## 1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Philips Portable FM/MW Radio TAR1509. Please read it thoroughly before using the device and retain it for future reference. The Philips TAR1509 is a compact, battery-operated radio designed for portability and ease of use, offering clear sound and reliable reception for FM and MW bands.

# 2. Safety Information

- Do not expose the radio to water or excessive moisture.
- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Use only specified AAA batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.
- Keep the device away from strong magnetic fields.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the radio yourself. Refer to qualified service personnel.
- Dispose of batteries and the device according to local regulations.

## 4. Product Overview

#### **Controls and Features:**

- Telescopic Antenna: For improved FM reception.
- Tuning Dial: Analog display for selecting radio frequencies.
- Tuning Thumbwheel: Adjusts the frequency to find stations.
- Volume Thumbwheel: Controls the audio output level.
- AM/FM/OFF Switch: Selects the radio band or turns the device off.
- Headphone Port (3.5mm): For private listening.
- Battery Compartment: Located on the back for AAA batteries.
- Lanyard: For easy carrying.

## 5. Setup

### 5.1. Battery Installation

- 1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the radio.
- 2. Slide the cover open.
- 3. Insert 2 x AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-) as indicated inside the compartment.
- 4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Note: Batteries are not included and must be purchased separately.

# 6. Operating

#### 6.1. Turning On/Off and Selecting Band

- 1. Slide the AM/FM/OFF switch to either 'AM' or 'FM' to turn on the radio and select your desired band.
- 2. To turn off the radio, slide the switch to 'OFF'.

#### 6.2. Tuning to a Station

- 1. For FM reception, extend the telescopic antenna fully for optimal signal.
- 2. Slowly rotate the Tuning thumbwheel until you find your desired station. The analog dial will indicate the frequency.
- 3. Adjust the Volume thumbwheel to your preferred listening level.




Figure 3: The Philips TAR1509 radio being used outdoors, showcasing its compact and ultra-portable nature.

#### 6.3. Using Headphones

To listen privately, plug any standard 3.5mm headphones into the headphone port located on the side of the radio. The internal speaker will automatically mute.

## 7. Maintenance

- Clean the radio with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- If the radio will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.
- Keep the telescopic antenna clean and free from obstruction.

# 8. Troubleshooting

- **No Power:** Check if batteries are inserted correctly and are not depleted. Replace if necessary. Ensure the AM/FM/OFF switch is not in the 'OFF' position.
- **Poor Reception:** Extend the telescopic antenna fully for FM. For AM, try rotating the radio for better signal. Move away from electronic devices that may cause interference.
- No Sound: Check the volume level. Ensure headphones are not plugged in if you intend to use the speaker.
