## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your BenQ MA270U 27-inch 4K monitor. Designed for seamless integration with MacBook Pro and MacBook Air, this monitor offers a vibrant 4K display, versatile USB-C connectivity with power delivery, and an adjustable stand for ergonomic comfort. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper functionality and longevity of your device.

## 3. SETUP

---

### 3.1 Assembling the Stand

The monitor stand is designed for easy, tool-free assembly. Attach the base to the stand column, then secure the column to the back of the monitor until it clicks into place.

## 3.2 Connecting the Monitor

The BenQ MA270U offers versatile connectivity options. For MacBook users, a single USB-C cable can handle video, audio, and power delivery.

- **USB-C Connection:** Connect one end of the USB-C cable to the monitor's 90W USB-C port and the other end to your MacBook. This single cable provides video signal, up to 90W power delivery to charge your MacBook, and enables the integrated MacBook controls.
- **HDMI Connection:** Use an HDMI cable to connect your computer or other devices to one of the monitor's two HDMI 2.0 ports.
- **Power Connection:** Connect the power cable to the monitor's power input and then to a wall outlet.

### 4.1 Powering On/Off

Press the power button located on the monitor to turn it on or off. The monitor will automatically detect the input signal from your connected device.

### 4.2 Integrated MacBook Controls

When connected via USB-C, the BenQ MA270U allows you to adjust brightness and volume directly from your MacBook keyboard,

providing a seamless user experience.

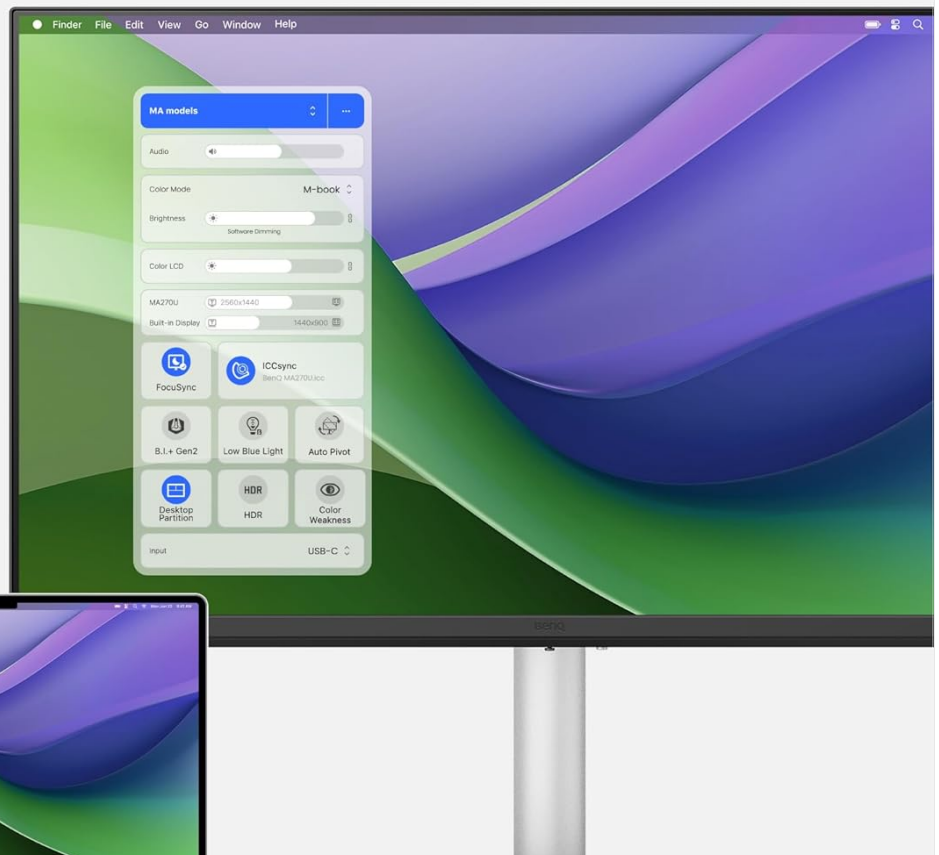


Figure 4.2: Screenshot of the Display Pilot 2 software interface on a MacBook, demonstrating simplified settings for the BenQ MA270U monitor.

## 5. FEATURES OVERVIEW

### 5.1 Mac Color Match (P3 Color Gamut)

The BenQ MA270U is calibrated to match MacBook color profiles, offering a vibrant P3 wide color gamut. This ensures consistent and accurate color representation, crucial for creative professionals.

### 5.2 Dual USB-C with Power Delivery

The monitor features two USB-C ports. One port delivers up to 90W of power, ideal for charging your MacBook Pro/Air while

connected. The second USB-C port provides 15W, suitable for charging smaller devices like an iPad or iPhone.

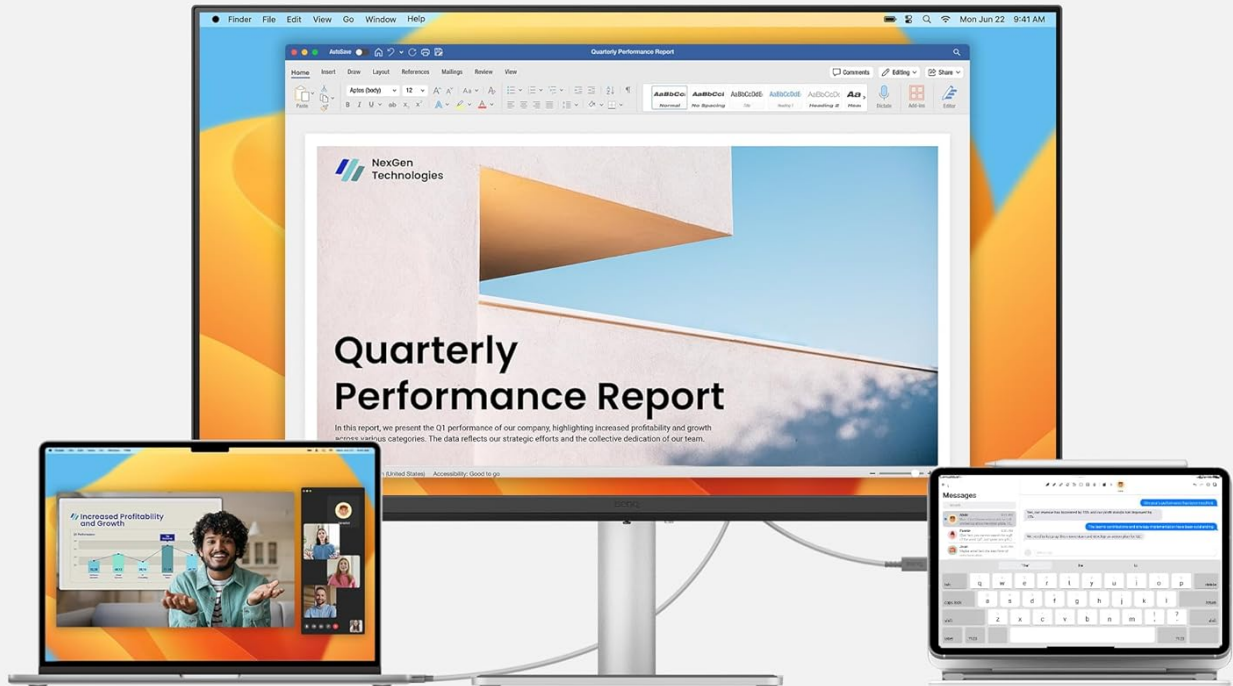


Figure 5.1: The monitor acting as a powerful hub, connecting and charging a MacBook and an iPad simultaneously via its dual USB-C ports.

## 5.3 Adjustable Stand

The ergonomic stand allows for extensive adjustments to optimize your viewing comfort. You can adjust the monitor's height, tilt, swivel, and pivot (90 degrees for portrait mode).

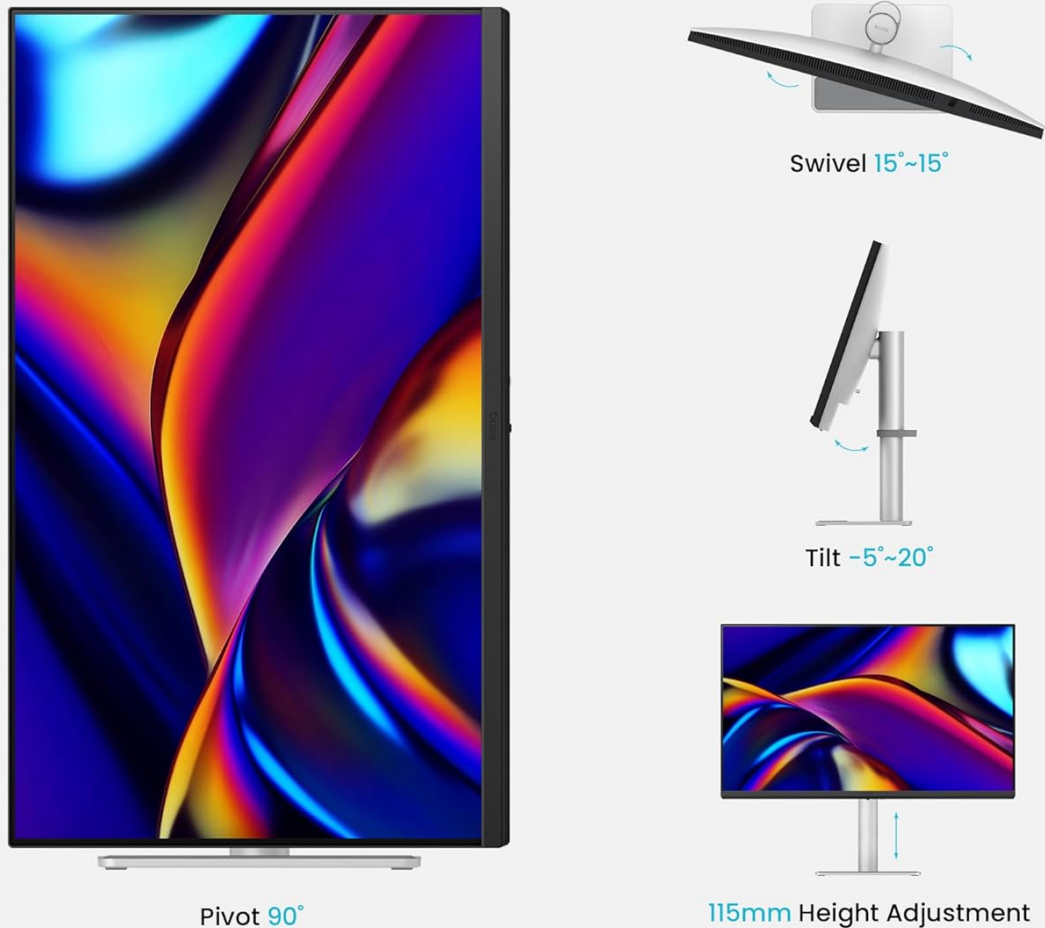


Figure 5.2: Visual representation of the adjustable stand's capabilities, including height adjustment (115mm), pivot (90°), swivel ( $\pm 15^\circ$ ), and tilt ( $-5^\circ$  to  $20^\circ$ ).

## 7. MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your BenQ MA270U monitor, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn smudges, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-specific cleaning solution. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Cleaning the Casing:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the monitor's casing.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the monitor's ventilation openings are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- **Power Off When Not in Use:** Turn off the monitor when not in use for extended periods to conserve energy and prolong its lifespan.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your BenQ MA270U monitor, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Display/Black Screen:**
  - Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the monitor and the power outlet.
  - Verify that the video cable (USB-C or HDMI) is firmly connected to both the monitor and your computer.
  - Check if your computer is powered on and not in sleep mode.
  - Try switching to a different video input source on the monitor (if applicable) to rule out input issues.
- **No Sound:**
  - Ensure the volume on both the monitor and your computer is not muted and is turned up.
  - If using USB-C, confirm that audio output is selected to the monitor in your MacBook's sound settings.
  - If using HDMI, ensure your computer's audio output is set to the monitor.
- **Color Inaccuracies/Blurry Text:**
  - Ensure the monitor is set to its native 4K (3840x2160) resolution.
  - For Mac users, ensure the correct color profile is selected in Display Settings. The monitor is calibrated for Mac colors.
  - Install and use the BenQ Display Pilot 2 software for fine-tuning color settings.

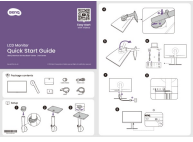

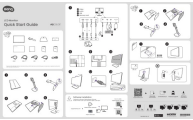
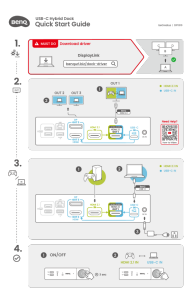
