## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your BTQILEYOO Y80-2X Motorcycle Helmet Bluetooth Headset. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper functionality and safety.

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in your package:

- BTQILEYOO Y80-2X Bluetooth Headset Unit
- Headphones (speakers)
- Microphone
- Mounting Clip
- USB Type-C Charging Cable
- User Manual

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components and controls of your Y80-2X headset.

**Work Indicator Light:** Displays device status.

**Voice Assistant Button:** Activates voice assistant.

**Power On/Off / Play/Pause / Hang Up Button:** Multi-function button.

**Type-C Speaker MAC Interface:** Connects speakers.

**Type-C Charging Port:** For charging the device.

**Intercom Key / Intercom/Charging Indicator:** Intercom function and charging status.

**Volume Up / Next Song:** Short press for volume up, long press for next song.

**Volume Down / Previous Song:** Short press for volume down, long press for previous song.

## 4. SETUP

### 4.1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge the headset. Connect the provided USB Type-C charging cable to the charging port on the headset and to a USB power source. The charging indicator will show charging status and turn off when fully charged.

## 4.2. Installation on Helmet

The Y80-2X headset is designed for easy installation on various helmet types, including full-face, half-face, off-road, unmask, and retro helmets.




Figure 4.1: The Y80-2X headset is compatible with various helmet types.

1. Attach the mounting clip to the side of your helmet. Ensure it is securely fastened.
2. Slide the Y80-2X main unit onto the mounting clip until it clicks into place.
3. Install the speakers inside the helmet, positioning them near your ears for optimal sound.
4. Position the microphone in front of your mouth, ensuring it is clear of obstructions.

## 4.3. Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your headset to a smartphone or other Bluetooth device:

1. Ensure the headset is powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power On/Off button until the indicator light flashes rapidly, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your smartphone, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "Y80-2X" from the list of devices.
5. Once paired, the indicator light will change to a slow flash or solid blue (refer to specific light patterns in the full manual).

The headset supports connecting to two mobile phones simultaneously, allowing flexible switching between music, navigation, and calls.




Figure 4.2: The Y80-2X headset can connect to two mobile phones simultaneously.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1. Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power On/Off button for approximately 3 seconds.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power On/Off button for approximately 5 seconds.

### 5.2. Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the Power On/Off button.
- **Next Song:** Long press the Volume Up button.
- **Previous Song:** Long press the Volume Down button.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the Volume Up button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the Volume Down button.

### 5.3. Phone Calls

- **Answer Call:** Short press the Power On/Off button when an incoming call is announced. The headset supports automatic answering after voice announcement of the telephone number.
- **End Call:** Short press the Power On/Off button during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the Power On/Off button when an incoming call is announced.
- **Voice Assistant:** Short press the Voice Assistant button to activate your phone's voice assistant (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant).

## Incoming calls are answered automatically

### 5.4. Intercom Function

The Y80-2X supports two-person intercom communication up to 500 meters and is compatible with other Bluetooth intercom headsets.

- **Start Intercom:** Short press the Intercom Key.
- **End Intercom:** Short press the Intercom Key again.

## 5.5. RGB Lighting Effect

The Y80-2X features a flash color RGB lighting effect. Specific controls for this feature are typically integrated with the main control buttons. Refer to the full product manual for detailed instructions on changing or disabling lighting modes.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the headset. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Water Resistance:** The headset is IPX6 rated for water resistance. While it can withstand splashes and rain, avoid submerging it in water. Ensure the charging port cover is securely closed.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place when not in use. Avoid extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge regularly.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headset does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headset fully.
Cannot pair with phone.	Headset not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on phone.	Ensure headset is in pairing mode (rapid flashing light). Enable Bluetooth on phone and search again.
No sound from speakers.	Volume too low; speakers not connected properly; faulty speakers.	Increase volume. Check speaker connection to the Type-C Speaker MAC Interface. If issue persists, contact support.
Intercom not working.	Out of range; not properly connected to other headset.	Ensure headsets are within 500m range. Re-establish intercom connection.
Poor call quality / Noise.	Environmental noise; microphone position.	The headset features CVC noise reduction. Ensure microphone is positioned correctly and not obstructed. Move away from excessive noise sources if possible.
