4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Key Features:

5. SETUP

5.1 Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge both batteries. The charger plugs directly into the battery unit.

1. Connect the battery charger to a power outlet.
2. Plug the charging cable into the battery pack.
3. The indicator light on the battery will show charging status.
4. Once fully charged, disconnect the charger.
5. Allow 15 minutes between charging batteries if charging consecutively.

5.2 Attaching Nozzles

The vacuum cleaner features connectors for various attachments to optimize cleaning for different surfaces and tasks.

- **Flat Suction Nozzle:** Attaches to the front dust bin connector for gaps and crevices.
- **Multi-surface Nozzle:** Attaches to the front dust bin connector for hard and wide surfaces.
- **Flat Brush:** Used with the flat suction nozzle for soft surfaces.

- **Air Suction Nozzle:** Attaches to the front dust bin connector for vacuum storage bags.
- **Short Blowing Nozzle:** Mounts at the rear end of the vacuum cleaner for blowing functions.
- **Round Brush:** Used with the long blowing nozzle to blow dirt out of seams.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Suction Mode

The MBNGF X9 ULTRA provides powerful suction for various cleaning needs.

1. Attach the desired suction nozzle (Flat Suction, Multi-surface, or Air Suction) to the front dust bin connector.
2. Ensure the battery is securely inserted and charged.
3. Press the power button to turn on the vacuum.
4. Guide the nozzle over the area to be cleaned.
5. Press the power button again to turn off the vacuum.

6.2 Blower Mode

The X9 ULTRA can also function as a powerful blower for various tasks.

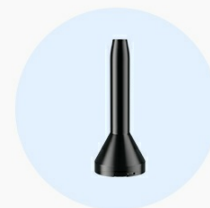
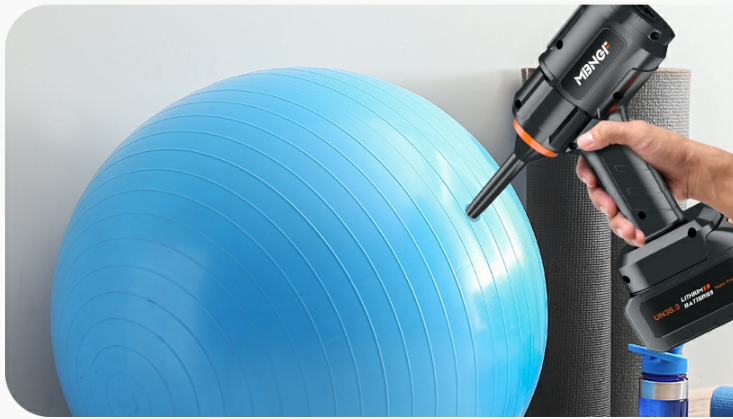


Figure 6.2: Using the Blower Function for Campfires

1. Attach the Short Blowing Nozzle to the rear end of the vacuum cleaner.
2. Ensure the battery is securely inserted and charged.
3. Press the power button to turn on the blower.
4. Direct the airflow as needed for tasks such as blowing dust, inflating items, or assisting with fire ignition.
5. Press the power button again to turn off the blower.

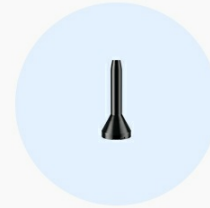


Figure 6.3: Inflating Sports Equipment

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your MBNGF X9 ULTRA vacuum cleaner.

7.1 Emptying the Dustbin

The dustbin has a capacity of 230ml and should be emptied regularly to maintain suction power.

1. Ensure the vacuum is turned off.
2. Twist and detach the dustbin from the main unit.
3. Carefully empty the collected debris into a trash receptacle.
4. Reattach the dustbin securely.

7.2 Cleaning the Filter

The reusable HEPA filter should be cleaned periodically to prevent clogging and maintain suction efficiency.

1. Remove the dustbin as described above.
2. Carefully remove the washable filter and steel filter from the dustbin.
3. Tap the filter gently to dislodge dust and debris.
4. For a deeper clean, rinse the washable filter under running water. Ensure it is completely dry before reinserting.
5. Reinsert the steel filter, then the washable filter, and finally reattach the dustbin.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your MBNGF X9 ULTRA, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum does not turn on.	Battery is not charged or not properly inserted.	Charge the battery fully. Ensure the battery is securely clicked into place.
Low suction power.	Dustbin is full. Filter is clogged. Nozzle is blocked.	Empty the dustbin. Clean or replace the filter. Check and clear any blockages in the nozzle or main unit.
Blower function is weak.	Short Blowing Nozzle not properly attached. Obstruction in the blowing path.	Ensure the Short Blowing Nozzle is securely attached to the rear port. Check for and remove any obstructions.
Battery life is shorter than expected.	Battery not fully charged. Battery degradation over time.	Ensure battery is fully charged before each use. Consider replacing the battery if it's old and performance has significantly degraded.
Unusual noise during operation.	Obstruction in the fan or motor area. Loose parts.	Turn off and disconnect the battery. Check for and remove any foreign objects. If noise persists, contact customer support.
