INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Udreamer Turntable with Integrated Preamplifier. This Hi-Fi system features 40W bookshelf speakers, Bluetooth connectivity, an aluminum platter, and a 2-speed belt drive. Designed for vinyl enthusiasts, it delivers high-fidelity sound reproduction close to the original recording. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Place the turntable on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive vibration. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit and speakers.

2. Assembling the Turntable

1. **Install the Platter:** Gently place the solid aluminum platter onto the spindle. Ensure it sits securely.
2. **Install the Belt:** Locate the drive belt (usually pre-installed or in a separate bag). Carefully stretch the belt around the inner rim of the platter and hook it onto the motor pulley.
3. **Place the Platter Mat:** Lay the felt platter mat on top of the platter.
4. **Install the Counterweight:** Slide the counterweight onto the rear of the tonearm. Rotate it to adjust tracking force later.
5. **Install the Dust Cover:** Attach the removable dust cover to the hinges at the back of the turntable.

3. Connecting the Speakers

Connect the included bookshelf speakers to the passive speaker jacks on the rear of the turntable using the provided speaker wires. Ensure correct polarity (positive to positive, negative to negative) for optimal sound.

4. Power Connection

Connect the 9V 2A power adapter to the DC IN port on the back of the turntable, then plug it into a wall outlet.

5. Tonearm Balance and Tracking Force Adjustment

Properly balancing the tonearm and setting the tracking force is crucial for sound quality and record longevity.

1. **Zero Balance:** With the stylus guard on, release the tonearm clamp. Rotate the counterweight until the tonearm floats freely and is perfectly level.
2. **Set Tracking Force:** Once balanced, hold the counterweight steady and rotate the numbered ring to '0'. Then, rotate the entire counterweight (including the numbered ring) counter-clockwise to the recommended tracking force for the AT-3600L cartridge, which is typically 3.5 grams.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Playing a Record

1. Place a record on the platter.
2. Select the appropriate speed (33 1/3 or 45 RPM) using the speed selector switch. For 45 RPM records, place the 45 RPM adapter on the spindle if needed.
3. Remove the stylus guard from the cartridge.
4. Gently lift the tonearm using the cueing lever.
5. Move the tonearm over the desired starting groove of the record.
6. Slowly lower the cueing lever to gently drop the stylus onto the record.

7. Adjust the volume using the main volume knob.
8. To stop playback, lift the tonearm using the cueing lever, return it to the tonearm rest, and secure it with the clamp.

2. Bluetooth Connectivity (Input & Output)

The Udreamer turntable supports both Bluetooth input and output.

Bluetooth Output (Connecting to Bluetooth Speakers/Headphones)

1. Ensure your Bluetooth receiver (speaker, headphones) is in pairing mode.
2. Turn the "BT OUT" knob on the turntable to activate Bluetooth output. The indicator light will flash.
3. The turntable will automatically search for and connect to nearby Bluetooth devices. Once connected, the indicator light will become solid.
4. You can now play records, and the audio will be streamed to your connected Bluetooth device.

Bluetooth Input (Playing Music from Phone/Tablet)

1. Turn the "BT IN" knob on the turntable to activate Bluetooth input. The indicator light will flash.
2. On your smartphone or tablet, search for Bluetooth devices and select "Udreamer Turntable" (or similar name).
3. Once connected, the indicator light will become solid.
4. You can now play music from your phone/tablet through the turntable's speakers.

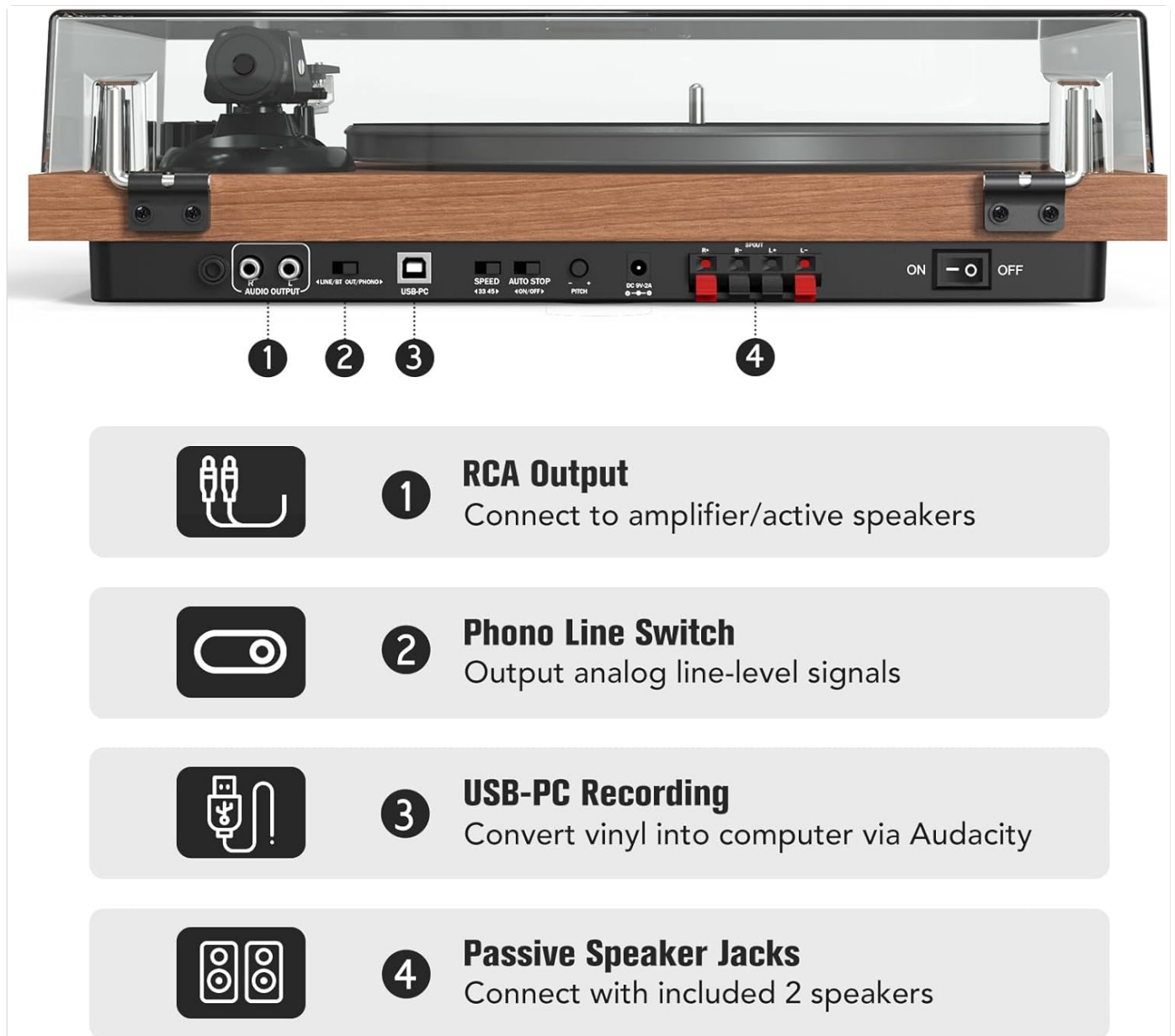

3. USB-PC Recording

You can convert your vinyl records into MP3 files for digital storage and playback.

1. Connect the turntable to your computer using the supplied USB cable.
2. Install audio recording software on your computer (e.g., Audacity, available for free online).
3. Follow the software's instructions to select the turntable as the input device and begin recording.
4. Play your vinyl record to record the audio.
5. Save the recorded audio as an MP3 file.

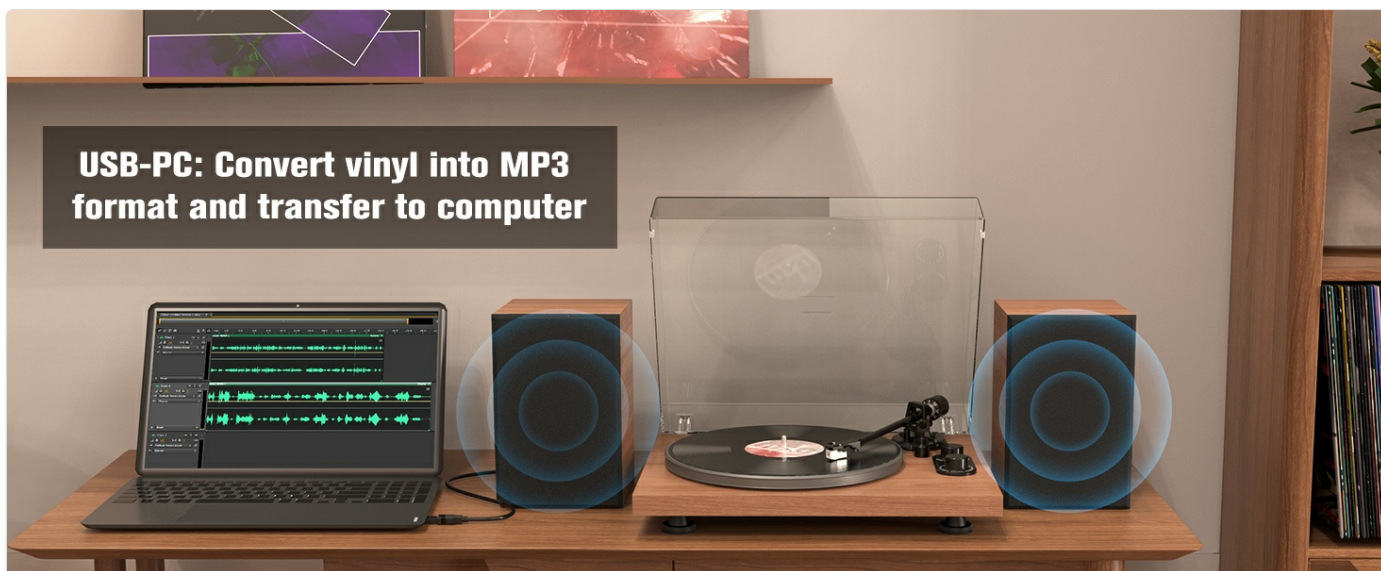


Image: The Udreamer Turntable connected to a laptop via USB, illustrating the process of converting vinyl audio to MP3 format for transfer to a computer.

4. RCA Output

The turntable features RCA output for connecting to external amplifiers or active speakers.

1. Connect the RCA cable from the "AUDIO OUTPUT" ports on the turntable to the corresponding input ports on your amplifier or active speakers.
2. Ensure the "PHONO LINE SWITCH" is set correctly based on your amplifier's input type (Phono or Line).

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Turntable

- Always unplug the turntable before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the dust cover and cabinet.
- For the platter and tonearm, use a slightly damp cloth, then dry immediately. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

2. Stylus Care

- Clean the stylus regularly using a soft brush designed for stylus cleaning, brushing gently from back to front.
- Avoid touching the stylus with your fingers.
- Replace the stylus (AT-3600L compatible) every 300-500 hours of playback or if you notice a degradation in sound quality.

3. Record Care

- Handle records by their edges or label.
- Store records vertically in their sleeves to prevent warping.
- Clean records with a dedicated record brush before each play to remove dust and static.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected; outlet not working	Ensure power adapter is securely plugged in; try a different outlet.
No sound from speakers	Speakers not connected; volume too low; Phono/Line switch incorrect	Check speaker connections and polarity; increase volume; ensure Phono/Line switch matches your setup.
Sound distorted or skipping	Stylus dirty or worn; tracking force incorrect; record dirty or damaged	Clean stylus; re-adjust tracking force; clean record or try a different one.
Bluetooth not connecting	Device not in pairing mode; too far from turntable; interference	Ensure device is in pairing mode; move closer to turntable; reduce other wireless interference.
Platter not spinning	Drive belt dislodged or broken; motor issue	Check and re-seat the drive belt; contact customer support if belt is broken or motor is faulty.






