INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use and care of your new Fossil FS6071 Everett Men's Watch. The Everett watch features a 42mm diameter case, a three-hand quartz movement with date display, a cream sunray dial, and a brown leather strap. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece.

SETUP

1. Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch) out to position 2.

2. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hands and set the correct time.
3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into position 0.

2. Setting the Date

1. Pull the crown out to position 1.
2. Rotate the crown clockwise to advance the date. Do not rotate counter-clockwise as this may damage the movement.
3. Set the date to the day before the current date.
4. Pull the crown out to position 2 and rotate it clockwise to advance the hour hand. As the hour hand passes 12 o'clock, the date will change to the current date. Continue rotating until the correct time (AM/PM) is set.
5. Push the crown back into position 0.

OPERATING THE WATCH

Your Fossil FS6071 watch is powered by a reliable quartz movement, ensuring accurate timekeeping. Once the time and date are set, the watch will operate continuously.

Wearing the Watch

Adjust the brown leather strap to comfortably fit your wrist. The buckle closure ensures a secure fit.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Watch

- Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and fingerprints.
- For the leather strap, avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, and harsh chemicals. Clean with a slightly damp cloth and allow to air dry.

Water Resistance

While your watch may have some level of water resistance, it is generally recommended to avoid submerging it in water or exposing it to steam (e.g., in a shower or sauna) to protect the leather strap and internal components. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in to maintain any water resistance rating.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a single battery. When the watch stops running, it indicates the battery needs replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to prevent damage to the watch's movement and to ensure proper resealing for water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:**

Ensure the crown is fully pushed into position 0. If the watch still does not run, the battery may need replacement. Consult a professional watch repair service.

- **Date Not Changing:**

Verify that the time is set correctly, especially the AM/PM cycle. The date typically changes around midnight. If the issue persists, the movement may require inspection by a technician.

- **Condensation Under Crystal:**

This indicates moisture has entered the watch. Immediately take the watch to a professional for inspection and repair to prevent internal damage.
