INTRODUCTION

The Rowenta Duo Force is a versatile 2-in-1 appliance designed for both steam ironing and garment steaming. Its lightweight design, rapid heat-up, and powerful steam output ensure efficient and effective garment care. This manual provides essential information for safe and optimal use of your appliance.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet when filling with water, emptying, or during cleaning, and when not in use.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended while it is connected to the mains supply.
- Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children less than 8 years.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- Use the appliance only for its intended household use.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Use only distilled or demineralized water. Tap water may cause mineral buildup.

Key Features:

- **2-in-1 Functionality:** Seamlessly switches between powerful steam ironing and efficient garment steaming.
- **Stainless Steel Soleplate:** Provides excellent glide and durability for smooth ironing.
- **Precision Tip:** Designed for reaching difficult areas like collars and seams.
- **Detachable Water Tank:** 13.5-oz capacity for extended use and easy refilling.
- **Rapid Heat-Up:** Ready to use in approximately 30 seconds.
- **Powerful Steam Boost:** Up to 180 g/min steam output for stubborn wrinkles.
- **Auto-Off Feature:** Enhances safety by automatically shutting off when left unattended.
- **No-Setting Technology:** Automatically adjusts heat and steam for all ironable fabrics.
- **Anti-Drip System:** Prevents water stains on garments.
- **Anti-Calc Function:** Helps maintain steam performance over time.
- **Ultra-lightweight Design:** Weighs only 1.65 lbs for comfortable handling.

- **Lock & Carry System:** For secure transport and storage.

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the iron and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **First Use Preparation:** Before first use, remove any labels or protective film from the soleplate. It is normal for a small amount of smoke or odor to be produced during the first few minutes of use. This will disappear quickly.
3. **Filling the Water Tank:**
 - Ensure the iron is unplugged.
 - Detach the water tank by pressing the release button and sliding it out.
 - Fill the tank with distilled or demineralized water up to the 'MAX' line. Do not use scented water, water from tumble dryers, or other additives.
 - Reinsert the water tank until it clicks securely into place.

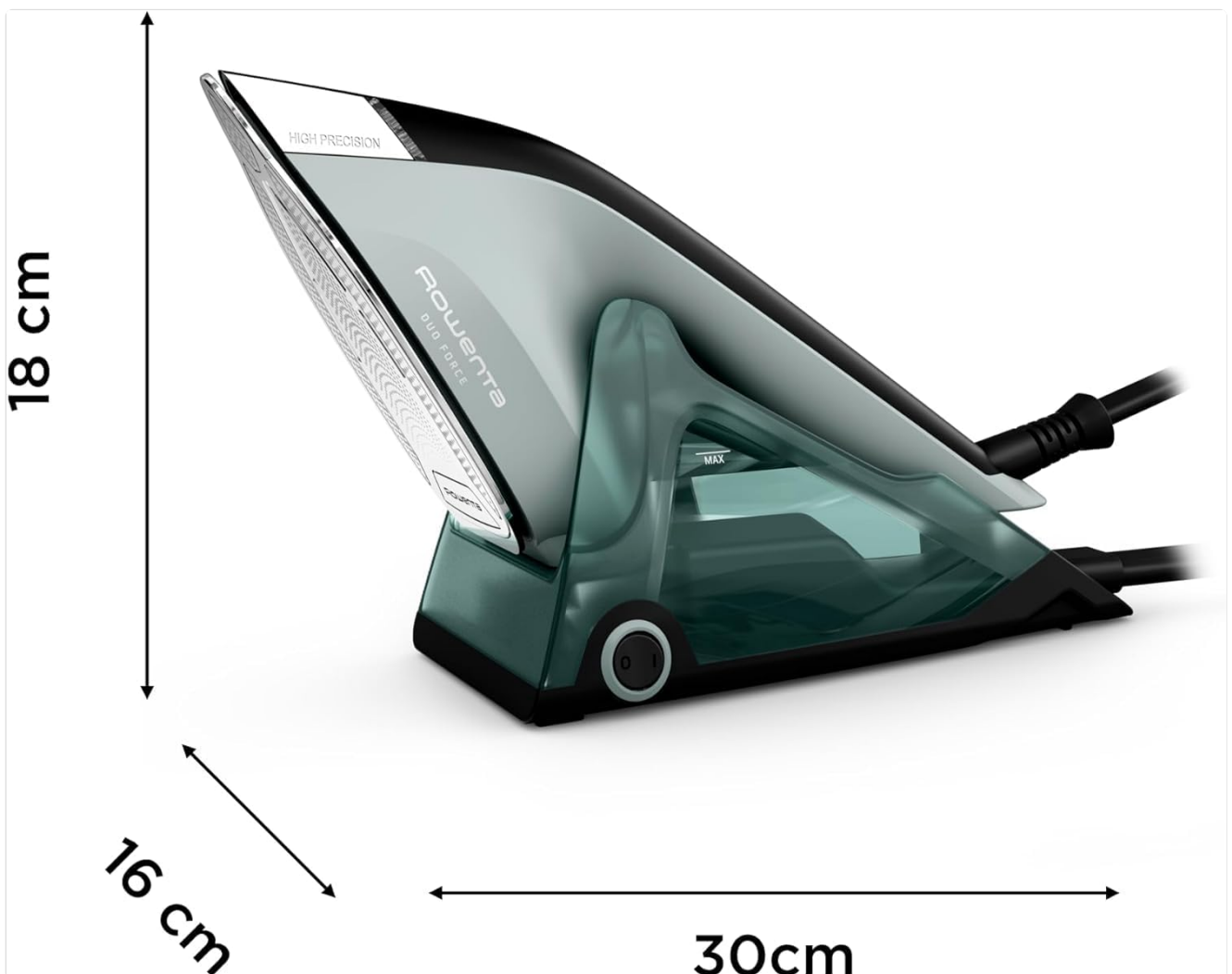


Figure 5: The detachable water tank, which may contain residual water from factory testing.

4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet. The indicator light will illuminate.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Ironing Mode:

1. **Heat-Up:** The iron heats up in approximately 30 seconds. The indicator light will turn off when the desired

temperature is reached.

2. **Fabric Selection:** Due to the no-setting technology, the iron automatically adjusts to all ironable fabrics. No manual temperature adjustment is needed.
3. **Steam Ironing:** Press the steam trigger under the handle to release continuous steam. For an extra burst of steam, press the steam boost button.
4. **Dry Ironing:** For dry ironing, ensure the steam control is set to the 'no steam' position.
5. **Spray Function:** Use the spray button on the top of the handle to lightly moisten stubborn wrinkles.

Steaming Mode (Vertical Steaming):

1. **Preparation:** Hang the garment on a hanger. Ensure the water tank is filled.
2. **Steaming:** Hold the iron vertically, close to the fabric, but not touching it. Press the steam trigger to release steam. Move the iron up and down the garment.

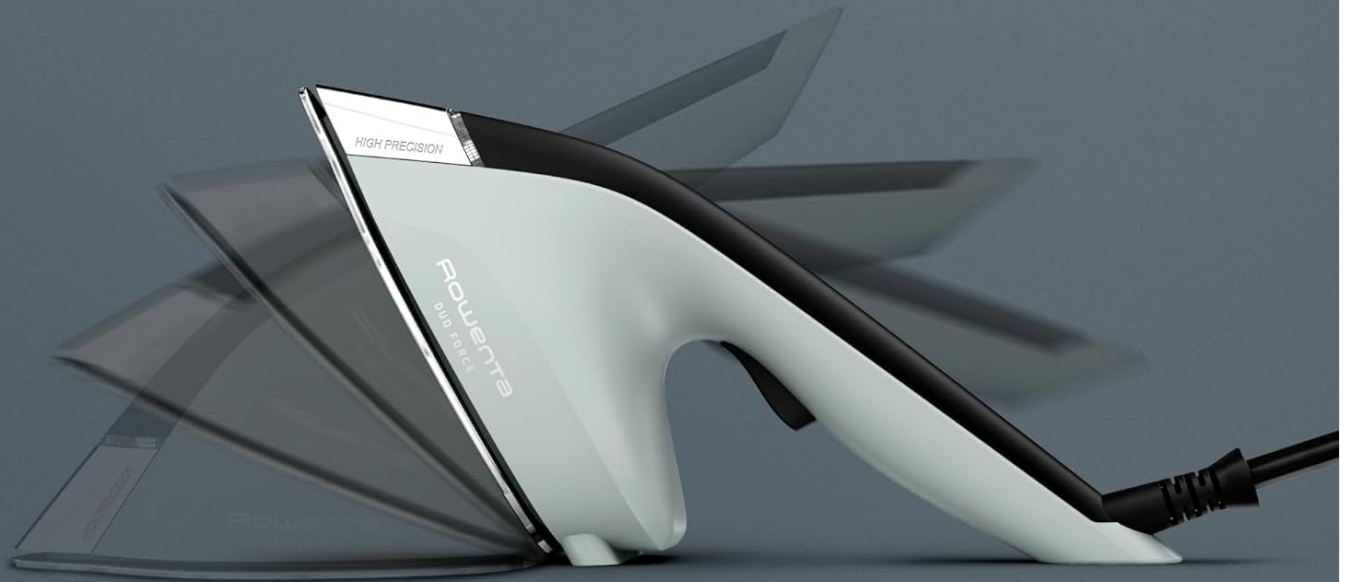
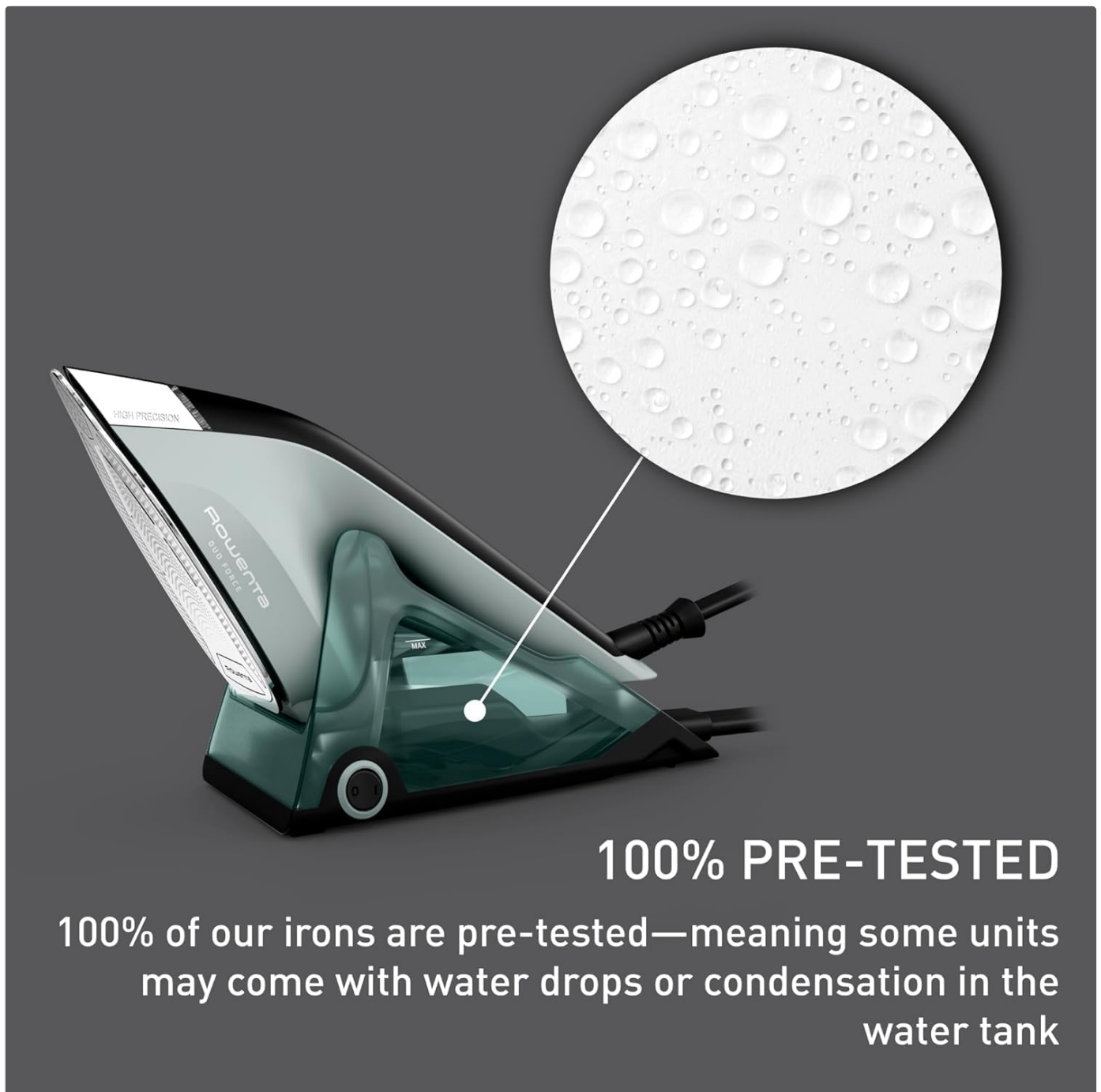


Figure 7: The Rowenta Duo Force being used for vertical steaming, ideal for delicate fabrics or quick touch-ups.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

1. After Each Use:

- Unplug the iron and allow it to cool completely.
- Empty any remaining water from the tank.
- Wipe the soleplate with a damp cloth to remove any residue.

2. **Anti-Calc System:** The integrated anti-calc system helps prevent limescale buildup. For optimal performance, regularly perform the self-clean function as described in the full manual (if applicable).

3. **Storage:** Store the iron vertically on its heel in a safe, dry place. Use the Lock & Carry System for secure transport.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Iron does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction.	Check power cord connection; test outlet with another appliance.
No steam or insufficient steam.	Water tank empty; steam control set to 'no steam'; iron not hot enough.	Fill water tank; adjust steam control; allow iron to heat up fully.
Water dripping from soleplate.	Temperature too low for steam; anti-drip system not engaged.	Allow iron to reach full temperature before using steam.
White flakes coming from soleplate.	Mineral buildup (limescale).	Perform self-clean function; use distilled water only.
