1. INTRODUCTION

This ultralight and compact tunnel tent is designed for trekking, hiking, and other outdoor adventures, offering reliable protection and comfort. 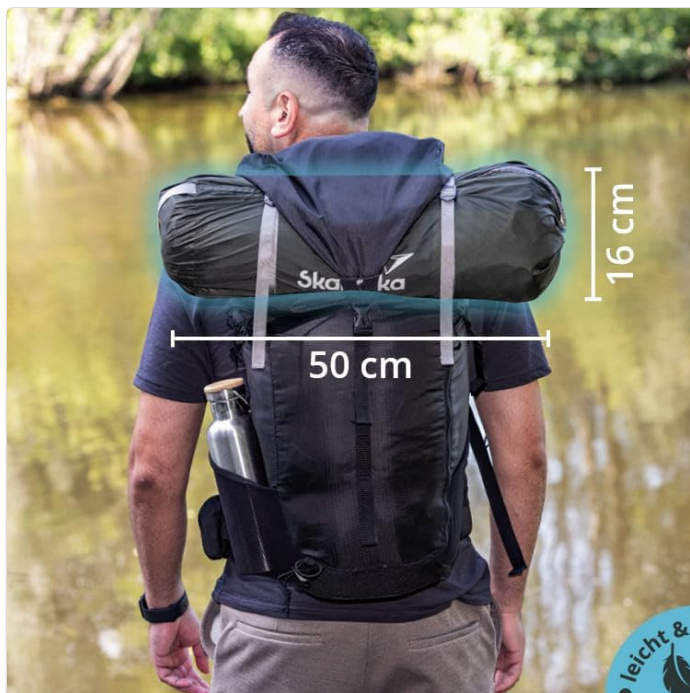
2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Fire Safety:** Keep all flame and heat sources away from the tent fabric. The tent is made of flammable material.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation to prevent condensation and carbon monoxide buildup if using heating or cooking equipment (not recommended inside the tent).
- **Weather Conditions:** While the tent offers reliable weather protection, avoid pitching it in extreme weather conditions such as severe storms, strong winds, or heavy snowfall.
- **Site Selection:** Choose a flat, clear area free of sharp objects. Avoid pitching under trees with dead branches or in areas prone to flash floods.
- **Anchoring:** Always use all guy lines and pegs to securely anchor the tent, especially in windy conditions.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please check that all components are present before attempting to set up your tent:

- Outer Tent (Flysheet)
- Inner Tent (Sleeping Cabin with breathable mesh)
- Pre-assembled Aluminum Pole System
- Aluminum Pegs
- Guy Lines (pre-attached or separate)
- Robust Carry Bag
- Repair Kit (if included)

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The Skandika Vatn tent features an easy and quick assembly process, ideal for spontaneous outdoor adventures. Estimated setup time is approximately 5 minutes.

1. **Unpack and Lay Out:** Remove the tent from its carry bag and lay the outer tent flat on your chosen pitching site.
2. **Assemble Poles:** Connect the sections of the pre-assembled aluminum pole system. The elasticated sections will guide the assembly.
3. **Insert Poles:** Slide the assembled poles through the sleeves on the outer tent.
4. **Secure Poles:** Insert the ends of the poles into the grommets or attachment points at the base of the tent.
5. **Pitch Outer Tent:** Lift the tent structure and secure the corners with pegs.
6. **Attach Inner Tent:** The inner tent is typically pre-attached or can be easily clipped into the outer tent from the inside. Ensure the sleeping cabin is properly suspended.
7. **Stake Out Guy Lines:** Extend and stake out all guy lines to provide stability and tension to the tent. Adjust tension as

needed.

5. OPERATING (USAGE)

The Skandika Vatn tent is designed for comfortable and practical use in various outdoor conditions.

5.1. Entrances and Ventilation

The tent features two opposing entrance doors and two permanent weather-protected ventilation openings. This design ensures cross-ventilation, maintaining a pleasant indoor climate and reducing condensation. The weather-protected area near the entrances provides additional space for storing gear, keeping it dry and accessible.

5.2. Interior Features

Inside the sleeping cabin, you will find practical storage pockets to keep small, important items organized and within reach. A hook is also provided for hanging a camping lamp, illuminating the interior.

5.3. Inner Tent Only Use

In clear, warm weather, the inner tent can be used independently without the outer flysheet. This allows for stargazing while being protected by the full mosquito net, ensuring a comfortable and insect-free night.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the lifespan of your Skandika Vatn tent.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the tent with a soft sponge and lukewarm water. Do not use harsh detergents, bleach, or washing machines, as this can damage the waterproof coating.
- **Drying:** Always ensure the tent is completely dry before packing it away. Packing a damp tent can lead to mildew and fabric degradation. Air dry in a shaded, well-ventilated area.
- **Storage:** Store the tent in its carry bag in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Pole Care:** After use, wipe down poles to remove dirt. If poles become bent or damaged, replace them promptly to maintain tent structure.
- **Pegs and Guy Lines:** Clean pegs and inspect guy lines for fraying or damage. Replace as necessary.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Condensation Inside Tent:** This is normal in certain conditions. Ensure all ventilation openings are open. If possible, slightly open tent doors for increased airflow. Avoid cooking or bringing wet items inside the tent.
- **Water Leaks:** Check if the tent is properly pitched and tensioned. Ensure all zippers are fully closed. Small leaks can often be repaired with a seam sealer or repair patch from a tent repair kit.
- **Difficulty Assembling Poles:** Ensure pole sections are fully seated. If a pole is bent, it may need to be straightened or replaced.
- **Tent Not Stable in Wind:** Ensure all pegs are fully driven into the ground and all guy lines are properly tensioned and anchored. Re-adjust tension if wind direction changes.
