## INTRODUCTION

The Logitech POP Mouse is a compact and portable wireless Bluetooth mouse designed for modern workspaces. It features programmable buttons, quiet clicks, and the ability to easily switch between up to three devices. #### **SETUP**

#### 1. Powering On

The POP Mouse comes with a pre-installed AA battery. To power on the mouse, locate the power switch on the bottom of the mouse and slide it to the ON position.

#### 2. Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure the mouse is powered on.
- 2. Press and hold the Easy-Switch button on the bottom of the mouse for 3 seconds until the LED light starts blinking rapidly. This indicates the mouse is in pairing mode.
- 3. On your device (laptop, tablet, PC), navigate to the Bluetooth settings.
- 4. Select "Logitech POP Mouse" from the list of available devices to complete the pairing process.
- 5. The LED light on the mouse will turn solid for 5 seconds to confirm successful pairing.

The POP Mouse can connect to up to 3 devices simultaneously. Use the Easy-Switch button to toggle between paired devices.



## **Smartwheel Speed Scroll**

The Smartwheel allows you to switch between high-precision tracking and speed scrolling with a single flick. This feature enables quick navigation through documents and web pages.




Image: A hand demonstrating the use of the Logitech POP Mouse, highlighting its Smartwheel for fast scrolling.




Image: A user interacting with a computer, demonstrating how the customizable action buttons on the Logitech POP

The POP Mouse incorporates Silent Touch Technology, which reduces click noise by over 90% compared to standard mice. This feature ensures a quiet working environment.




Image: A user operating the Logitech POP Mouse, illustrating the quiet clicking experience provided by Silent Touch Technology.

## **Multi-Device Connectivity**




Image: The Logitech POP Mouse positioned next to a compatible keyboard on a desk, demonstrating its compact design and suitability for various setups.

## **Cleaning Your Mouse**

To maintain optimal performance and hygiene, regularly clean your POP Mouse. Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or submerging the mouse in liquid.

#### **Battery Replacement**

The Logitech POP Mouse is powered by one AA battery, offering up to 2 years of battery life depending on usage. When the battery is low, the LED indicator on the mouse may flash. To replace the battery:

- 1. Turn off the mouse using the power switch on the bottom.
- 2. Gently remove the top cover of the mouse. It is magnetically attached.
- 3. Remove the old AA battery and insert a new one, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
- 4. Replace the top cover and turn the mouse back on.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

## Mouse Not Connecting/Responding

- Check Battery: Ensure the battery is not depleted. Replace if necessary.
- Power Cycle: Turn the mouse off and then on again.
- **Re-pair Bluetooth:** Go to your device's Bluetooth settings, remove the POP Mouse, and then re-pair it following the "Bluetooth Pairing" steps in the Setup section.
- **Device Compatibility:** Ensure your device's operating system is compatible (Windows, macOS, iPadOS, ChromeOS, Linux).
- Interference: Move the mouse closer to your device and away from other wireless devices that might cause interference.

## **Cursor Movement is Erratic or Jumpy**

- Clean Sensor: Ensure the optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse is clean and free of debris.
- Surface: Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective, and uniform surface. Mouse pads are recommended.
- Battery Level: Low battery can sometimes affect tracking performance. Replace the battery.

## **Action Button Not Working**

- Logi Options+ App: Ensure the Logi Options+ App is installed and running on your computer.
- Configuration: Verify that the action button is correctly configured within the Logi Options+ App.
