# ASUS BR1102FGA 11.6-inch 2-in-1 Educational Laptop User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your ASUS BR1102FGA 11.6-inch HD Touchscreen 2-in-1 Educational Laptop. Designed for versatility, this device functions as both a traditional laptop and a tablet, featuring an Intel Celeron N100 processor, 4GB RAM, and a 128GB SSD, running on Windows 11 Pro. Its spill-resistant design and anti-glare coating enhance durability and usability in various environments.

## WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all items from the box. Ensure all components are present before proceeding with setup.

- ASUS BR1102FGA 11.6-inch 2-in-1 Educational Laptop
- Power Adapter and Cable
- 9H HDMI Cable (Accessory)
- Documentation (Quick Start Guide, Warranty Card)

## SETUP

### 1. Initial Charging and Power On

Before first use, connect the power adapter to the laptop's charging port and a power outlet. Allow the battery to charge for at least 30 minutes. Press the power button located on the right side of the device to turn it on.

## 2. Windows 11 Pro Setup

Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial Windows 11 Pro setup. This includes selecting your region, language, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, and creating a user account.

## 3. Connecting to Wi-Fi

During the Windows setup, you will be prompted to connect to a wireless network. Select your network from the list and enter the password. If you skip this step, you can connect later via the Windows Settings menu (Start > Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi).

## 4. Port Identification

Familiarize yourself with the available ports for connecting peripherals.

- **Left Side:** 1 x USB 2.0 Type-C, 1 x USB 3.2 Gen 2 Type-C, 1 x USB 3.2 Gen 2 Type-A, NETWORK (RJ-45), HDMI.
- **Right Side:** Power Button, Audio Jack, USB-A, USB-C, Volume Buttons.

## OPERATING

### 1. 2-in-1 Functionality

Your ASUS BR1102FGA is a versatile 2-in-1 device, allowing you to switch between laptop and tablet modes. The hinge allows for a full 360-degree rotation of the screen.

- **Laptop Mode:** Traditional clamshell configuration for typing and productivity.
- **Tablet Mode:** Fold the screen back completely to use as a tablet. The keyboard and touchpad will automatically disable.
- **Tent/Stand Mode:** Position the laptop in a tent or stand configuration for media consumption or presentations.

## 2. Touchscreen Operation

The 11.6-inch HD display supports multi-touch gestures. Use your fingers to navigate, tap, swipe, pinch-to-zoom, and interact with applications. The anti-glare coating helps reduce reflections for better visibility.

## 3. Keyboard and Touchpad

The integrated keyboard and touchpad provide standard input functionality. The keyboard is designed to be spill-resistant, offering protection against minor liquid spills.

## 4. Using the Cameras

The laptop features two cameras for various uses, including video conferencing and capturing images.

## MAINTENANCE

### 1. Cleaning Instructions

- **Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Keyboard and Chassis:** Use a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used. Ensure no liquid enters openings.

### 2. Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures. Do not fully discharge the battery frequently. For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50-60% and store in a cool, dry place.

### 3. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install Windows updates to ensure optimal performance, security, and compatibility. Go to Start > Settings > Windows Update.

## 4. Storage Management

Periodically review and delete unnecessary files to maintain sufficient free space on the 128GB SSD. Utilize cloud storage or external drives for large files.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### 1. Laptop Not Powering On

- Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet.
- Check if the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- Allow the laptop to charge for a period before attempting to power on again.

### 2. Slow Performance

- Close unnecessary applications running in the background.
- Check for and install any pending Windows updates.
- Ensure sufficient free space on the SSD.
- Restart the laptop.

### 3. Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues

- Verify that Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows Settings.
- Restart your router and modem.
- Forget the Wi-Fi network and reconnect.
- Ensure your laptop is within range of the Wi-Fi signal.

### 4. Touchscreen Not Responding

- Restart the laptop.
- Ensure the screen is clean and free of debris.
- Check for updated display drivers via Windows Update or the ASUS support website.
