High-Quality LDAC Bluetooth 5.3 2-Way Speakers

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Edifier S880DB MKII bookshelf speakers. This manual provides important information regarding the setup, operation, and maintenance of your new audio system. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper and safe operation.

The Edifier S880DB MKII speakers are designed to deliver high-fidelity audio with versatile connectivity options, including LDAC Bluetooth 5.3 for high-resolution wireless audio, and various wired inputs. Featuring a total output power of 88W RMS, these speakers utilize advanced TI Class D audio amplifiers, 1-inch titanium diaphragm tweeters, and 3.75-inch aluminum diaphragm mid-bass drivers, all housed in a high-strength MDF enclosure to minimize distortion.

3. SETUP

3.1 Speaker Placement

For optimal sound performance, place the speakers on a stable, flat surface, ideally at ear level when seated. Ensure there is adequate space around the speakers for proper ventilation.

3.2 Connecting the Speakers

1. Connect the active speaker (with controls) to the passive speaker using the provided speaker connection cable. Ensure the polarity is correct (red to red, black to black).
2. Connect the power cable to the active speaker and then to a power outlet.

3.3 Audio Input Connections

The S880DB MKII offers multiple input options:

- **Bluetooth:** For wireless connection to smartphones, tablets, or computers.
- **Optical:** For connecting to TVs, game consoles, or other digital audio sources.
- **Coaxial:** For connecting to digital audio sources with coaxial output.
- **USB:** For connecting to a computer as a USB audio device.
- **Line In (RCA):** For connecting to analog audio sources like CD players or turntables.

Select the appropriate cable and connect your audio source to the corresponding input on the active speaker.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the active speaker or the remote control to turn the speakers on or off.

4.2 Input Selection

Use the input selector button on the active speaker or the remote control to cycle through the available audio inputs (Bluetooth, Optical, Coaxial, USB, Line In).

4.3 Volume Control

Adjust the master volume using the rotary knob on the active speaker or the volume buttons on the remote control.

4.4 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Select Bluetooth input on the speakers. The indicator light will flash.
2. Enable Bluetooth on your audio device (smartphone, tablet, etc.) and search for "EDIFIER S880DB MKII".
3. Select the speaker from the list to pair. Once paired, the indicator light will be solid.

4.5 Tone Control

The active speaker features knobs for adjusting treble and bass levels to customize your sound preference.

4.6 EDIFIER ConneX App

Download the EDIFIER ConneX mobile application for enhanced control. The app allows for playback control, sound effect changes, equalizer customization, and access to the manual and other settings.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker surfaces. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Dust:** Regularly dust the speaker grilles and cabinet to prevent accumulation.
- **Environment:** Avoid placing speakers in direct sunlight, near heat sources, or in areas with high humidity.
- **Handling:** Handle the speakers with care. Avoid dropping or subjecting them to strong impacts.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound	• Power not connected • Incorrect input selected • Volume too low • Audio cable loose or faulty	• Ensure power cable is securely connected and power outlet is active. • Select the correct input source. • Increase the volume. • Check and re-connect audio cables. Try a different cable if available.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bluetooth connection issues	• Speakers not in pairing mode • Device too far from speakers • Interference	• Ensure Bluetooth input is selected and indicator is flashing. • Move device closer to speakers (within 10 meters). • Turn off other Bluetooth devices nearby.
Distorted sound	• Volume too high • Source audio quality is poor • Incorrect tone settings	• Reduce volume on both speakers and source device. • Try a different audio source or file. • Adjust treble and bass knobs to neutral or preferred settings.

- To enjoy all Bluetooth functions of this product, make sure that your audio source device supports A2DP and AVRCP profiles.
- If no device is connected in 10 minutes, the speaker will switch to Bluetooth hidden mode. "H" will blink on the OLED display. In this mode, CD new devices cannot find the speaker, but CD for a device that exists in the pairing record of this speaker, you can select "CD FOR SBB0039 MK3" from its Bluetooth device list to reconnect. To exit from Bluetooth hidden mode, press the "Volume/Source" knob on the speaker or tap the "H" button on the remote control.

- USB interface of the speaker is built as USB Audio Class 2.0, which supports high-resolution audio with sample rate up to 192kHz. For a computer running Windows 8 or earlier version, a driver needs to be installed. - Make sure that SPEAKER1903 is set as the audio output device (1) for Windows users, or "Control Panel" > "Sound" > "Set as Default" to set "SPEAKER1903 (HDMI)" or "SPEAKER1903 (USB)" as the default audio output device. (2) For Mac users, access "System Preferences" > "Sound" > "Output" to select "SPEAKER1903 (HDMI)" as the current audio output device.
- In USB mode, the following sample rates are supported: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, and 192kHz.

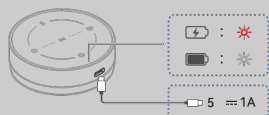
3. Подключение кабеля

4. Дистанционное управление

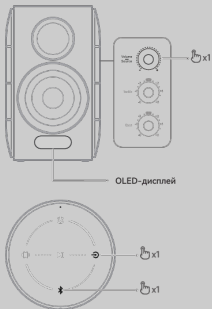

7. Bluetooth соединение

3. Чтобы отключиться от текущего устройства Bluetooth, дважды нажмите кнопку "Громкость/Источник" на задней панели или нажмите и удерживайте кнопку «Ф» на пульте дистанционного управления.

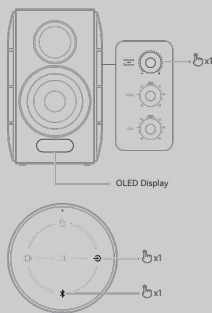
5. Power on/off

Power on: Switch the main power button on the rear panel to "ON".

Power off: Switch the main power button to "OFF".

- To switch the speaker to standby mode or work mode, tap and hold the "⊕" button on the remote control or press and hold the "Volume/Source" knob on the rear panel.

6. Input source selection



Press the "Volume/Source" knob on the rear panel or tap the "⊕" button on the remote control to switch between input sources.

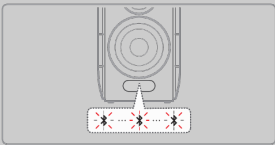
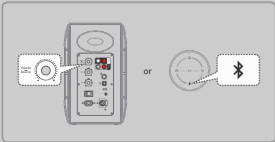

7. Bluetooth connection

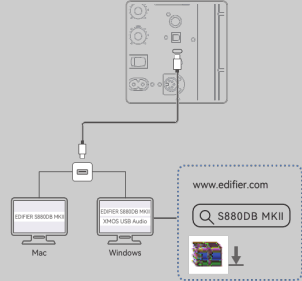
1. Switch to Bluetooth input. "" will blink rapidly on the OLED display.
 2. On your device, select "EDIFIER S880DB MKII" in its Bluetooth device list to connect, and "" will be displayed constantly when the connection is established.
- To disconnect from the current Bluetooth device, double press the "Volume/Source" knob on the rear panel, or tap and hold the "" button on the remote control.



- Note:**
- Pin code for connection is "0000" if needed.
 - To enjoy all Bluetooth functions of this product, make sure that your audio source device supports A2DP and AVRCP profiles.
 - If no device is connected in 10 minutes, the speaker will switch to Bluetooth hidden mode. "" will blink on the OLED display. In this mode, (1) new devices cannot find the speaker, but (2) for a device that exists in the pairing record of this speaker, you can select "EDIFIER S880DB MKII" from its Bluetooth device list to reconnect. To exit from Bluetooth hidden mode, press the "Volume/Source" knob on the speaker or tap the "" button on the remote control.

8. USB audio streaming

1. Switch to USB mode.
2. Connect the speaker to your computer with the bundled USB cable.
3. On the computer, select this speaker as the audio output device, and then start playback.



- Note:**
- USB interface of the speaker is built on USB Audio Class 2.0, which supports high-resolution audio with sample rate up to 192kHz. For a computer running Windows 8 or earlier versions, a driver needs to be installed. You can visit www.edifier.com, search for "S880DB MKII", go to its detail page, scroll down to the support information, and click the link to download the driver.

 - Make sure that S880DB MKII is set as the audio output device. (2) For Mac users, access "System Preferences"→"Sound"→"Output" to select "EDIFIER S880DB MKII" as the current audio output device.
 - In USB mode, the following sample rates are supported: 44.1kHz, 48kHz, 96kHz, and 192kHz.

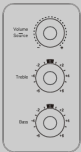

- Make sure that this product is in Bluetooth pairing mode. If not, manually switch it to this mode.
- Restart this product, enable Bluetooth function on your Bluetooth device, and then try again.
- Reset this product to factory settings and try again.

No power

- Make sure that the power cable is properly connected.
- Make sure that the power supply is not disconnected.
- Make sure that the main power button on the rear panel is switched to "ON".

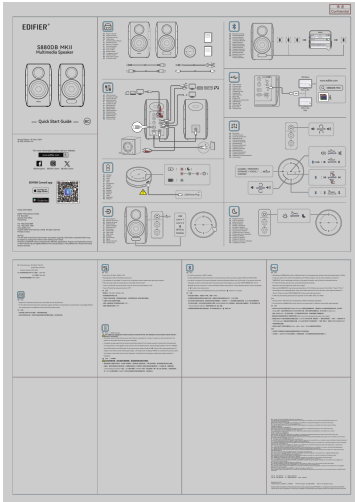
No sound

- Make sure that this product is powered on.
- Make sure that this product and your device is properly connected.

- Increase the volume of this product and your device.

Noise coming from speakers

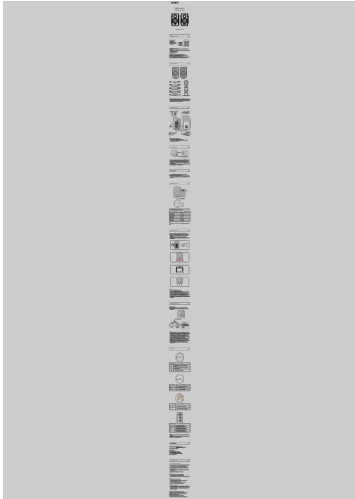

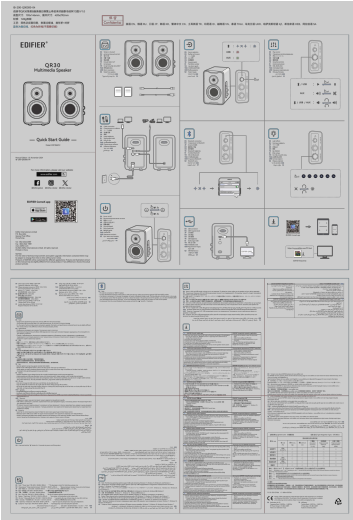

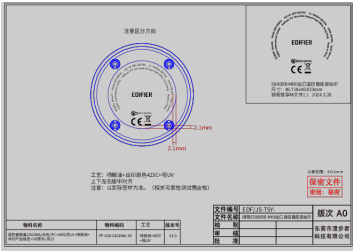
