Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the ZDK Projector. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your projector to ensure optimal performance and longevity. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and keep it for future reference.

Safety Information

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, please observe the following safety precautions:

- Do not look directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on.
- Do not place the projector in direct sunlight or near heat sources.
- Ensure proper ventilation; do not block ventilation openings.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the projector yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Keep the projector away from water or any liquids.
- Use only attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

Product Overview

Components and Ports

Familiarize yourself with the various parts and connection ports of your ZDK Projector.

The ZDK Projector features a robust design with multiple connectivity options to suit various media sources.

Setup

1. Placement and Projection Size

Choose a flat, stable surface for the projector. The projection distance will determine the screen size. The ZDK Projector supports a display area from 35 inches to a maximum of 300 inches.

2. Power Connection

Connect the power cable to the projector's power input and then plug it into a wall outlet.

3. Focus and Keystone Correction

Adjust the focus ring on the projector lens until the image is clear. Use the keystone correction feature (if available on your model, typically a ring or digital setting) to correct any trapezoidal distortion of the image, ensuring a perfectly rectangular display.

Operating

1. Turning On/Off

- **Power On:** Press the power button on the projector or the remote control.

- **Power Off:** Press the power button again. The projector will go into standby mode.

2. Input Source Selection

Use the "Source" button on the remote or projector to select your desired input (HDMI, USB, AV, etc.).

3. Wireless Connectivity (WiFi & Bluetooth)

The ZDK Projector supports 2.4G+5G WiFi for screen mirroring and Bluetooth 5.1 for audio output.

WiFi Screen Mirroring:

- Select "Screen Mirroring" or "Wireless Display" from the projector's main menu.
- **For iOS devices:** Connect your iPhone/iPad to the same WiFi network as the projector. Open Control Center, tap "Screen Mirroring," and select the projector from the list.
- **For Android devices:** Ensure your Android device supports Multi-screen, Wireless Display, or Smart View. Connect to the same WiFi network, then activate the mirroring function and select the projector.
- **For Windows devices:** Use the "Project" feature (Windows key + P) and select "Connect to a wireless display."

2.4+5G Dual-Band WiFi allows for faster and more stable screen mirroring

Bluetooth Audio Connection:

- Go to the projector's "Settings" menu and select "Bluetooth."
- Turn on Bluetooth on the projector and put your Bluetooth speaker or headphones into pairing mode.
- Select your device from the list of available devices on the projector's screen to connect.

4. Menu Navigation

Use the arrow keys and "OK" button on the remote or projector to navigate through the on-screen menu. Adjust settings such as picture mode, sound mode, aspect ratio, and more.

Maintenance

Regular maintenance helps prolong the life of your projector.

- **Lens Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cloths.
- **Body Cleaning:** Wipe the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn stains, use a slightly damp cloth and then dry thoroughly.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the ventilation openings are clear of dust and debris. Use a soft brush or compressed air to gently

- clean them.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the projector in a cool, dry place, ideally in its original packaging or a protective case.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your projector, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image on screen	Power not connected; Incorrect input source; Cable loose.	Check power cable; Select correct input source; Reconnect cables securely.
Blurry image	Out of focus; Incorrect projection distance.	Adjust focus ring; Adjust projector distance to screen.
No sound	Volume too low; Muted; Incorrect audio output selected; Bluetooth not connected.	Increase volume; Unmute; Check audio settings; Reconnect Bluetooth device.
WiFi mirroring issues	Not on same network; Device compatibility; Network interference.	Ensure both devices are on the same 2.4G/5G WiFi network; Check device mirroring support; Try restarting router/projector.
Overheating	Blocked ventilation; Prolonged use.	Ensure vents are clear; Allow projector to cool down.

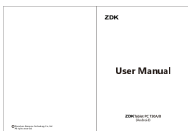
