes directly on the speaker.
- **6 Default App Settings:** Access additional preset sound profiles through the Tribit App.
- **Limitless Customization:** Use the app's equalizer to create and save your personalized sound profiles.

Stereo Pairing (StormBox Micro 2)

You can pair two Tribit StormBox Micro 2 speakers together for a true wireless stereo experience:

1. Ensure both StormBox Micro 2 speakers are powered on and not connected to any Bluetooth device.
2. On one speaker, press the Link button. It will enter pairing mode.
3. On the second speaker, press the Link button.
4. The speakers will automatically connect to each other. Once connected, one speaker will act as the left channel and the other as the right.
5. Connect your Bluetooth device to one of the paired speakers.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker's surface. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the speakers in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the speakers regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.
- **Water Resistance:** While the speakers are designed for outdoor use, avoid submerging them in water. Ensure charging ports are dry before charging.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
---------	-------------------

Problem	Possible Solution
Speaker won't turn on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair with Bluetooth device.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (flashing blue LED). ◦ Disable and re-enable Bluetooth on your device. ◦ Move the speaker closer to your device. ◦ Forget the speaker from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.
No sound or low volume.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Increase volume on both the speaker and your connected device. ◦ Ensure the speaker is properly connected to your device. ◦ Check if the audio source is playing.
Sound distortion.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Reduce the volume on either the speaker or your device. ◦ Move the speaker closer to your device to avoid interference. ◦ Ensure the speaker is fully charged.
Stereo pairing not working (StormBox Micro 2).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure both speakers are StormBox Micro 2 models. ◦ Disconnect both speakers from any Bluetooth devices before attempting stereo pairing. ◦ Follow the stereo pairing steps precisely.

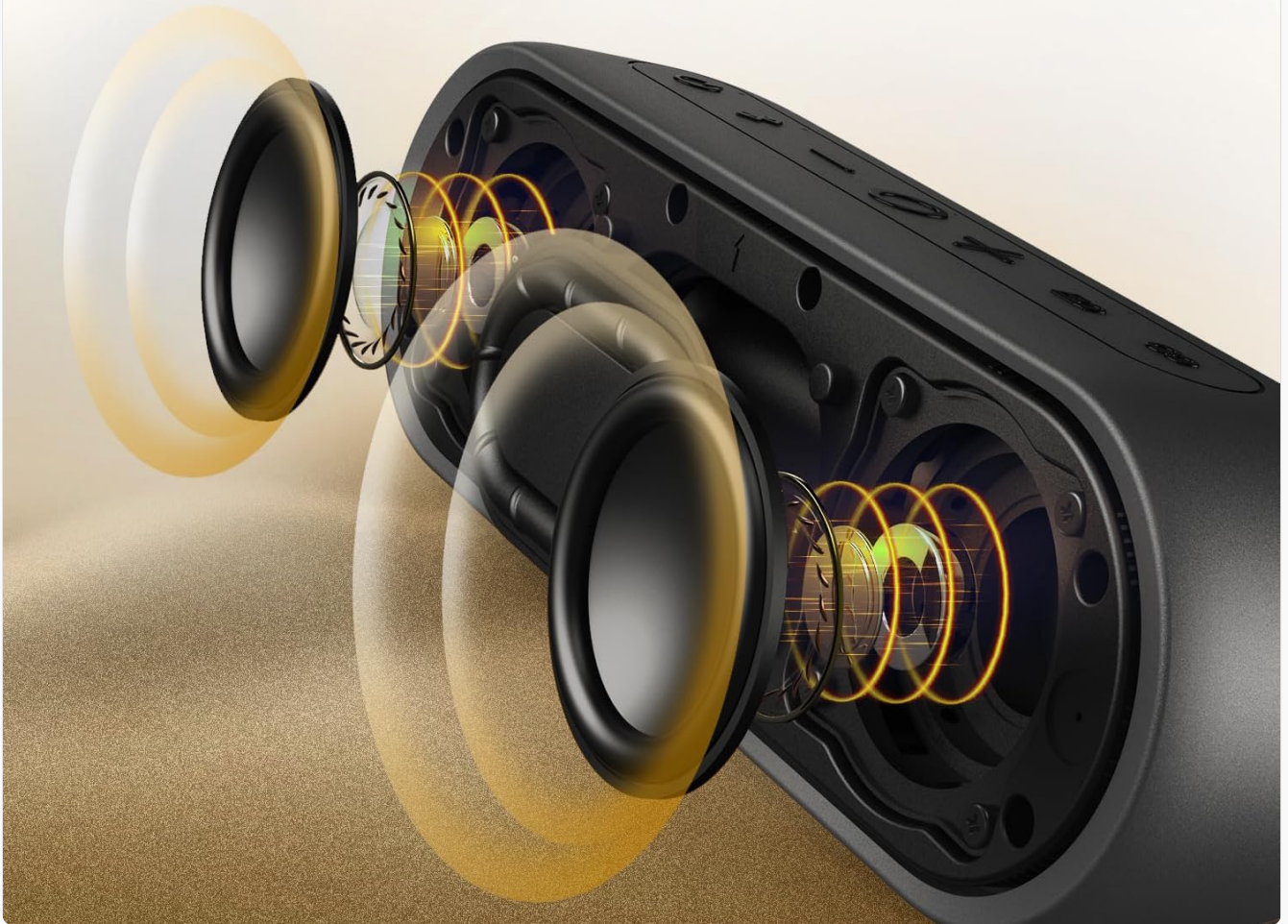
