4. SETUP

4.1. Electric Piano Keyboard Setup

- 1. Unpacking: Carefully remove the keyboard and all accessories from the packaging.
- 2. **Keyboard Stand Assembly:** Assemble the included keyboard stand according to its separate instructions. Place the keyboard securely on the stand.
- 3. **Power Connection:** Connect the power adapter to the DC IN jack on the back of the keyboard, then plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
- 4. Sustain Pedal: Insert the sustain pedal cable into the SUSTAIN jack.
- 5. **Microphone:** Connect the microphone to the MIC IN jack.
- 6. **Audio Output:** For external amplification, connect an audio cable from the AUDIO OUT jack to an amplifier or speaker system.

4.2. Acoustic Guitar Setup

- 1. **Unpacking:** Remove the guitar from its gig bag.
- 2. **Tuning:** Use the included digital tuner to tune the guitar strings. Attach the tuner to the headstock. Pluck each string individually and adjust the tuning pegs until the tuner indicates the correct pitch (E-A-D-G-B-e from thickest to thinnest string).



3. **Strap Attachment:** If desired, attach the guitar strap to the strap buttons located at the base of the guitar body and near the neck joint.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Electric Piano Keyboard Operation


- 1. Power On/Off: Press the POWER button to turn the keyboard on or off.
- 2. Volume Control: Use the VOLUME knob or buttons to adjust the overall sound level.
- 3. **Selecting Tones (Voices):** Press the TONE button, then use the number keypad or +/- buttons to select from 600 available instrument sounds.
- 4. **Selecting Rhythms:** Press the RHYTHM button, then use the number keypad or +/- buttons to select from 400 accompaniment styles. Press START/STOP to begin or end the rhythm.
- 5. **Demo Songs:** Press the DEMO button to play through the 50 built-in demo songs. Use the +/- buttons to

- select a specific song.
- 6. **Lighted Keys Feature:** The keyboard features LED lighted keys that illuminate during demo songs or teaching modes to guide your playing.
- 7. **Teaching Modes:** The keyboard offers 3 teaching modes to assist beginners. Refer to the specific instructions on the keyboard's display for mode selection and usage.

8. **Dual Keyboard Mode:** This feature allows two players to use the keyboard simultaneously, splitting it into two independent sections. Consult the keyboard's display for activation.

- 9. **Recording and Playback:** Use the RECORD button to start recording your performance and PLAYBACK to listen to your recorded track.
- 10. **USB Connectivity:** The USB port allows for connection to a computer or a USB flash drive for expanded accompaniment options or MIDI functionality.




Image 5.4: A USB flash drive being inserted into the Vangoa keyboard's USB port, illustrating its capability for expanded accompaniment and data transfer.

11. **Other Features:** Explore functions like Sustain, Vibrato, Chord modes, EQ settings, and Percussion options using the dedicated buttons on the control panel.

5.2. Acoustic Guitar Operation

- 1. **Holding the Guitar:** Sit comfortably and rest the guitar on your lap, or stand with the strap over your shoulder.
- 2. **Strumming:** Use a pick or your fingers to strum the strings over the soundhole.
- 3. **Fretting Notes:** Press down on the strings behind the frets with your left-hand fingers to produce different notes.
- 4. **Using the Capo:** A capo can be placed across the fretboard to raise the pitch of all strings simultaneously, allowing you to play in different keys without changing chord shapes.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe down both instruments. For the keyboard, ensure it is unplugged. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- String Care (Guitar): Wipe guitar strings after each use to remove oils and dirt, which can prolong string

life. Replace strings when they become dull, corroded, or break.

- **Storage:** Store instruments in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures and humidity. Use the gig bag for the guitar to protect it from dust and minor impacts.
- Transportation: When transporting, ensure instruments are securely packed to prevent damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
No sound from keyboard	Power off; Volume too low; Headphones connected; External speakers off.	Ensure power is on; Increase volume; Disconnect headphones; Turn on external speakers.	
Keys not lighting up	Not in teaching/demo mode; Feature disabled.	Select a teaching mode or demo song; Check keyboard settings to enable lighted keys.	
Guitar sounds out of tune	Strings stretched; Tuning pegs slipped.	Retune the guitar using the digital tuner. New strings may require frequent tuning initially.	
Buzzing sound from guitar strings	Improper fretting; Action too low; Worn frets.	Ensure fingers are pressing firmly behind the fret; If persistent, consult a guitar technician.
