1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Attoe Wireless Gaming Mouse. This manual provides detailed instructions on how to set up, operate, and maintain your mouse to ensure optimal performance. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product.

This gaming mouse features a versatile three-mode connection (Wired, 2.4G Wireless, and Bluetooth 5.3), 6 programmable buttons, 5 adjustable DPI levels, and customizable RGB lighting. Its ergonomic hollow-out design ensures comfort during extended use.

4. SETUP AND CONNECTION

The Attoe Wireless Gaming Mouse supports three connection modes: Wired, 2.4G Wireless, and Bluetooth 5.3. Choose the mode that best suits your needs.

4.1. Wired Connection

1. Insert the mouse's USB Type-C cable into the USB port of your computer.
2. The mouse will be immediately ready for use. This mode also charges the mouse.

4.2. 2.4G Wireless Connection

1. Flip the power switch located at the bottom of the mouse to the "ON" position.
2. Plug the 2.4G USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
3. Hold down the mode switch button on the mouse for 3 seconds to enter the code matching state. The indicator light on the mouse will blink red rapidly.
4. Once successfully paired, the indicator light will turn off.

4.3. Bluetooth (BT1/BT2) Connection

1. Flip the power switch located at the bottom of the mouse to the "ON" position.
2. Hold down the mode switch button on the mouse for 3 seconds to enter the code matching state.
3. **For BT1:** The green light will blink rapidly during code alignment. Once connected, it will blink green during connection back. The indicator will turn off upon successful connection.
4. **For BT2:** The blue light will blink rapidly during code alignment. Once connected, it will blink blue during connection back. The indicator will turn off upon successful connection.
5. On your computer or device, navigate to Bluetooth settings and select the Attoe mouse from the list of available devices to pair.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. DPI Adjustment

The mouse features 5 adjustable DPI levels: 800, 1200, 1600, 2400, and 3600. You can cycle through these DPI settings by pressing the dedicated DPI button, usually located behind the scroll wheel. Adjust the DPI to match your preference for gaming or general use.

5.2. Programmable Buttons

The mouse is equipped with 6 programmable buttons. These buttons can be customized using the dedicated T66 Mouse Software to assign macros, key functions, or other commands. Refer to the software's instructions for detailed programming steps.

5.3. RGB Lighting Modes

The Attoe gaming mouse features 6 RGB lighting modes. You can adjust or turn off the lighting effects by pressing the dedicated LED button on the mouse. The lighting enhances the aesthetic appeal and can be customized to your preference.

6. CHARGING THE MOUSE

The Attoe Wireless Gaming Mouse has a built-in 650mAh rechargeable battery. When the battery is low, you may experience slow, unstable, or non-responsive cursor movement. It is recommended to charge the mouse promptly.

- Connect the provided Type-C charge cable to the mouse's charging port.
- Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).
- The mouse will function normally while charging in wired mode.

8. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Attoe Wireless Gaming Mouse, please follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the mouse. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, but ensure no liquid enters the mouse. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the mouse in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Handling:** Avoid dropping the mouse or subjecting it to strong impacts. Do not disassemble the mouse, as this may void the warranty and cause damage.
- **Battery Care:** For best battery life, avoid fully discharging the mouse frequently. Charge it when the low battery indicator appears.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Attoe Wireless Gaming Mouse, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Mouse not responding / No movement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the mouse is powered on.◦ Check battery level; charge the mouse if low.◦ For 2.4G wireless: Ensure the USB receiver is properly plugged in and the mouse is paired. Try re-pairing if necessary.◦ For Bluetooth: Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and the mouse is paired. Try re-pairing.◦ For wired: Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the mouse and the computer.◦ Try connecting to a different USB port or a different computer to rule out port or system issues.
Cursor movement is slow or erratic	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Low battery: Charge the mouse.◦ Interference (for wireless modes): Move the mouse closer to the receiver/device or away from other wireless devices.◦ Dirty sensor: Clean the optical sensor at the bottom of the mouse with a soft cloth.◦ Surface issues: Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective, and uniform surface.◦ DPI setting: Adjust the DPI to a higher level if movement is too slow.
Buttons not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the mouse is properly connected and powered.◦ Check if any software conflicts are present. Try restarting your computer.◦ If using custom button assignments, check the T66 Mouse Software settings.
RGB lighting not working or stuck	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Press the LED button to cycle through modes or turn it on/off.◦ Ensure the mouse has sufficient power.◦ If using software control, check the lighting settings in the T66 Mouse Software.
