SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- 4. **Drain Valve:** Ensure the drain valve is in the closed position before introducing any fluids.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Pr-300 Cover Assembly is primarily a passive component, but its integrated features require specific operational considerations:

- **Sight Glass Monitoring:** Regularly inspect the fluid level or condition through the sight glass. Ensure the glass remains clean for accurate readings.
- **Drain Valve Operation:** To drain fluid, place a suitable container beneath the drain valve. Slowly open the valve by turning it counter-clockwise. Close the valve by turning it clockwise until snug. Do not overtighten.
- Environmental Conditions: Operate the assembly within the temperature and pressure limits specified for your overall system.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of the Pr-300 Cover Assembly:

- Cleaning: Periodically clean the exterior of the cover assembly and the sight glass with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could scratch the sight glass.
- **Inspection:** Routinely inspect the cover assembly for signs of wear, corrosion, or damage, especially around the sight glass and drain valve. Check for any leaks.
- Gasket/Seal Replacement: If leaks are detected or during routine system overhauls, inspect and replace the gasket or seals as necessary. Refer to JB Industries documentation for compatible replacement seals.
- **Drain Valve Functionality:** Periodically operate the drain valve to ensure it opens and closes smoothly and seals properly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fluid Leakage	Improper installation; Damaged gasket/seal; Loose fasteners; Damaged drain valve.	Re-tighten fasteners evenly; Inspect and replace gasket/seal; Inspect and replace drain valve if damaged.
Sight Glass Obscured	Dirt or residue on glass; Internal fluid contamination.	Clean exterior of sight glass; If internal, system may require flushing or component replacement.
Drain Valve Stuck/Leaking	Debris in valve mechanism; Worn internal seals.	Attempt to gently operate valve; If persistent, valve may need to be disassembled and cleaned or replaced.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, contact a qualified technician or the manufacturer for assistance.
