Model: Air Touch V1 (HC000025/AP/V1)

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Honeywell Air Touch V1 Air Purifier. This device is engineered to provide a cleaner and healthier indoor environment by effectively removing airborne pollutants. This manual contains important information regarding the safe operation, installation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your air purifier. Please read it thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

## 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

---

- **Comprehensive Air Purification:** Protects homes and offices from smoke, dust, pollens, viruses, bacteria, and pet dander, ensuring a safe indoor environment.
- **High Filtration Efficiency:** Removes 99.99% of micro allergens and airborne pollutants, including PM2.5 and PM10 particles.
- **Optimal Coverage:** Features a Clean Air Delivery Rate (CADR) of up to 152 m<sup>3</sup>/h, covering areas up to 235 sq. ft. (22 sq. m) with 2 air changes per hour.
- **Advanced 3-Stage Filtration:** Incorporates a Pre-filter, High-Grade H13 HEPA Filter, and Activated Carbon Filter for thorough purification.
- **Rapid Purification Cycle:** Completes an air purification cycle every 12 minutes.
- **Quiet Operation:** Operates at a low noise level of 29 dB(A), ensuring minimal disturbance.
- **User-Friendly Controls:** Equipped with one-touch control for easy operation.
- **Filter Life Indicator:** Includes a filter reset indicator and boasts a filter life of up to 9000 hours or 1 year.

- **Manufacturer Warranty:** Comes with a 2-year manufacturer warranty.

## 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

### 3.1 Unpacking

1. Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging.
2. Check for any damage during transit. If damaged, do not operate and contact customer support.
3. Remove all protective plastic films or packaging materials from the unit and filters.

### 3.2 Filter Installation

The Honeywell Air Touch V1 comes with a 3-in-1 filter system. Ensure all filters are correctly installed before first use.

1. Turn the air purifier upside down.
2. Twist the base cover counter-clockwise to unlock and remove it.
3. Carefully remove the combined filter unit from the air purifier.

4. Remove any plastic packaging from the filter.
5. Insert the filter back into the air purifier, ensuring it is seated correctly.
6. Replace the base cover and twist clockwise to lock it securely.

### 3.3 Placement

- Place the air purifier on a firm, level surface.
- Ensure there is at least 30 cm (12 inches) of clear space around the air inlet and outlet for optimal airflow.
- Avoid placing the unit near heat sources, direct sunlight, or in areas with high humidity.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Power On/Off

- Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
- Press the **Power Button** (usually indicated by a power symbol) on the top panel to turn the unit ON or OFF.

## 4.2 Fan Speed Control

The air purifier typically offers multiple fan speed settings to adjust purification intensity and noise level.

- Press the **Fan Speed Button** (often indicated by fan blades or multiple lines) to cycle through available speeds (e.g., Low, Medium, High, Sleep Mode).
- Select **Sleep Mode** for quiet operation during nighttime.

## 4.3 Air Purification Cycle

The Honeywell Air Touch V1 is designed to purify the air in a room every 12 minutes, ensuring continuous clean air circulation.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your air purifier. Always unplug the unit before performing any maintenance.

### 5.1 Filter Replacement Indicator

The unit is equipped with a filter reset indicator that illuminates when it's time to replace the filter. The filter life is approximately 9000 hours or 1 year, depending on usage and air quality.

### 5.2 Replacing the 3-in-1 Filter

1. Unplug the air purifier from the power outlet.
2. Turn the unit upside down and unlock the base cover by twisting it counter-clockwise.
3. Remove the old 3-in-1 filter unit.
4. Dispose of the old filter responsibly.

5. Insert the new 3-in-1 filter into the unit, ensuring it fits snugly.
6. Replace the base cover and twist clockwise to lock it.
7. Plug in the air purifier. Press and hold the **Filter Reset Button** (refer to your unit's control panel for exact location) for 3-5 seconds until the indicator light turns off, resetting the filter life counter.

### 5.3 Cleaning the Pre-Filter

The pre-filter is washable and helps extend the life of the HEPA filter by capturing larger particles.

- The pre-filter is integrated into the 3-in-1 filter unit. While the entire unit is replaced, the pre-filter component can be gently cleaned if accessible and recommended by the manufacturer.
- For this model, the pre-filter is part of the composite filter. When the filter replacement indicator lights up, the entire 3-in-1 filter unit should be replaced.

### 5.4 Exterior Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure no water enters the unit.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	Not plugged in. Power outage. Filter not installed correctly.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the circuit breaker. Verify the filter is correctly seated and the base cover is locked.
Airflow is weak or purification is ineffective.	Filters are dirty or clogged. Obstruction around air inlets/outlets. Room size exceeds coverage area.	Replace the 3-in-1 filter. Ensure clear space around the unit. Confirm the unit is suitable for your room size (235 sq. ft. max).
Unit is making unusual noise.	Filter not installed correctly. Foreign object inside the unit. Unit not on a level surface.	Reinstall the filter. Unplug and check for any foreign objects. Place the unit on a stable, flat surface.
Filter replacement indicator remains on after filter change.	Filter reset not performed.	After replacing the filter, press and hold the Filter Reset Button for 3-5 seconds until the light turns off.
