1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient assembly, operation, and maintenance of your FocusOnHome Garbage Bin Shed. This metal outdoor storage solution is designed to discreetly store up to three standard trash cans, enhancing the appearance of your outdoor areas. Constructed from durable galvanized steel, it offers resistance against corrosion, rust, and scratches.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety instructions before assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- Always follow assembly instructions carefully.
- Choose a level area with good drainage for installation to ensure stability and prevent water accumulation.
- Be cautious when handling heavy components during assembly. It is recommended to have at least two people for assembly.
- Keep all small parts, tools, and packaging materials away from children and pets to prevent choking hazards or injury.
- Wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves, during assembly to protect hands from sharp edges.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

- Galvanized Steel Panels (various sizes for walls, roof, doors)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the garbage bin shed is required. Panels are pre-cut and pre-drilled to facilitate the process. Due to the number of components and fasteners, patience and careful attention to the instructions are essential. It is highly recommended to assemble this product with at least two people.

4.1 Site Preparation

1. Select a level area with good drainage to prevent water accumulation around the base of the shed.
2. Clear the area of any debris, rocks, or vegetation.

4.2 Component Identification

Familiarize yourself with all parts before starting. Refer to the detailed diagrams in the included assembly manual for specific component identification.

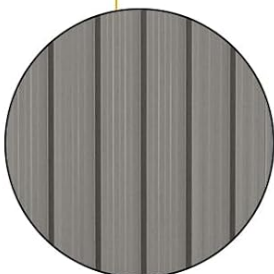

4.3 Assembly Steps (General Guidelines)

1. **Frame Assembly:** Begin by assembling the base frame on your prepared level surface. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. **Wall Panel Installation:** Attach the side and back wall panels to the base frame using the provided fasteners. Ensure panels are correctly oriented and aligned with pre-drilled holes.
3. **Door Assembly:** Assemble the individual doors, attaching hinges and handles as per the manual. Mount the doors to the front frame of the shed.
4. **Lid Installation:** Attach the lifting lids to the top frame, ensuring the springs are correctly installed to allow for easy opening and closing.
5. **Roof Panel Attachment:** Secure the roof panels to the top frame, ensuring a tight fit for weather protection.
6. **Final Checks:** Double-check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tightened securely. Test the operation of the doors and lids.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The FocusOnHome Garbage Bin Shed is designed for convenient access and storage of trash cans.

5.1 Placing and Removing Trash Cans

- **Front Access:** Open the individually hinged front doors to roll trash cans in or out. The black plastic door handles provide a secure grip.
- **Top Access:** For depositing rubbish, lift the individually hinged lids on top of the shed. The convenient springs assist in opening and holding the lids.

5.2 Locking Mechanism

The shed is equipped with lockable doorknobs. A padlock (not included) can be used to secure the contents of the shed.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your garbage bin shed.

- **Cleaning:** The galvanized steel construction is easy to clean. Simply spray with water to remove dirt and debris. For stubborn stains, use a mild soap solution and a soft brush, then rinse thoroughly. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Check hinges and springs for smooth operation and lubricate if necessary.
- **Drainage:** Ensure the area around the shed remains clear of debris to maintain proper drainage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

- **Difficulty during Assembly:** If you find assembly challenging due to numerous screws and washers, take breaks and carefully re-read the instructions for each step. Ensure all parts are correctly oriented before tightening fasteners.
- **Bent or Damaged Parts:** Upon receiving the product, inspect all parts for any damage, such as bent panels. If you discover damaged components, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support for replacement parts.
- **Doors or Lids Not Closing Properly:** Check that the shed is installed on a perfectly level surface. Uneven ground can cause misalignment. Inspect hinges for any obstructions or damage.
- **Rust Spots:** While the shed is rust-resistant, prolonged exposure to harsh conditions or damage to the galvanized coating can lead to rust. Clean any rust spots immediately with a wire brush and apply a rust-inhibiting primer and paint suitable for galvanized steel.

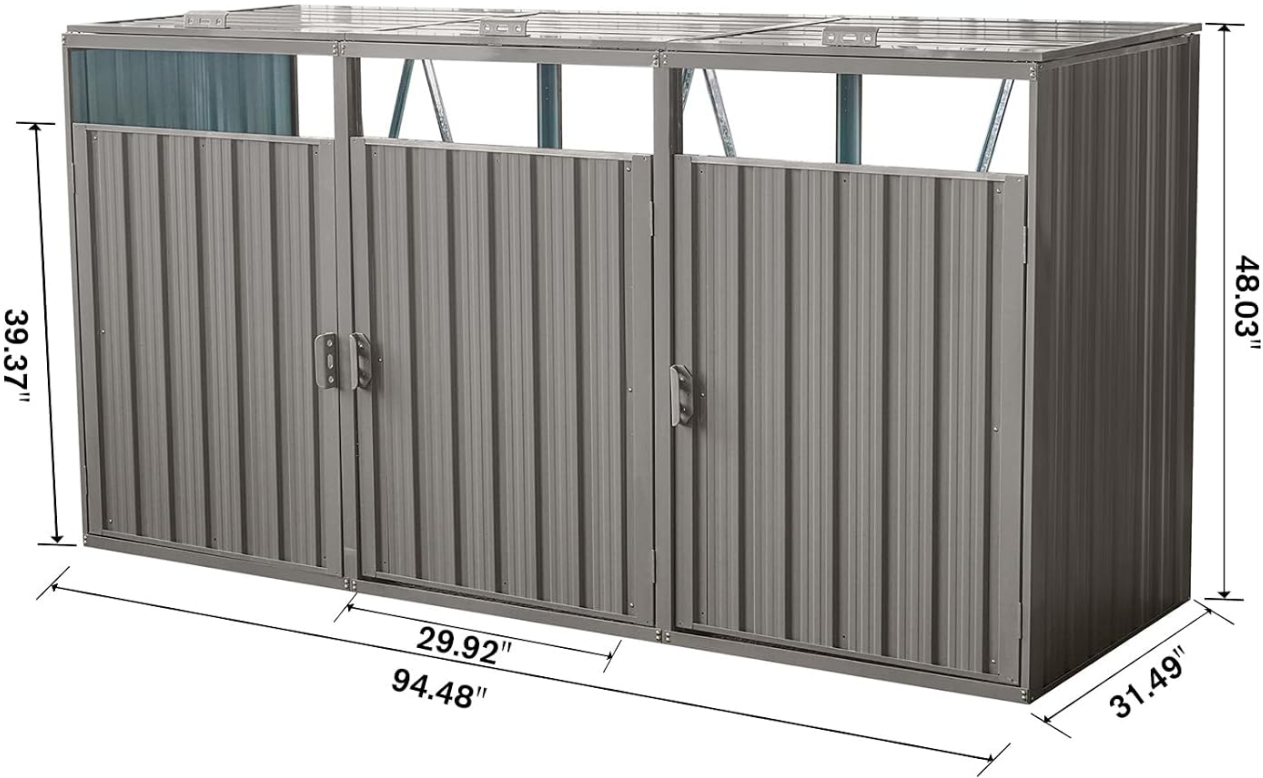


Image 8.1: Detailed product dimensions in inches.
